IRREGULAR VERB: IR, 'TO GO'

The 'I' form of some irregular verbs ends in **-oy**.

estar: **estoy**

to be: I am

dar: **doy**

to give: I give

Another commonly used one is **voy**, I go. It comes from **ir**, which is also an irregular verb.

ir: **voy**

to go: I go

For these three verbs, just change **-oy** for these other endings:

voy

I go

vas

you go (informal)

va

he/she goes, you go

vamos

we go

vais

you go (plural, informal)

van

they, you go (plural, formal)
