

Calculate the number of matching scores:

Row 1 & 2 matches = <u> </u>	Row 2 & 3 matches = <u> </u>	Row 3 & 5 matches = <u> </u>
Row 1 & 3 matches = <u> </u>	Row 2 & 4 matches = <u> </u>	Row 3 & 6 matches = <u> </u>
Row 1 & 4 matches = <u> </u>	Row 2 & 5 matches = <u> </u>	Row 4 & 5 matches = <u> </u>
Row 1 & 5 matches = <u> </u>	Row 2 & 6 matches = <u> </u>	Row 4 & 6 matches = <u> </u>
Row 1 & 6 matches = <u> </u>	Row 3 & 4 matches = <u> </u>	Row 5 & 6 matches = <u> </u>
