0A INT. TARDIS - DAY 7

0A

THE DOCTOR and MARTHA brace themselves as the TARDIS lands.

THE DOCTOR

There we are. Perfect landing. Which isn't easy in such a tight spot.

MARTHA

You should be used to tight spots by now!

*

Martha goes to the door.

MARTHA (CONT'D)

(excited)

Where are we?

*

THE DOCTOR

The end of the line. No place like it.

*

He indicates that she can go outside. She opens the door.

CUT TO:

1 INT. LIVING ROOM. MARTHA'S FLAT - DAY 7 - CONTINUOUS 1

MARTHA steps out into her own living room.

The room is small and a little untidy. Books and mugs on the coffee table. CDs on the floor. Tights and underwear drying on the radiators.

MARTHA

Home? You took me home.

*

THE DOCTOR comes out behind her, pleased with himself.

THE DOCTOR

Back to the morning after we left. So you've only been gone about twelve hours. No time at all, really!

*

MARTHA

But all the stuff we've done ...

Shakespeare, New New York, Old New York!

*

THE DOCTOR

Yep. All in one night. Relatively speaking.

*

Martha looks around the room.

(CONTINUED)

1 CONTINUED:

1

THE DOCTOR (CONT'D)
Everything should be just as it was.
Books. Cds... Laundry.

Martha grabs the items of underwear and stuffs them behind a cushion.

THE DOCTOR (CONT'D)
So. Back where you were. As promised.

MARTHA
So. This is it?

She is a little awkward, knowing a goodbye is coming up.

THE DOCTOR
I should probably -

Martha's mobile rings. She finds it and looks to see who's calling. Switches it off.

MARTHA
Leo. My brother. He'll call back if it's important.

THE DOCTOR
Well, then, I'll leave you to -

Martha's landline rings.

MARTHA
I'm sorry.

The answering machine kicks in with a 'beep'.

FRANCINE
(leaving message)
Martha? Are you there? Pick it up will you.

MARTHA
Mum. It'll wait.

FRANCINE
(leaving message)
Alright then. Pretend that you're out, if you like. I was only calling to say that your sister's on TV.

This grabs Martha's attention.

(CONTINUED)

1 CONTINUED: (2)

FRANCINE (CONT'D)

(leaving message)

On the news of all things! Just thought
you might be interested. Speak to you
soon.

She hangs up. Martha grabs the remote and switches on
News 24.

MARTHA

How could Tish end up on the news?

ON TV: EXT. LABORATORIES. A news conference is going on.
A wizened old man in his 70s - PROFESSOR LAZARUS - is
answering questions. Behind him is TISH - his PR person -
smartly dressed and looking serious.

*

THE DOCTOR

Is that her?

Martha is surprised.

MARTHA

Yeah. She's got a new job. PR for some
research lab.

*

Martha turns up the sound and catches the end of the
bulletin.

CLOSE ON TV SCREEN

LAZARUS

... Ladies and Gentlemen, the details
are top secret but I can tell you that,
tonight, I will demonstrate a device
which will redefine our world. With the
push of a single button, I will change
what it means to be human!

BACK TO SCENE

Martha turns to the Doctor.

MARTHA

Sorry. You were saying... You should..?

THE DOCTOR

Yes. I should.

He turns and goes back to the door of the Tardis.

THE DOCTOR (CONT'D)

One trip, we said.

(CONTINUED)

1 CONTINUED: (3)

1

MARTHA

Yeah. I suppose things just, kind of,
escalated.

*

THE DOCTOR

Seems to happen to me a lot.

*

She smiles, a little sadly.

MARTHA

Thank you. For everything.

THE DOCTOR

It was my pleasure.

A moment - then he goes into the Tardis, closes the door.

CU on Martha, so sad, as she hears the engines start up.
Stay on her, as she turns away...

Then the engines stop, abruptly. Martha turns back,
delighted -

The Doctor emerges again, frowning.

THE DOCTOR (CONT'D)

No, I'm sorry. Did he say he was going
to *change what it means to be human!*

CUT TO:

OPENING TITLES

2 INT. LAZARUS' OFFICE. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 2

Top floor of a modern building in the heart of London.
LAZARUS gazing out, leaning on his stick. With him is
LADY SYLVIA THAW - a flinty old lady in her seventies.

LADY THAW

Are you sure it's safe?

LAZARUS

There were some issues. They've been
resolved. I'm confident I'll be in no
serious danger.

LADY THAW

That's comforting, Richard, but it
wasn't just you I was worried about.

LAZARUS

Your concern is touching.

