NUMBERS 1 TO 15

There isn't an easy way of learning the numbers 1-10. You just have to memorize them.

uno, dos, tres one, two, three

cuatro, cinco, seis four, five, six

siete, ocho, nueve, diez seven, eight, nine, ten

However, the numbers 11–15 all end in **-ce**:

once, doce, trece 11, 12, 13

catorce, quince 14, 15

Uno, one, changes form depending on what it refers to.

línea uno line one

un hermano one brother (or a brother)

una hermana one sister (or a sister)

Decimals are separated by a comma, not a point, which you'll hear as **con** in prices. The euro symbol goes after the number.
