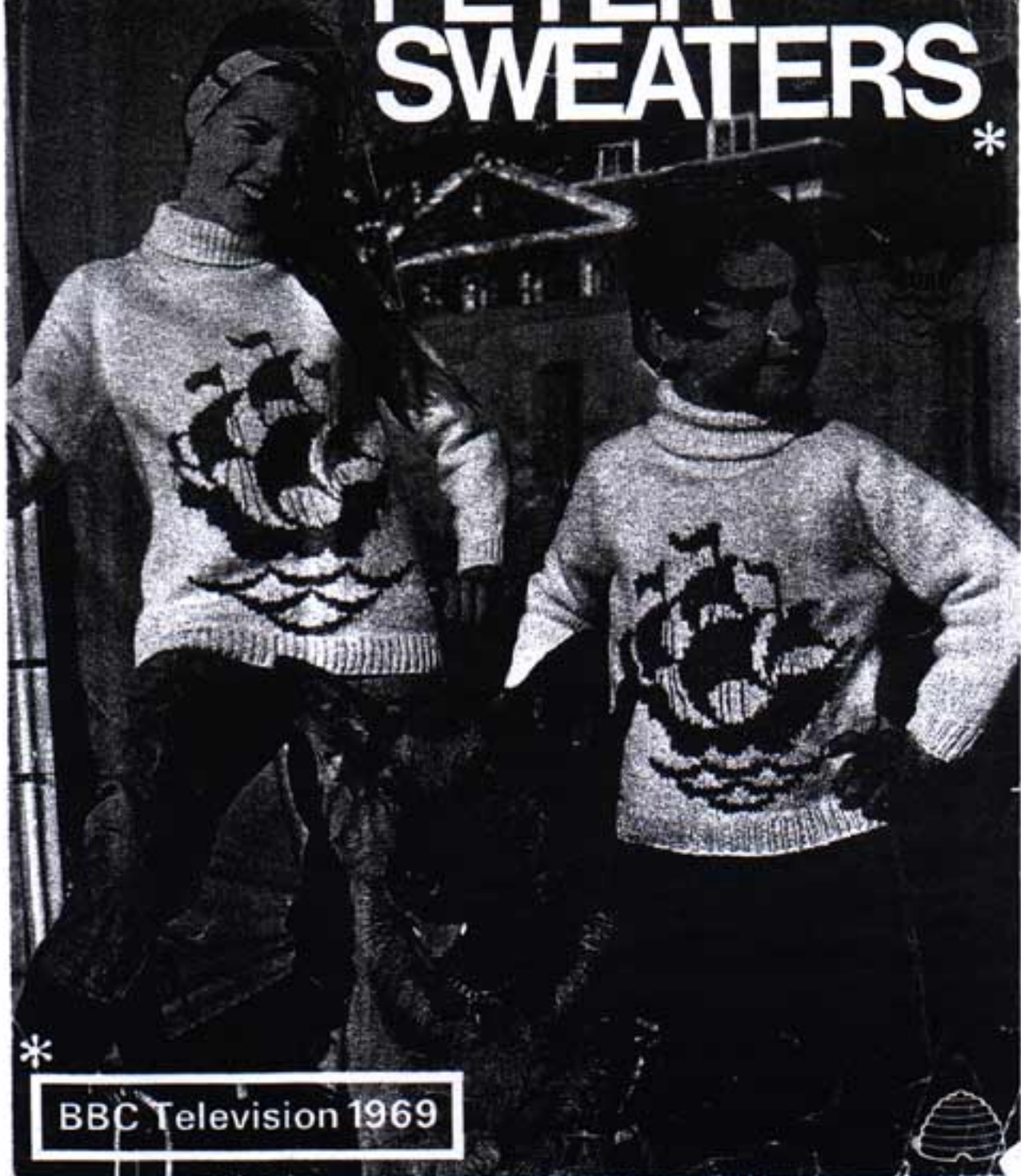

Sail away with Blue Peter*

Tension

10 sts. and 13 rows to 2 ins. on No.8 needles, over stocking stitch.