(CONTINUED)

2 CONTINUED:

LADY THAW

My concern is financial. The people in that room will represent billions of pounds worth of potential investment. Mr. Saxon wants to be sure they'll like what they see.

LAZARUS

Don't worry. Our friend will get his money's worth.

A knock at the door.

LAZARUS (CONT'D)

Come in.

TISH enters, clutching a piece of paper. She spots Thaw.

TISH

Oh, excuse me, Lady Thaw. You wanted to see the guest lists for tonight, Professor.

Lazarus beams at her - he fancies her.

LAZARUS

Yes, Patricia, thank you.

Tish crosses over to his desk and places the paper in front of him. Lazarus catches hold of her wrist, keeping her beside him. He sniffs.

LAZARUS (CONT'D)

That's an interesting perfume. What's it called?

Thaw's face tightens in annoyance. Tish is mildly repelled by the old guy.

TISH

Soap.

She firmly tugs her wrist free and heads for the door.

CUT TO:

3 EXT. STREET. LONDON - NIGHT 7

3

THE DOCTOR and MARTHA walking in London. Martha has changed into a smart evening dress. The Doctor is in black-tie evening wear.

(CONTINUED)

3 CONTINUED:

3

THE DOCTOR

Black-tie. You know, whenever I wear this, something bad always happens.

MARTHA

That's not the outfit, that's just you. Anyway, I think it suits you - in a James Bond kinda way.

THE DOCTOR

(pleased)

James Bond? Really?

MARTHA

I'm more worried about this dress. What d'you think, how does it look?

The Doctor has found a document in his pocket.

THE DOCTOR

Oh, brilliant!

MARTHA

(flattered)

D'you think so?

THE DOCTOR

Thought I'd lost that. United States Declaration of Independence. First Draft. Before I got them to stick in the bit about the pursuit of happiness.

(remembering)

Thomas Jefferson. He was funny. Spoke Gaelic, you know. Very keen on tomatoes for some reason.

*

Martha sighs.

THE DOCTOR (CONT'D)

(impervious)

Look, that must be the place!

ANGLE ON:

FX: a gleaming, illuminated, corporate sign - 'Lazarus Laboratories.' The top of the building is an impressive, modern, glass and steel creation.

The entrance has been prepared to welcome guests to the event. Lights, barriers, a red carpet, SECURITY and PHOTOGRAPHERS. It is more film premiere than science evening.

(CONTINUED)

3 CONTINUED: (2)

A limo pulls up and a glamorous GUEST steps out - formally dressed - to a barrage of flash photography.

CUT TO:

4 INT. RECEPTION ROOM. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 -MOMENTS LATER

MARTHA and THE DOCTOR come through a set of double doors into the reception room.

MARTHA

Pretty strict about the guest list,
weren't they.

THE DOCTOR

Psychic paper. Works every time.

MARTHA

Yeah. Only you're a bit over-dressed to
be from environmental health.

Martha and the Doctor look around the room, curious.

In the centre, a slightly raised platform, lit like a stage. On it is Lazarus' Genetic Manipulation Device - GMD.

Centred on the platform, a walk-in capsule no bigger than a phone box. Four large arms curve up from the floor to meet at a point above the capsule - like two intersecting arches describing quarter segments of a dome.

The cocktail party is in full swing around this device. GUESTS mill around drinking champagne and chomping on vol-au-vents. A STRING QUARTET provides music. WAITERS and WAITRESSES move among the crowd serving drinks and food from trays.

THE DOCTOR

Look, they've got nibbles! I love
nibbles.

He takes a snack from a passing waiter. TISH appears - bouncing over, clipboard in hand - happy to see Martha - eager to show off.

TISH

Hello!

MARTHA

Tish!

The sisters hug and kiss.

(CONTINUED)

TISH

You look great! So, what d'you think?
Impressive, isn't it?

MARTHA

Very.

*

TISH

And two nights out in a row for you?
That's dangerously close to a social
life!

*

MARTHA

If I keep this up I'll end up in the
gossip columns.

*

TISH

You might actually. You should keep an
eye out for photographers. And Mum.
She's coming too. Even dragging Leo
along with her.

*

*

MARTHA

Leo? In black tie? That I must see!

*

They laugh - then Martha realises she's not introduced
the Doctor yet. Tish is sizing him up.

*

MARTHA (CONT'D)

This is the Doctor.

*

*

The Doctor shakes hands.

*

THE DOCTOR

Hello.

*

*

TISH

Is he with you?

*

*

MARTHA

Yeah.

*

*

TISH

But he's not on the list. How did he get
in?

*

*

MARTHA

(covering)

He's my 'plus one'.

*

*

TISH

You weren't down for 'plus one'.

