A. It is 17th century earth. Strange lights are seen in the sky by Elizabeth the daughter of Squire John. Later that evening the family is attacked.

On the Tardis, the Doctor is trying to return Tegan to Heathrow but they land three centuries earlier. They go out and have a look round. In the woods they see drifting white smoke and are attacked by villagers. As they escape they meet Richard Mace, an actor/highwayman, who takes them to a barn where the Doctor looks at the ornament around his neck and Nyssa finds some powerpacks. All five go to see the Squire and as there is no reply the Doctor and Nyssa break in. They are followed by villagers. Inside the house the Doctor finds a wall that interests him and, while Nyssa opens the door to Tegan, Mace and Adric, the Doctor disappears. Nyssa takes them to where she left the Doctor and the door is slammed shut behind them.

A. The wall the Doctor has found is an energy barrier and he reappears through it. The others follow him into the cellar. The Android comes in behind them and attacks. Mace and Nyssa run out but Tegan and Adric are hurt. The Doctor is unable to rescue them alone and is forced to retreat.

The Doctor demonstrates the bracelet and powerpack to Mace. He and Nyssa go back to the Tardis to prepare the sonic booster to destroy the Android.

Tegan and Adric are questioned by the Terileptil Leader, which is a fish-like monster, before being locked in a room.

The Doctor, Mace and Nyssa find the escape pod which brought the Terileptils to earth when they are attacked by "controlled" villagers. They escape to the woods where Nyssa goes off alone to the Tardis and the Dr. and Mace go to find the Miller.

Tegan and Adric escape from the room but she is recaptured by the Android as they try to get out of the house.

In the Miller's barn the Doctor and Mace are found by masked villagers who prepare to behead them.

A. The village Headman enters the Miller's barn just as the Doctor and Mace are about to be beheaded. He is wearing a bracelet and orders them to be locked in the harness room. Adric has escaped from the house and runs back to the Tardis where Nyssa is preparing the sonic booster. The Terileptil puts a bracelet on Tegan and sets her to work.

The Doctor and Mace over power the Headman but do not escape. The Android smashes through the harness room wall - the villagers run away. The Doctor and Mace are taken back to the house where the Terileptil explains all to the Doctor. Mace is fitted with a bracelet and the Doctor with handcuffs. He is locked in the room where he goes through his pockets.

Adric decides to find the Doctor but is caught by masked villagers on leaving the Tardis. Nyssa completes the booster and tests it.

The Terileptil fires at the sonic screwdriver which shrivels up and leaves Mace pointing a gun at the Doctor and Tegan about to open a cage of plague-ridden rats.

A. Tegan fiddles with the catch on the cage of rats as The Doctor knocks out Mace and removes the power packs from their bracelets. The Leader drives off to London leaving the Miller in charge of the laboratory and ordering the Android to find the Tardis. The Doctor, Tegan and Mace escape from the cell but find their way out of the cellar barred. They hide as the Doctor manages to open the energy barrier to the laboratory and then attack and overpower the Miller.

Meanwhile, Nyssa has tested the booster and the masked villagers who had captured Adric have been frightened off by the Android. Nyssa goes out of the Tardis and is chased back by the Android. She runs into the Girls' room and turns on the booster making the Android vibrate and then explode. She and Adric move the Tardis to the Manor House where they pick up The Doctor, Tegan and Mace and go off in search of the Terileptils. They find them in London at a bakery. They all go in, Adric knocks over a stool and warns the Terileptils they are there. A fight ensues. The Terileptils are killed and the quintet run out just as the Leader's gun explodes. They throw the amoules into the fire and then go back to the Tardis leaving Mace behind. As they dematerialise a sign of "Pudding Lane" is revealed on the wall behind the Tardis.