Abbreviations

K.=knit; P.=purl; st.=stitch; tog.=together; t.b.l.=through back of loops; inc.=increase by working

into front and back of stitch; dec.=decrease by working 2 sts. together; beg.=beginning; M.1 P.=pick up horizontal loop lying before next st. and purl into back of it.

Special Note

When working motif from chart,

strand wool not in use loosely across back of work over 2 sts. each time to keep fabric elastic.

You must use the recommended Patons brand to be sure of a successful result.

Junior sizes with smaller galleon

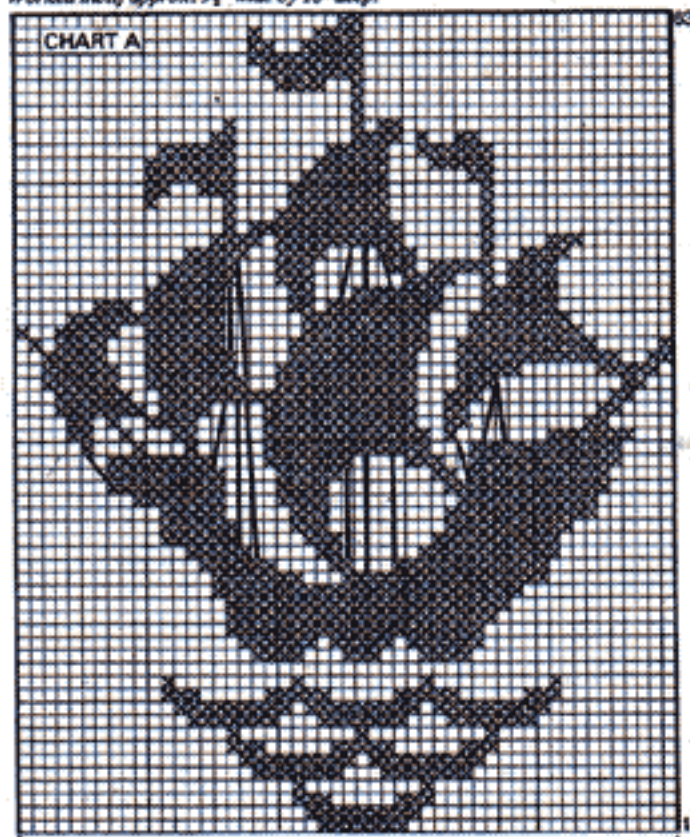
To fit chest/bust	ins.	26-27	28-29	30-31	32-33
Length from top of shoulders	ins.	16½	18	19½	21½
Sleeve seam (adjustable)	ins.	10½	12	13½	15
Patons Capstan Light	× 2 oz.	6	7	8	9
Dark	× 2 oz.	1	1	1	1

Two No. 10 and two No. 8 BEEHIVE or MILWARDS DISC needles, measured by BEEHIVE gauge. Two stitch-holders.

Sizes

The figures in square brackets [] refer to the 28-29, 30-31 and 32-33 sizes.

Worked motif approx. 9½" wide by 10" deep.



51 PATT. STS.

□ L (Light) ⊞ D (Dark)

FRONT

** Using No. 10 needles and L., cast on 66 [70, 74, 78] sts. and work 1½ [1½, 1½, 2] ins. K.1, P.1 rib. Next row—P.7 [5, 5, 4], M.1 P., * P.13 [10, 8, 7], M.1 P.; rep. from * to last 7 [5, 5, 4] sts., P.7 [5, 5, 4], (71 [77, 83, 89] sts.)**

Change to No. 8 needles and stocking stitch, starting with a K. row, working Galleon in centre from Chart A and reading odd rows knit from right to left and even rows purl from left to right.