*

*

4 CONTINUED: (2)

4

THE DOCTOR
So this Lazarus, he's your boss?

TISH
Professor Lazarus, yes. I'm part of his
executive staff.

MARTHA
She's in the PR department.

TISH
I'm head of the PR department, actually.

MARTHA
You're joking!

TISH
(indignant)
Don't sound so shocked!

MARTHA
But you've got no experience!

THE DOCTOR
Is that normal?

TISH
I was on that government scheme. They
saw my potential.

MARTHA
You sure that's all they saw?

TISH
I'm not just here for decoration. I put
this whole thing together.

THE DOCTOR
So do you know what the Professor's
going to be doing tonight? That looks
like it might be a sonic micro-field
manipulator.

TISH
(to Martha)
He's a science geek. I should've known.

She smiles pityingly at her sister.

TISH (CONT'D)
Got to get back to work now. I'll catch
up with you later.

She disappears into the crowd.

(CONTINUED)

4 CONTINUED: (3)

4

THE DOCTOR

'Science geek'? What's that mean?

MARTHA

That you're obsessively enthusiastic
about it.

THE DOCTOR

Ah. Nice.

MARTHA

It wasn't a compliment.

THE DOCTOR

(disappointed)

Oh.

MARTHA

What do we do now?

The Doctor looks around, considering the situation.

THE DOCTOR

Mingle. Mingle and nibble.

CUT TO:

5 INT. RECEPTION ROOM. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 -MOMENTS LATER

FRANCINE and LEO arrive. Francine is agitated.

FRANCINE

Your father's caused me enough heartache
already with his menopause and his
trophy girlfriend.

LEO

Yeah, mum. I know. It was just
something he said last night.

FRANCINE

'Thinking about buying a ring'! What,
for her nose? What an idiot.

LEO

I wish I'd never mentioned it now.

Francine scowls at him. They approach MARTHA and THE
DOCTOR.

MARTHA

Mum!

(CONTINUED)

5 CONTINUED:

5

Martha gives her mum a big hug. Francine is pleased -
kisses Martha - but is a bit surprised.

*
*

FRANCINE

Alright. What's the occasion?

*

MARTHA

What d'you mean? I'm just pleased to see
you, that's all.

FRANCINE

But you saw me last night.

MARTHA

I know, I just ... missed you.

Francine studies Martha curiously.

MARTHA (CONT'D)

(to Leo)

You're looking good, Leo.

LEO

If anyone asks me to fetch them a drink,
I'll swing for them.

FRANCINE

(to Martha)

Is everything alright?

MARTHA

Fine. Why?

*

FRANCINE

I don't know. You seem different. Has
something happened? Are you okay?

MARTHA

(a little evasive)

Yes.

*

Francine notices the Doctor.

*

FRANCINE

You disappeared last night.

*

MARTHA

I .. uhm ... I just went home.

FRANCINE

On your own?

Martha realises her Mum is looking at the Doctor.

*

(CONTINUED)

5 CONTINUED: (2)

5

MARTHA

This is a friend of mine, the Doctor.

FRANCINE

Doctor what?

MARTHA

No, just the Doctor. We've been doing
some work together.

LEO

(shaking hands)

Alright, mate.

The Doctor offers his hand to Francine. She takes it but
is suspicious.

THE DOCTOR

Lovely to meet you Mrs. Jones. Heard a
lot about you.

FRANCINE

Have you? What've you heard then?

THE DOCTOR

Well, that your Martha's mum and ... no,
actually, that's about it really. We've
not had much time to chat, you know.
Been busy.

FRANCINE

Busy? Doing what exactly?

THE DOCTOR

Oh. You know. Stuff.

Before Francine can go on, the lights dim in the room and
come up on the platform.LAZARUS - in black-tie - is climbing onto the platform
with help from a white-coated ASSISTANT.The STRING QUARTET stop playing. Party chatter dies and
an expectant hush falls on the room - people cluster
around the platform.Lazarus - leaning on his stick - raises one arm for
attention.Cameras flash. REPORTERS and PHOTOGRAPHERS scrum at the
front of the stage.

(CONTINUED)

5 CONTINUED: (3)

5

LAZARUS

Ladies and Gentlemen. I'm Professor
Richard Lazarus and tonight I'm going to
perform a miracle!

*
*
*

Two Assistants are busy checking instruments in the
control area to one side.

LAZARUS (CONT'D)

It is, I believe, the most important
advance since Rutherford split the atom.
The biggest leap since Armstrong stood
on the moon.

*
*
*

Applause and excited chattering. More cameras flash.

Lazarus moves to the capsule and pulls open the capsule
door.

