

Make a seascape wall display

You will need

One or two large pieces of large blue card (for background)
Blue tack or other adhesive
Scissors
Felt tips, paints or crayons

Instructions

Prepare the background for the wall display by sticking the pieces of blue card to a wall in the classroom.

If possible, paint some extra detail such as rocks, patches of sand or pieces of seaweed.

Next, organise the children with paper and paints to begin making sea animals to stick onto the wall display. Some examples of sea creatures have been provided for inspiration.

Once the children have finished painting and cutting out their sea animals, let them take turns to stick them onto the seascape.

As they stick their sea animals to the seascape encourage them to explain what they have drawn, why they have drawn that particular sea animal and how it swims in the sea or moves around the sea bed.
