A. Caught in a time corridor emanating from the planet Karfel, the Doctor and Peri are forced to land. The Doctor, having been to Karfel before in a former regeneration, is surprised when he meets Tekker, an oily, fawning individual totally unsuited to his office of Maylin, governor of Karfel. The Doctor then learns that the planet is really ruled by the Borad, using Tekker as the supposedly 'acceptable, face of Leadership'. Meanwhile, Vena, a member of the Planet's High Council, has fallen from grace. But before she can be executed, she steals a vital amulet from the Borad and then throws herself into the time corridor. This takes her to 19th century Earth, where she meets a young man called Herbert. While this is happening, Peri is taken hostage by Tekker thereby forcing the Doctor to go after Vena in his Tardis and retrieve the amulet. While gone, Tekker orders that Peri should be fed to the Morlox, a creature that inhabits the caves of Karfel. Hearing of this, the Borad instructs that Peri should be brought to him as his intention, after a certain amount of genetic engineering is to make her his bride. On the Doctors return with Vena & Herbert, he is forced into battle with the Borad and Tekker attempts to throw him into the Timelash.
