SAYING C, Z, S

In parts of Southern Spain, the Canaries and Latin America you hear people pronounce some letters differently.

One difference is the **c** sound.

It isn't pronounced 'th', but the same as an **s**.

Estás de vacaciones, ¿no?

You're on holiday, aren't you?

The same thing happens with the letter **z**.

El Sur es la **zona** turística

The South is the tourist area

You may also hear the **s** after vowels aspirated. For example, 'estás':

¿Dónde estás?

Where are you?
