A. THE STORY: The Tardis stops on the edge of the cosmos and is in danger of being sucked in by a spiral nebula. To escape, the Tardis is materialised on the RIC, an ancient spaceship. Tala, the pilot, collapses and the spaceship flies out of control towards the nebula. The Doctor links K9 up to the controls which successfully gives RIC enough power to escape. Jackson, the Captain, then instructs his crew to follow a signal which they are receiving. The signal is from another spaceship, the P/E, for which they have been searching for over a hundred thousand years. The course however will take them back into the nebula. The RIC is drawn through a layer of meteorites and becomes encrusted with space debris. The episode ends with the crew trying to blast their way out with the lazer cannon but the cannon appears to have no effect.

A. THE STORY: The crew of the RIC spaceship eventually succeed in blasting their way out of the space debris which has formed a rugby ball shape around the ship, only to find themselves heading, without fuel, into a planet. The planet is giving out a signal which is that from their lost spaceship, the P7E. The RIC crashes into the planet but the exterior proves to be soft and the spaceship sinks below the surface and only hits solid when they reach the core.

Inside the core Idas and his father, Idmon, are trying to free their family buried beneath the rockfall. This is monitored by Rask and Tarn, two security guards. Rask arrests Idmon but Idas manages to escape.

After blasting their way out into the tunnels, Jackson and his crew go in search of the P7E followed by the Doctor and Leela. The Doctor and Leela see Idas being pursued by Rask and his guards. They cause a diversion and Idas finds his way into the RIC. The Doctor and Leela also return to the spaceship after overhearing Rask's order that the tunnels be closed down for fumigation.

Gas starts to come into the RIC airlock. Idas collapses and Leela stays with him while the Doctor goes out into the gas-filled tunnels again. He finds a fan system for the gas and sets to work but the episode ends when he too collapses.

A. THE STORY: The end of Episode Two and hence the beginning of the reprise into this episode leads up to the point where the Doctor collapses over the fan system controlling the gas in the tunnels. The Doctor however succeeds in reversing the effect of the fan and the gas is sucked back into the P7E. Idmon is about to be sacrificed. The Doctor, Leela and Idas set out to rescue him but are captured by Rask and his guards and taken to watch the sacrifice before "they too will answer the question of the sword". A fight breaks out in the Sacrificial Chamber and they escape. Jackson and his crew arrive on the scene again but Herrick is captured and tortured. The Doctor realizes that there is another way to get back into the P7E to obtain the race bank cylinders; this is by the goods entrance - the crushers. The Doctor and Leela hide in a skip which is pushed along by Idmon. The episode ends however when Idmon slips and the skip begins its tip into the crushers.

A. THE STORY: The ship containing the Doctor and Leela tips into the crusher but they manage to hang on until Jackson and the others come to their rescue and drag them out. The captured Herrick tells the seers that the crew is in search of the race bank of the Minyans and Ankh and Lakh decide to give him the cylinders he describes. The Doctor, Leela and Iidas leave the others and find another way to the Oracle. From a vent they view the collection of the cylinders by Ankh and Lakh. The Doctor discovers that the Oracle however still holds the real cylinders and he manages to obtain them. Herrick is brought to Jackson with the false cylinders and they return to the ship. The Doctor and company also return to the RIC but the Doctor discovers that the false cylinders are in fact bombs and takes them back into the tunnels. He meets Rask who takes the cylinders thinking they are still the real ones. The Doctor escapes from the guards and again returns to the ship. Ankh and Lakh try to defuse the bombs but the Oracle has made it impossible. The RIC manages to blast out of the planet before it explodes. Jackson and his crew have succeeded in their mission and the Doctor, Leela and K9 return to the Tardis.
