



## Accessing your P60 and other pay documents on the EY – Interact Payroll (EYIP) Portal

1. Log in at <https://interactpayroll.ey.com/login> using the personal email associated with your account. This will be the same email used for the Freelance Payment Portal.





2. Your P60 should appear in the section called 'My Documents'. [screenshot]



*If the P60 is not visible here, it may be because it has been generated under a different payroll entity. This commonly happens due to the transition from monthly to weekly payroll. For example, if you are now paid weekly, your 24–25 P60 may be stored under the monthly payroll entity that applied at the time.*

## Switching Payroll Entity in EYIP

1. Select 'Switch entity or pay group' at the top of the screen.



2. Choose an alternative entity and pay group from the dropdown list. The P60 is likely stored under the monthly version of your current weekly entity.

**Pay Entity:** United Kingdom – W Main PS → United Kingdom Main PS

**Pay Group:** W Main PS → Main PS

**Pay Entity:** United Kingdom – W Studios Productions → United Kingdom BBC Studios Productions
