DIRECTORS UK COMMERCIAL FEE RATES: 2019 – 2025

- Applies to all programmes classed as commissions for OFCOM purposes.
- 2022 – 2023 rates apply to programmes commissioned from 1 July 2022 and contracted after 1 August 2022.
- 2023 – 2024 rates apply to programmes commissioned from 1 July 2023
- 2024 – 2025 rates will apply to programmes commissioned from 1 July '24

- The following programmes are out of scope and exempt from payment of the commercial fee:
 - Welsh language programmes commissioned by S4C, and other indigenous language programme commissioned by or in association with a Broadcaster.
 - Programmes under 15 minutes (where programme means the total series duration).
 - Programmes commissioned for online only use (i.e. no linear transmission)
 - Exempt Works (as defined under this Agreement).
- The producer's delivery invoice to the Broadcaster must identify the total DUK deduction as set out in the commissioning agreement.