1st row—K.10 [13, 16, 19] L., work next 51 sts. as on 1st row of chart A., K.10 [13, 16, 19] L.
2nd row—P.10 [13, 16, 19] L., work next 51 sts. as on 2nd row of chart A., P.10 [13, 16, 19] L.

Continue in stocking stitch thus, working Galleon from chart (next row, 3rd row) until it is complete at the same time working as follows:—

Continue straight until Front measures 10 [11, 12, 13½] ins. at centre, ending with right side facing.

Shape raglans by casting off 3 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.

Next row—K.2, K.2 tog., K. to last 4 sts., K.2 tog.t.b.l., K.2.

Next row—P.

Rep. last 2 rows until 31 [35, 39, 43] sts. remain, ending with right side facing.

Divide for neck:—

Next row—K.2, K.2 tog., K.8 [9, 10, 11], turn and leave remaining sts. on a spare needle.

Continue on these 11 [12, 13, 14] sts. for first side, dec. 1 st. at raglan edge as before on every alt. row, at the same time dec. 1 st. at neck edge on every row until 4 [5, 6, 7] sts. remain.

Now keep neck edge straight and continue dec. at raglan edge on

every alt. row as before until 3 sts. remain, ending with right side facing.

Next row—K.1, K.2 tog.

Next row—P.2, turn.

K.2 tog. and fasten off.

With right side facing, slip centre 7 [9, 11, 13] sts. on a stitch-holder, rejoin yarn to remaining sts., K. to last 4 sts., K.2 tog.t.b.l., K.2.

Finish to correspond with first side.

BACK

Work as for Front from ** to **.

Change to No. 8 needles and stocking stitch, starting with a K. row, and work straight until Back matches Front at side edge, ending with right side facing.

Shape raglans as for Front until 21 [23, 25, 27] sts. remain, ending with right side facing.

Leave sts. on a stitch-holder.

SLEEVES

With No. 10 Needles and L., cast on 30 [32, 36, 38] sts. and work 1½ [1½, 1½, 2] ins. K.1, P.1 rib.

Next row—P.3 [3, 3, 1], M.1 P., * P.8 [5, 6, 5], M.1 P.; rep. from * to last 3 [4, 3, 2] sts., P.3 [4, 3, 2] [34 [38, 42, 46] sts.).

Change to No. 8 needles and stocking stitch, starting with a K. row, shaping sides as follows:—

Inc. 1 st. at each end of 3rd [5th, 9th, 7th] and every following 6th [7th, 8th, 9th] row until there are 50 [54, 58, 62] sts.

Work straight until sleeve seam measures 10½ [12, 13½, 15] ins., ending with right side facing (adjust length here).

Shape raglan top by casting off 3 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.

Next row—K.2, K.2 tog., K. to last 4 sts., K.2 tog.t.b.l., K.2.

Work 3 rows straight.

Rep. last 4 rows once more.

Next row—K.2, K.2 tog., K. to last 4 sts., K.2 tog.t.b.l., K.2.

Next row—P.

Rep. last 2 rows until 6 sts. remain, ending with right side facing.

Next row—K.1, K.2 tog., K.2 tog.t.b.l., K.1.

Next row—P.

Leave sts. on a safety-pin.

TO MAKE UP

Omitting ribbing, block and press each piece on wrong side using a warm iron and damp cloth.

Using a fine back-stitch seam join raglan seams on Right Sleeve and front raglan seam on Left Sleeve.

Collar

With right side facing and No. 10 needles, K. 4 Left sleeve sts., inc. 1 st. in centre, pick up and K.15 [16, 17, 18] down left side of neck, K.7 [9, 11, 13] from centre inc. 2 sts., pick up and K.15 [16, 17, 18] up right side, K.4 from Right sleeve inc. 1 st.

in centre, and 21 [23, 25, 27] from back inc. 4 sts. evenly (74 [80, 86, 92] sts.).

Work 4 [4, 4½, 4½] ins. K.1, P.1 rib. Cast off loosely in rib.

