This is the entrance.



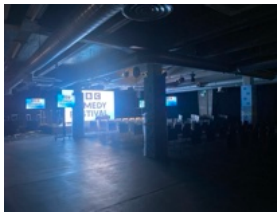
You can arrive from 9:30am.

trucks on site.



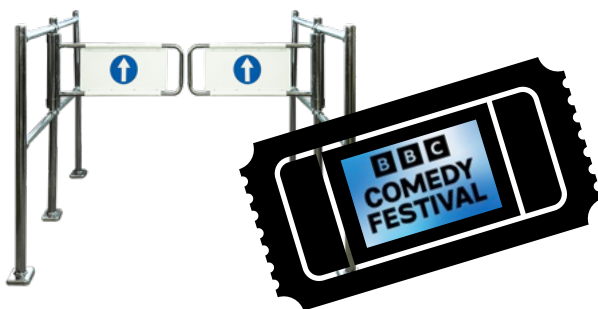
SWG3 is a large warehouse venue with many large rooms and spaces.

It is free seating and there is re-admittance.



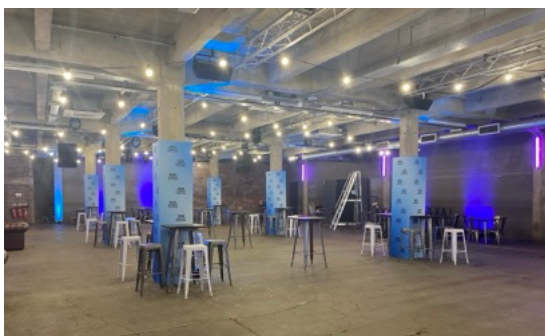
A coffee and a snack van are located outside.

snacks are provided.







If you are feeling nervous or shy

Getting Here and Access

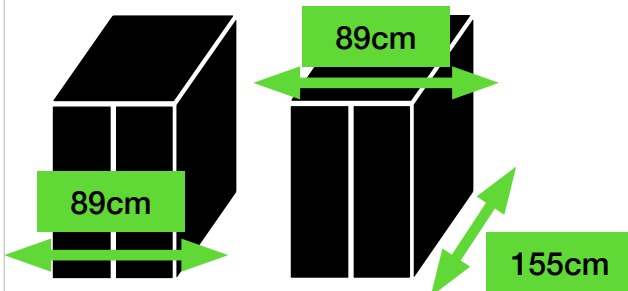

There are 5 steps or a small lift into Galvaniser.

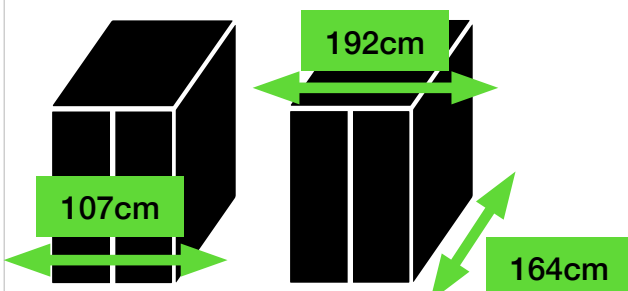


This lift door is 89cm wide.

This lift interior is 89cm wide and 155cm deep.



There are 26 steps or a large lift up to Warehouse on the 1st floor.



This lift door is 107cm wide.

This lift interior is 192cm wide and 164cm deep.