*
*

LAZARUS (CONT'D)

Tonight you'll watch and wonder. But
tomorrow, you'll wake to a world which
will be changed forever.

*
*

Tossing the stick aside, Lazarus steps into the capsule
and closes the door.

The Doctor is watching - intrigued and concerned. Martha
is by his shoulder.

*
*

Assistant #1 starts the GMD - he pushes a big red button.

*

Buzzing of power surging through the arches. A high-
pitched whine begins. Prac. light blazes from the arms
of the arches down on the capsule.

Martha screws her eyes against the bright light. The
Doctor is fascinated.

The room begins to shake a little. Light fittings
rattle. Bottles fall off tables.

FX: The GMD in full operation.

TISH is standing near LADY THAW. She is concerned.

TISH

Has he done this before?

*

LADY THAW

Would you want to go through this more
than once?

The Doctor watches, engrossed.

(CONTINUED)

5 CONTINUED: (4)

5

A red warning light blinking on one of the panels in the control area. An audible alarm buzzer sounding.

The Doctor, now concerned.

THE DOCTOR

Something's wrong. It's overloading.

Assistant #1 trying to solve the problem. He's knocked back by a prac explosion at a control panel.

Screams from the audience. They try to back away from the device.

Lady Thaw, frozen, fearing disaster.

The Doctor pushes past her and goes to the control area. He starts to sonic the main control panel.

LADY THAW

Somebody stop him! Get him away from that machine!

One of the Assistants tries to pull him away but the Doctor shrugs him off.

THE DOCTOR

If this goes up it will take the whole building with it! Is that what you want?

Lady Thaw shuts up.

FX: The device shuts down. Lights on the arches fade out. The noise dies. The capsule is no longer pulsing but is brightly lit from within.

The Doctor moves to the capsule but is beaten to it by Martha who is already there.

THE DOCTOR (CONT'D)

Get it open.

Francine - seeing Martha - frowning, vindicated in her suspicions that something is going on.

The Doctor and Martha pull open the capsule door. Prac. Smoke pours out, light blazes. They recoil unable to see anything.

A hand emerges from the smoke and grips the side of the capsule. A figure steps out, unsteady and shrouded in the smoke and light.

(CONTINUED)

5 CONTINUED: (5)

Martha and the Doctor peer through the smoke and are astonished.

Lazarus emerging from the smoke - now a young man - apparently having shed forty years. He is fit, handsome, healthy and radiant with energy.

Lazarus steps forward, steady now. He beams a perfect grin and opens his arms wide.

LAZARUS

Ladies and Gentlemen. I am Richard Lazarus. I'm seventy-six years old. And I'm reborn!

The crowd gasps in disbelief - then goes wild.

Cheering. Applause. Cameras flashing.

Lady Thaw amazed.

LADY THAW

He did it. He actually did it!

*

Lazarus - loving the limelight - god-like.

CUT TO:

6 INT. RECEPTION ROOM. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 -MOMENTS LATER

LAZARUS moving through the crowd arms outstretched. GUESTS surround him, shaking his hand, patting him on the back or just gazing at him in wonder. He is lit by a constant halo of flash photography.

Still on the platform, MARTHA watches him. Beside her, THE DOCTOR is examining the capsule.

MARTHA

That can't be the same guy. It's impossible. It must be a trick.

The Doctor finishes his examination.

THE DOCTOR

(concerned)

It's not a trick. I wish it were.

MARTHA

So what just happened?

(CONTINUED)

6 CONTINUED:

6

THE DOCTOR
(serious)
He just changed what it means to be
human.

CUT TO:

7 INT. RECEPTION ROOM. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - 7
CONTINUOUS

LADY THAW is by LAZARUS' side, even she is mesmerised.
Stroking his cheek.

LADY THAW
That was the most astonishing thing I've
ever seen. Look at you! *

LAZARUS
This is only the beginning. We're not
just making history, we're shaping the
future too. *

LADY THAW
Think of the money we'll make! People
will sell their souls to be transformed
like that. And I'll be first in line! *

Lazarus suddenly shudders slightly. Lady Thaw notices.
Unfazed, Lazarus takes a tray of canapes from a WAITER
and begins to wolf them down. Lady Thaw is slightly
appalled. *

LADY THAW (CONT'D)
Richard!

LAZARUS
I'm famished.

He carries on eating. THE DOCTOR and MARTHA come over.
They notice the hungry appetite. *

THE DOCTOR
Energy deficit. Always happens with
this kind of process.

Lazarus looks up, intrigued.

LAZARUS
You talk as if you see this every day,
Mister..? *

THE DOCTOR
Doctor.
(MORE)

(CONTINUED)

7 CONTINUED:

7

THE DOCTOR (CONT'D)

And no, not every day, but I have
experience of this kind of
transformation.

