

TEACHER'S NOTES

GUIDANCE

EACH LESSON WILL:

- Look at the issues of racism and sectarianism.
- Last 40 minutes.
- Have four or five main learning outcomes hoping to help pupils improve, explore, contemplate and begin a process of realisation.
- Include a focus on pupil comprehension, skills and attitudes.
- Include one or more video clips for pupils to watch.
- Recommend some pupil preparation before accessing the video clips and an active task to complete after the viewing of the clips.
- Have some element of discussion involved and end with a homework – which usually encourages the students to complete their pupil journal (see pupil journal template).
- Is accompanied by questions to help prompt discussion.
- Is accompanied (where relevant) by a glossary peculiar to the lesson you have chosen.
- Will recommend some extension activities.
- Ultimately is designed to be fun, active and allow the pupils a truly hands-on approach to learning.
