<p>Learning hint</p> <p>Open a magazine at random and use the pictures to practise German greetings – you can usually tell from the background and the way people are dressed what time of day it is. Don't confine yourself to greeting them: practise asking how they are – be formal or informal depending on the picture – then introduce yourself and think of how they would reply. You'll find it a help when you come to do it for real.</p>