*

LAZARUS

That's not possible. No-one else is
capable of doing what I've done tonight.

*

*

THE DOCTOR

Oh, it was impressive, I'm not denying
it. Very impressive. Using Hypersonic
sound waves to create a state of
resonance? That's inspired.

LAZARUS

(surprised)

You understand the theory, then?

*

THE DOCTOR

Enough to know that you couldn't
possibly have allowed for all the
variables.

*

LAZARUS

No experiment is completely without
risk.

*

THE DOCTOR

The thing nearly exploded! You might as
well have stepped into a blender!

*

*

Lady Thaw intervenes.

*

LADY THAW

You're not qualified to comment. Your
intervention could've ruined the whole
process.

*

*

*

THE DOCTOR

The process was over. The machine
wouldn't power down. If I hadn't stopped
it, it would've exploded.

*

*

*

LAZARUS

Then I thank you, Doctor. But that's a
simple engineering issue. What happened
in the capsule was exactly what was
supposed to happen. No more. No less.

*

MARTHA

You've no way of knowing that. Not until
you've run proper tests.

*

(CONTINUED)

7 CONTINUED: (2)

7

LAZARUS

Look at me! You can see what happened!
I'm all the proof you need.

*

Martha is unconvinced.

*

LADY THAW

The device will be properly certified
before we start to operate commercially.

*

MARTHA

Commercially? You're joking! That'll
cause chaos.

*

*

LAZARUS

Not chaos - change. A chance for
humanity to evolve. To improve.

*

*

THE DOCTOR

This isn't about improving, this is
about you and your customers living a
little longer.

LAZARUS

Not a little longer, Doctor, a lot
longer. Perhaps indefinitely.

Lady Thaw tries to steer Lazarus away.

LADY THAW

Richard, we have things to discuss.
Upstairs.

*

*

LAZARUS

Goodbye, Doctor.

Lazarus smiles at the Doctor, benign. He turns to Martha
and extends a hand. She takes it.

LAZARUS (CONT'D)

In a few years you'll look back and
laugh at how wrong you were.

*

*

Lazarus kisses her hand - long enough to be clear he's
enjoying it. Then he is gone - into the throng of adoring
GUESTS with Thaw.

THE DOCTOR

He's out of his depth. He's no idea
what damage he might've done.

MARTHA

So what do we do now?

(CONTINUED)

7 CONTINUED: (3)

7

THE DOCTOR

Now? Well, this building must be full of
laboratories, I say we do our own tests.*
*

Martha holds up the hand Lazarus kissed.

MARTHA

Lucky I've just collected a DNA sample,
isn't it.*
*

The Doctor's face lights up.

THE DOCTOR

Martha Jones, you're a star!

CUT TO:

8 OMITTED
THRU
108
THRU
1011 INT. LAZARUS' OFFICE. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 11

LAZARUS is by the window, looking out.

LADY THAW pours two glasses of whisky at the desk. She
joins Lazarus at the window, giving him one glass.LADY THAW
(looking at him)
Quite a view.LAZARUS
I grew up over there. Tiny flat above a
butchers shop.

*

LADY THAW
It'll have a blue plaque soon. Richard
Lazarus lived here.LAZARUS
It's gone. Destroyed in the war. The
bombing.LADY THAW
Of course.LAZARUS
Nineteen-forty. D'you remember? Night
after night. Explosions. Guns.
Firestorms.*
*

(CONTINUED)

11 CONTINUED:

11

LADY THAW

My parents had sent me to the country by then.

LAZARUS

When the sirens went we'd go to the cathedral there. People used to shelter in the crypt. The living, cowering among the dead.

*
*

LADY THAW

It must've been terrifying.

Lazarus' face clouds at the memory.

LAZARUS

The destruction was incredible. Huge areas were reduced to rubble. A wasteland.

She is close to him now. Touching his face.

LADY THAW

But look what you've built here now. What you've done tonight. You've laid the foundations for an empire. An empire we can rule together.

She kisses him passionately. After a moment, Lazarus pushes her away. She is hurt.

LADY THAW (CONT'D)

What's wrong?

Lazarus turns her head to face her reflection in the window.

LAZARUS

Look at yourself, woman.

Lady Thaw looks at her reflection. Alongside Lazarus she is a withered old woman. She snaps the blinds closed angrily.

CUT TO:

12

INT. LAB ROOM. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7

12

CLOSE ON: Computer screen showing a visual analysis of the DNA from the Lazarus sample.

