A. CONTRIBUTORS & CONTENT

At a witchcraft coven, a photograph of a middle-aged lady is burned. The lady is Lavinia, a scientist who lives in the village of Moreton Harwood and the Aunt of Sarah-Jane Smith. Sarah-Jane arrives at the Manor, (her Aunt's home), just before Christmas to discover that her Aunt has left early for a tour of America. Brendan, her Aunt's ward arrives at the Manor too, from boarding school, for the Christmas holiday. They meet Commander Follock who runs the market garden at the Manor helped by George Tracey and his son Peter. Sarah-Jane and Brendan open a packing case addressed to Sarah-Jane and K9 is revealed. Sarah-Jane, puzzled by her Aunt's early departure, enquires at the Post Office run by Lilly Gregson but discovers nothing except that her Aunt upset the villagers with an article on witchcraft in the local paper. Sarah-Jane meets the Editor of the paper, Henry Tobias at a party held by Aunt Lavinia's neighbours, Howard and Juno Baker. George and Peter Tracey attempt to kidnap Brendan, but K9 stuns Peter and gives chase to George in the market garden which results in considerable damage to a greenhouse and George's terrified escape. Sarah-Jane and Brendan meet the Commander and George the next day at the spot and discuss the cause. Only the Commander is ignorant of the truth. That night Brendan and Peter disappear and Sarah-Jane obtains little information from the police. The Police Sergeant is a member of the coven and he visits George Tracey (also a member) to try and prevent the sacrifice of Brendan, which will appease the anger of the 'Goddess Ecate' who has 'sent her white dog' (K9). Sarah-Jane listens outside and later discovers the Sergeant lying dead on a country road. She tells the Commander but the next day he disappears. The Bakers don't help, only sympathize and she returns home. However, with K9's help they trace the witches coven and save Brendan's life. The High Priestess and Priest are unmasked to reveal Lilly Gregson and Commander Follock. Sarah-Jane and Brendan spend Christmas Day with the Bakers who had behaved suspiciously but turn out to be innocent. Aunt Lavinia phones from America where she is safe and sound.