Using a flat seam for ribbing and a fine back-stitch seam for remainder join remaining raglan seam, then join collar neatly with a flat seam.

Join side and sleeve seams.

Press all seams.

Thick vertical lines on chart indicate rigging and are embroidered straight sts. in D: using split wool.

Senior sizes with larger galleon

Length from top of shoulders	ins.	24	25	26	27
Sleeve seam (adjustable)	ins.	16	16½	17½	18½
Patons Capstan Light	× 2 oz.	10	11	12	13
Dark	× 2 oz.	1	1	1	1

* For plain garment (without motif) add 2 oz. to each Main Shade total.

Two No. 10 and two No. 8 BEEHIVE or MILWARDS DISC needles, measured by BEEHIVE gauge.

Two stitch-holders.

Sizes

The figures in square brackets [] refer to the 36-37, 38-39 and 40-41 sizes.

For Tension, Abbreviations and Special Note see page 2.

FRONT

** With No. 10 needles and L., cast on 86 [90, 94, 98] sts. and work 2 ins. K.1, P.1 rib.

Next row—P.7 [5, 2, 7], M.1 P., * P.12 [10, 9, 7], M.1 P.; rep. from * to last 7 [5, 2, 7] sts., P.7 [5, 2, 7] [93 [99, 105, 111] sts.).**

Change to No. 8 needles and stocking stitch, starting with a K. row, working Galleon in centre from Chart B., and reading odd rows knit from right to left and even rows purl from left to right.

1st row—K.11 [14, 17, 20] L., work next 71 sts. as on 1st row of chart B., K.11 [14, 17, 20] L.

2nd row—P.11 [14, 17, 20] L., work next 71 sts. as on 2nd row of chart B., P.11 [14, 17, 20] L.

Continue in stocking stitch thus, working Galleon from chart B

(next row, 3rd row) until it is complete at the same time working as follows:—

Continue straight until Front measures 15 [15½, 16, 16½] ins. at centre, ending with right side facing.

Shape raglans by casting off 4 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.

Next row—K.2, K.2 tog., K. to last 4 sts., K.2 tog.t.b.l., K.2.

Work 3 rows straight.

Rep. last 4 rows 1 [1, 2, 3] times more (81 [87, 91, 95] sts.).

Next row—K.2, K.2 tog., K. to last 4 sts., K.2 tog.t.b.l., K.2.

Next row—P.

Rep. last 2 rows until 47 [51, 57, 63] sts. remain, ending with right side facing.

Divide for neck as follows:—

Next row—K.2, K.2 tog., K.14 [15, 16, 17], turn and leave remaining sts. on a spare needle.

Continue on these 17 [18, 19, 20] sts. for first side, dec. 1 st. at raglan edge as before on every alt. row, at the same time dec. 1 st. at neck edge on every row until 7 [8, 9, 10] sts. remain.

Now keep neck edge straight and continue dec. at raglan edge on every alt. row until 3 sts. remain.

Next row—P.

Next row—K.1, K.2 tog.

Next row—P.2, turn.

K.2 tog. and fasten off.

With right side facing, slip centre 11 [13, 17, 21] sts. on a stitch-holder, rejoin yarn to remaining sts., K. to last 4 sts., K.2 tog.t.b.l., K.2.

Finish to correspond with first side.

BACK

Work as for Front from ** to **.

Change to No. 8 needles and stocking stitch, starting with a K. row, and work straight until Back matches Front at side edge, ending with right side facing.

Shape raglans as for Front until 29 [31, 35, 39] sts. remain, ending with right side facing.

Leave sts. on a stitch-holder.

SLEEVES

With No. 10 needles and L., cast on 40 [44, 48, 52] sts. and work 2 ins., K.1, P.1 rib.

Next row—P.5 [5, 6, 6], M.1 P., * P.10 [11, 12, 13], M.1 P.; rep. from * to last 5 [6, 6, 7] sts., P.5 [6, 6, 7] [44 [48, 52, 56] sts.).

