11. Narrator: They certainly do. So what are you waiting for? Pop down to Starkers. Where every member and every *member* has a place to call home (malfunctioning) home - home - home - home

14. Tim: It's no use Barry, it's broken.

15. Barry: No I'm telling you, this TV will bring in more footfall than ever.

16. Tim: How? It's ancient! It doesn't get news, it doesn't get sport all it does is play this one advert from 25 years ago.

17. Barry: Don't worry, my brother taught me a good trick. All you gotta do is give it
a
nice big whack.

20. Barry: (Sigh) Dead.

21. Tim: Just like your brother.

22. Barry: Yeah. Just like my dead brother.

23. Tim: Should we just shut up early today?

24. Barry: No. I made a promise to keep these doors open no matter what. Anyway, winter's always quiet for stripping.

25. Tim: It's June.

26. Barry: Need to get that calendar fixed as well. Business will pick up.

27. Tim: When? We've no customers. And when there are, they don't even throw notes anymore. They throw coins. It hurts!

28. Barry: Well you don't see Gabriel here complaining do you?

29. Gabriel: Hark I hear the trumpets of Galilee!

30. Tim: Gabriel thinks he's an angel ever since he got a pair of scissors stuck in his head after he got stabbed mid routine dressed as a sexy angel. All he ever talks about is the rapture and lambs.

31. Gabriel: (To the tune of rhythm of the night) These pair of scissors are my wife! My Wife!

32. Tim: And occasionally scissors.

33. Barry: Oh yeah. Hey, chin up. I guarantee any second now, a customer's going to walk through that door with some good news.

While I'm sure I don't need to explain the rules, I am going to. I will drop a coin from his majesty's collection onto this table. Blindfolded players will then try and guess what type of coin it is *before* their opponent. If after three rounds the scores are tied, the match will be decided by a shrapnel round but obviously that has never happened and probably never will. 269. Jennifer: (EFFECT - THROUGH PHONE) Yes, and they know how much that place means to you so they want to assure you they'll keep it exactly the way it is. The only difference is rather than a strip club, it would be a dual carriageway.

404. Host: I can't believe it. Starkers have assembled a team just in the nick of time.
Now *this* is (fast) dropping a coin on a table and guessing what type of coin it is while blindfolded.

406. Crowd: Rubel! Rubel! Rubel!

430. Dad: Now you go out there. And make me ashamed.

432. Dad: Mess it up like the complete disappointment you are.

435. Ref: Wrong.

436. Tim: Oh I got carried away.

437. Gorbachev: 5p.

438. Ref: Correct!

439. 073 SFX - RUSSIAN CHEER

440. 069 SFX - TENSE MUSIC

441. Host: The Soviets are one point ahead. If they win this next round they take home the gold. Here come the team captains, Barry Bulge and Gessya Koinadrop.

442. Barry: Alright guys, wish me luck.

443. Ref: Contestants, on my dropping.

444. 074 SFX - BEE APPROACHING

445. Tim: What's that buzzing?

446. Penny: No. Not again.

447. Ref: First guesses only.
