

## 6. Un regalo - The Learning Section

### Grammar

#### PLURALS

As in English, the general rule for making something plural in Spanish is to add an 's'

un billete, dos billetes

a ticket, two tickets

un kilómetro

a kilometre

dos kilómetros

two kilometres

But, if the word doesn't end in a vowel you have to add 'es'

un collar, dos collares

a necklace, two necklaces

'El' and 'la', the words for 'the' have plural forms in Spanish, 'los' and 'las'.

'Un' and 'una' become 'unos' and 'unas' which mean some or a few in

English

el/un pendiente

the/an earring

los/unos pendientes

the/some earrings

la/una pulsera

the/a bracelet

las/unas pulseras

the/some bracelets
