

## **Ice Cream Parlour**

### **You will need**

One table and white table-cloth to be used as a serving counter.

Tables and chairs set out as in an ice cream parlour.

A till or container for ice cream servers to collect pretend money from customers.

Pretend money.

Make signs for Ice Parlour, i.e. "Your School Name Ices", or colour in and use the signs provided.

Price list and menu (make your own or print and use example provided).

Brown/yellow paper or thin card (for cones).

Coloured paper (crepe or similar for ice cream).

Empty cartons or containers for ice cream, sprinkles and decorations.

Sticky tape

Light glue stick

Scoop and spoons (for ice cream servers and for children to eat ice cream).

Drinks umbrellas and sparklers for decoration.

Aprons and hats for ice cream servers.

### **Instructions**

First, set up the table and table-cloth as the ice cream parlour serving counter.

Place the till and all ice cream containers on the table.

Print out "Hurley Burley Ices" signs provided and get children to colour in. Once complete, add the signs to the counter table. Also print and add Hurley Burley Ices Menu.







Place some pretend money in the till and also distribute some to children participating as customers.





Arrange some of the children's tables and chairs close to the counter to provide an area for them to enjoy their ice creams.

Organise some children to prepare ice cream cones. A template shape is provided for guidance on how to prepare the ice cream cone. If possible, "cone" coloured paper (brown or yellow) works best. Once the shape is drawn on the coloured paper, simply cut it out, then roll it into a cone shape and secure with some sticky tape.

While some children are preparing the cones, others could be scrunching up the coloured crepe paper into balls to use as ice cream.

Now all the preparations are complete, let the children role play as ice cream waiters and waitresses and others can play at being customers and enjoy their ice creams.

## **Ice cream cone template**

Below is a template that can be used to make your own ice cream cones. Draw this shape onto a piece of cone coloured (yellow or brown) paper or card and then cut round the outline. Then roll it up ensuring the bottom is narrow and the top is open to put in the ice cream. Use 2 pieces of sticky tape to secure the cone at the top and bottom.
