



## **Project: Making a Promotional Video Application Form**

We are looking to select four young bands to help them to make their own music video for one of their songs.

We will provide you with the resources (DV camera, Minidisc recorder, digital camera, access to editing facilities) and production expertise (camera person, BBC producer).

We will help you develop your ideas and support you through the filming and editing process.

Band members must be between the ages of 15 and 30.

We ask that you supply us with a CD of a professional or good quality recording of the song you wish to make a video for so that we can assess the recording quality of the song, as well as making sure that it fits our legal guidelines. You may also submit a photograph of your band, although this is not compulsory and you will not be disqualified for not doing so.

By filling in this form, you are nominating yourself as the “band representative”. Should we need to contact your band, we will contact you, and your decisions will be that of the whole band.

We will be selecting a shortlist of ten bands that we will ask to meet with. As such, we must ask that you are available on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> July between 2pm and 8pm, and that you are able to get to The Forum in Norwich. We will select the final four from this ten.

If you are selected, filming and editing will be carried out in five-day (Monday to Friday) sessions – one session per band – during August.

**If you are selected to take part in this project you must agree to the following terms:**

**Contribution includes song and video.**

1. You agree to the BBC helping you make a music video that can be used to promote one of your own songs.
2. You agree to only submit materials which are your own original work. You must not violate, plagiarise, or infringe the rights of third parties including copyright, trademark, trade secrets, privacy, publicity, personal or proprietary rights.
3. Whilst we aim to encourage artistic development, we would not work on a song or video that harassed or caused distress to any person, transmitted obscene or offensive content, was defamatory, abusive, threatening, harmful, profane, sexually oriented, racially offensive or contained unlawful or objectionable content. Contributing material with the intention of committing or promoting an illegal act is strictly prohibited.
4. You give all necessary consents for the BBC to use your video and any other written, recorded, photographic or pictorial contribution to the Project. This may include publicity/promotional purposes and publication on [bbc.co.uk/norfolk](http://bbc.co.uk/norfolk) or broadcasting on BBC Radio Norfolk or BBC Look East.
5. Unless you specifically draw matters to the attention of the BBC you confirm that you have full right and title to enter into this agreement and have all the necessary consents and permissions to allow the BBC to use or record all elements of your contribution.
6. There is no obligation on the part of the BBC to publish, broadcast or otherwise use your contribution, and the BBC may edit your contribution as it thinks fit.
7. This agreement shall be freely assignable by the BBC and shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of England and Wales.