THE DOCTOR and MARTHA are peering at it. Martha isn't sure what's going on. The Doctor is entranced.

(CONTINUED)

12 CONTINUED:

12

THE DOCTOR

Amazing.

MARTHA

What?

THE DOCTOR

Lazarus' DNA.

MARTHA

I can't see anything different.

THE DOCTOR

Look at it.

Martha looks.

CLOSE ON: The familiar double-helix on the screen - then it changes.

Martha is startled.

MARTHA

Oh my God! Did that just change? *

The Doctor nods - excited.

MARTHA (CONT'D)

But it can't have!

THE DOCTOR

But it did.

MARTHA

It's impossible.

THE DOCTOR

And that's two impossible things we've seen so far tonight. Don't you love it when that happens? *

Martha is still trying to work out the DNA.

MARTHA

That means Lazarus has changed his own molecular patterns.

THE DOCTOR

(nodding)

Hypersonic sound waves to destabilise the cell structure. Then a metagenetic program to manipulate the coding in the protein strands.

(MORE)

*

*

*

*

(CONTINUED)

12 CONTINUED: (2)

THE DOCTOR (CONT'D)

Basically, he hacked into his own genes
and instructed them to rejuvenate.*
*

MARTHA

But they're still mutating now.

*

THE DOCTOR

Because he missed something. Something
in his DNA that's been activated and
won't let him stabilise. Something
that's trying to change him.

MARTHA

Change him into what?

THE DOCTOR

I don't know. But I think we need to
find out.

MARTHA

That woman said they were going
upstairs.

The Doctor stands up.

THE DOCTOR

So let's go.

*

CUT TO:

13 INT. LAZARUS' OFFICE. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 13LADY THAW is pacing the room - furious and upset. LAZARUS
is still by the window, impassive.

*

She stops as Lazarus twitches, as if he's pulled a muscle
in his neck.

LADY THAW (CONT'D)

What's going on?

LAZARUS

Must just be -

Another spasm - in his arm this time.

LADY THAW

What is it?

*

LAZARUS

I'll be fine in a moment. Probably just
cramp.

Lady Thaw gets up and goes to him. Just as...

Lazarus doubles over and falls to the floor, spasms
racking his whole body.

LADY THAW

Richard?

CLOSE ON: Lady Thaw's face as she watches him concerned.
The sound of joints cracking, sinews stretching out.

LADY THAW (CONT'D)

Is it some kind of seizure? What should
I do?

(CONTINUED)

13 CONTINUED: (2)

13

Lady Thaw's face shifts - confusion - what's going on? A growl from LAZARUS and a crackling of bone as he stretches out.

LADY THAW (CONT'D)

I don't understand. What's happening?
Richard?

RISING SHOT - LAZARUS' POV:

Lady Thaw's confusion turns to horror - her eyes wide with fear - as Lazarus slowly rises to his full height. She screams as he towers above her.

CUT TO:

14 INT. RECEPTION ROOM. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7

14

The QUARTET are playing again and there is a buzz of excitement among the GUESTS.

FRANCINE and LEO are still drinking champagne.

TISH comes over to join them.

FRANCINE

Have you seen Martha and that Doctor anywhere?

TISH

Not since the demonstration.

LEO

Did you see them when that machine blew up? That was pretty cool.

FRANCINE

Do you know anything about him? Has she ever mentioned him before?

TISH

Not to me.

FRANCINE

So we've never heard of him but she acts like she's known him for ages? The way she followed him onto that platform.

TISH

She's a doctor. She was just doing her job.

(CONTINUED)

14 CONTINUED:

14

FRANCINE

She's not a doctor yet. Never will be if
she doesn't stay focussed.

LEO

Look, she's found a bloke, so what.

FRANCINE

Something's going on, Leo. I can feel
it. She's hiding something and I don't
like it.

CUT TO:

15 INT. RECEPTION ROOM. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - MOMENTS
LATER

LAZARUS appears in the doorway of the reception. He is
back to the handsome young god he was before.

He adjusts his tie - he is wearing a different suit now.
He twists his head and snaps his neck back into place
with a crack. Smiling smugly, he moves into the room.

CUT TO:

16 INT. RECEPTION ROOM. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - MOMENTS
LATER

TISH is cruising through the GUESTS. Suddenly there is a
hand on her arm and she finds herself standing with
LAZARUS -who is beaming with confidence - surrounded by a
group of fawning guests.

LAZARUS

Patricia Jones!
(whispering in her ear)
I'd recognise the smell of that soap
anywhere!

Tish is a little nervous.

TISH

Professor.

LAZARUS

(grinning)

I'm sorry, ladies and gentlemen,
you'll have to excuse me while I take
care of Patricia here. I've been
neglecting her.