Change to No. 8 needles and stocking stitch, starting with a K. row, shaping sides by inc. 1 st. at each end of next and every following 7th row until there are 66 [72, 78, 84] sts. Work straight until sleeve seam measures 16 [16½, 17½, 18½] ins., ending with right side facing (adjust length here).

Shape raglan top by casting off 4 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.

Next row—K.2, K.2 tog., K. to last 4 sts., K.2 tog.t.b.l., K.2.

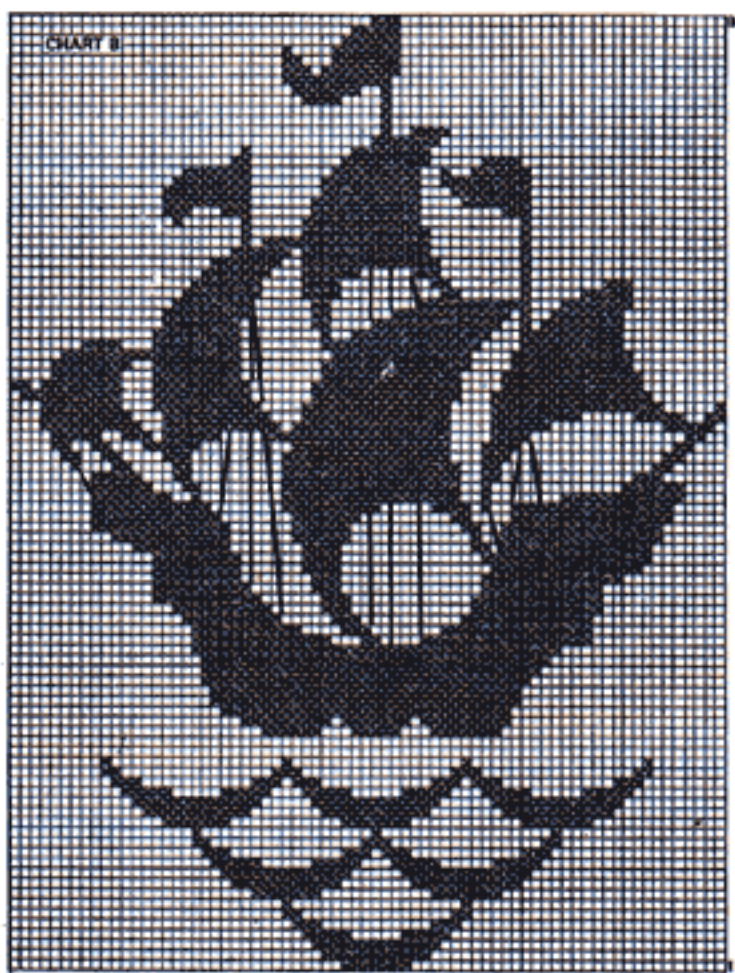
Work 3 [3, 3, 1] rows straight.

1st and 2nd sizes only—Rep. last 4 rows 2 [1] times more.

All sizes: Next row—K.2, K.2 tog., K. to last 4 sts., K.2 tog.t.b.l., K.2. Next row—P.

Rep. last 2 rows until 6 sts. remain, all sizes, ending with right side facing.

Worked motif approx. 14" wide by 15" deep.



77 PATT. STS.

□ L (Light) ■ SD (Dark)

Next row—K.1, K.2 tog., K.2 tog. (t.b.l.), K.1.

Next row—P.

Leave sts. on a safety-pin.

TO MAKE UP

As for smaller sizes page 3.

Collar

With right side facing and No. 10 needles, K. 4 from Left sleeve inc.

1 st. in centre, pick up and K. 20 [21, 22, 23] down left side of neck, K.11 [13, 17, 21] from centre inc. 3 sts. evenly, pick up and K.20 [21, 22, 23] up right side, K.4 Right sleeve sts. inc. 1 st. in centre, and 29 [31, 35, 39] from back inc. 5 sts. evenly: (98 [104, 114, 124] sts.).

Work 5 [5, 6, 6] ins. K.1, P.1 rib.

Cast off loosely in rib.

Complete as smaller sizes page 3.

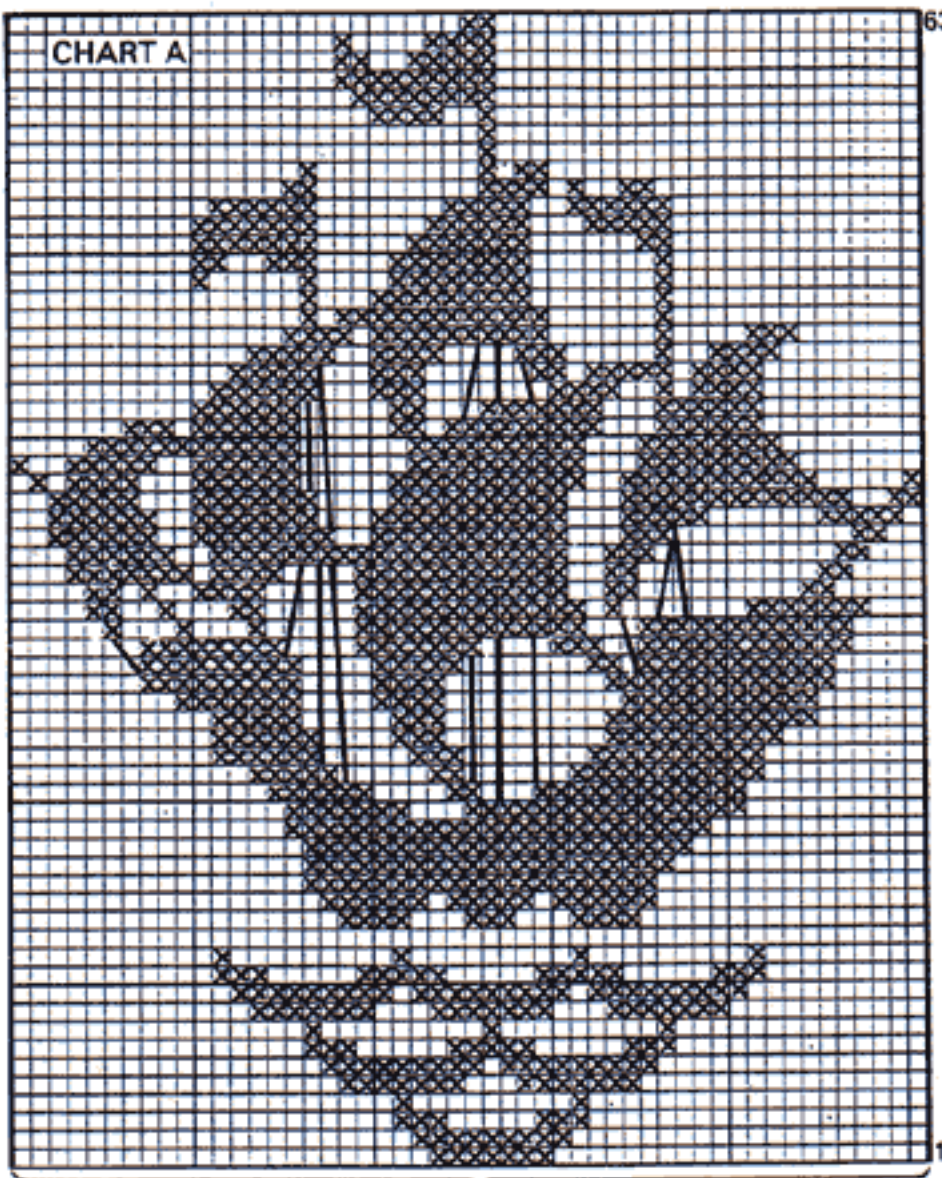