Lazarus winks at them and steers Tish away from the
group. He grins at her.

(CONTINUED)

16 CONTINUED:

16

LAZARUS (CONT'D)

Thank you for rescuing me.

TISH

I'm sorry. I didn't realise. Were those
people causing a problem?

*
*

LAZARUS

No. No problem. But it's nice to know
that someone has my best interests at
heart.

Tish is flattered.

TISH

It's my job. I try to do my best.

*

LAZARUS

Such dedication. I like that. It's a
rare quality these days.

Tish blushes, warming to him now.

TISH

Well, you know, I'm always here. If you
need anything.

Lazarus flirts.

LAZARUS

That's a comforting thought. I'll
remember that.

Tish smiles.

CUT TO:

17 INT. LAZARUS' OFFICE. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 17

MARTHA and THE DOCTOR push open the door. They switch on
the light and come inside.

MARTHA

This is his office alright.

THE DOCTOR

So where is he?

MARTHA

Let's try back at the reception.

*

The Doctor nods. They head back out.

(CONTINUED)

17

CONTINUED:

17

As Martha reaches the door something propped behind it falls to the floor at her feet. She looks down and finds herself staring at the shrunken, desiccated face of LADY THAW - now a shrivelled, leathery husk.

Martha lets out a short scream. The Doctor stoops over the husk to examine it.

Martha recovering from the shock.

MARTHA (CONT'D)

Is that human? *

THE DOCTOR

Used to be. It's just a shell now. Had all the life energy drained out of her. Like squeezing the juice out of an orange.

So he's changed already.

THE DOCTOR

(shrugs)

The Doctor nods. Martha is off, heading out the door. The Doctor tears himself away from the husk and goes after her.

CUT TO:

18

INT. CORRIDOR. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - CONTINUOUS

THE DOCTOR and MARTHA reach the lifts, breathless. The Doctor prods at the button.

MARTHA

Come on. Come on.

(CONTINUED)

18

CONTINUED:

18

The lift doors open and they step inside. The doors close and it starts to descend.

An ascending lift arrives alongside. Lift doors open. LAZARUS steps out with TISH - laughing at a shared joke - very flirtatious now.

LAZARUS

You seem very young to have such a responsible position. Have you much experience?

TISH

Not really. But the interview panel thought I had all the necessary attributes.

LAZARUS

How perceptive of them.

Tish smiles - enjoying this.

TISH

So, where are you taking me? *

LAZARUS

Up to the roof. It's a lovely evening. I thought I would show you the view. It's extraordinary. *

TISH

Like a lot of things round here, then. *

Lazarus smiles. They head down the corridor. Lazarus quietly clicking his neck again. *

CUT TO:

19

INT. RECEPTION ROOM. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - MONENTS
LATER

THE DOCTOR and MARTHA emerge from the lifts and then hurry into the party, scanning as they move through the GUESTS.

MARTHA

I can't see him.

THE DOCTOR

He can't be far. Keep looking.

They move through the crowd and suddenly find themselves beside LEO - FRANCINE is nearby. *

(CONTINUED)

19 CONTINUED:

19

LEO

Alright, Marth. I think Mum wants to
talk to you.

*
*
*

MARTHA

Believe me, Leo, Mum's the least of my
problems at the moment. Have you seen
Lazarus anywhere?

*
*
*

LEO

Well, he was getting cosy with Tish a
couple of minutes ago.

*

*

MARTHA

With Tish?!

FRANCINE

(spotting them)

Ah. Doctor. Maybe we could finish our
chat. We were interrupted.

LATER

MARTHA and THE DOCTOR burst in, breathless. The office is
just as they left it.

MARTHA

(desperate)

Where are they?

THE DOCTOR

The fluctuating DNA'll give off an
energy signature. I might be able to
pick it up.

The Doctor takes out the sonic screwdriver and moves
around looking for a direction indication. He stops.

THE DOCTOR (CONT'D)

Got him.

MARTHA

Where?

The Doctor's gaze follows where the screwdriver is
pointing - upwards.

MARTHA (CONT'D)

But this is the top floor!

She realises.

MARTHA (CONT'D)

The roof!

CUT TO:

21 EXT. ROOF. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7

21

FX: LAZARUS and TISH are enjoying the view of the city, including Southwark Cathedral.

TISH

That clock tower is beautiful - all lit up like that.

LAZARUS

It's Southwark Cathedral. One of the oldest churches in London. Been around even longer than I have.

Tish turns to look at the professor.

TISH

But you're looking pretty good for your age!

*
*

LAZARUS

Thank you.

She reaches out to touch his face.

TISH

Can I ..?

LAZARUS

Of course.

He moves close to her. She strokes his cheek.

TISH

LAZARUS

(smiling)

I'm still adjusting, myself. I've been working toward it for so many years - it's hard to believe the moment's finally arrived.

TISH

And is it like you expected?

LAZARUS

I find that nothing's ever exactly like you expect. There's always something to surprise you. "Between the idea and the reality, Between the motion and the act . . ."

THE DOCTOR (O.S.)
" ... Falls the shadow."

Lazarus and Tish whirl round.

THE DOCTOR and MARTHA have joined them - though keeping a safe distance away.

Tish is annoyed. Lazarus seems calm.

LAZARUS
So, the mysterious Doctor knows his Eliot. I'm impressed.

TISH
Martha! What're you doing here?

MARTHA
Tish, get away from him!

TISH
What? Don't tell me what to do.

She doesn't move.

THE DOCTOR
I wouldn't have thought you had time for poetry, Lazarus. What with you being so busy defying the laws of nature and everything.

LAZARUS
You're right, Doctor. One lifetime's been too short for me to do everything I would like. How much more I'll get done in two or three or four.

THE DOCTOR
It doesn't work like that. Some people live more in twenty years than others do in eighty. It's not the time that matters, it's the person.

LAZARUS
But if it's the *right* person? What a gift that would be!

THE DOCTOR
Or what a curse. Look at what you've done to yourself.

Lazarus glares at him.

Who are you to judge me?

MARTHA

Over here, Tish. Come to me.

Tish moves away from Lazarus toward her sister - but only to argue with her.

TISH

(hissing)

You have to spoil everything, don't you.

Lazarus' neck spasms suddenly. The Doctor and Martha notice. Tish has her back to him.

TISH (CONT'D)

Every time I meet someone nice you have to try and find fault.

Lazarus' arms spasm - as before.

MARTHA

Tish, he's a monster!

TISH

I know the age thing's a bit freaky - but it works for Catherine Zeta Jones!

Lazarus' whole body twists and he falls to the ground.

CLOSE ON: The Doctor's face transfixed.

CLOSE ON: Martha horrified.

Then, Tish turns round to see what they are both looking at. The sound of Lazarus transforming. She can't believe what she sees.

FX: The back of Lazarus' jacket splits as a bony spine bursts out.

FX: A cracking of bones as the 'creature' Lazarus uncoils and stretches up to his full height with Southwark Cathedral behind.

CLOSE ON: Tish's face. Horrified - then a loud scream.

Terrified, Tish backs away from Lazarus and bumps into Martha and the Doctor.

TISH (CONT'D)

(in shock)

What is that?

(CONTINUED)

21 CONTINUED: (3)

21

MARTHA

That's your boss.

Tish is frozen in shock. Tight on Martha and the Doctor as they drag her toward the door. -

CUT TO:

22 INT. STAIRWELL. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - CONTINUOUS

MARTHA and TISH come through the doorway and run downstairs.

THE DOCTOR comes through behind them and slams the door shut, sliding a bolt across to lock it.

Lazarus hits it from the other side with a loud clang and a roar of anger. The door shudders with the impact.

CUT TO:

23 INT. CORRIDOR. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - CONTINUOUS

MARTHA and TISH run down the corridor. THE DOCTOR close behind them. They reach the lifts and hit the call button. Tish is still in shock.

MARTHA

You okay?

TISH

I was gonna snog him!

*

*

Loud banging from the door to the roof.

CUT TO:

24 INT. STAIRWELL. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - CONTINUOUS

The door to the roof receives another serious blow. This time it partly caves in.

The lights go off - emergency lighting kicks in.

CUT TO:

25 INT. RECEPTION ROOM. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - 25
CONTINUOUS

The room is plunged into the gloom of emergency lighting.

The emergency exit locks with a loud thud.

(CONTINUED)

25

CONTINUED:

25

A single scream. The QUARTET stop playing. The GUESTS look around - anxious, waiting for instructions.

CUT TO:

26

INT. CORRIDOR. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - CONTINUOUS

THE DOCTOR, MARTHA and TISH are in the same dim emergency lighting state.

MARTHA

What's happening?

TISH

(trying to remember)

An intrusion ... it triggers a security lock down. Kills most of the power.
Stops the lifts. Seals the exits.

THE DOCTOR

(looking up)

He must be breaking through that door.

He starts back toward the stairwell.

THE DOCTOR (CONT'D)

The stairs, hurry.

They follow him.

CUT TO:

27

INT. STAIRWELL. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - MOMENTS LATER

THE DOCTOR, MARTHA and TISH racing down the stairs.

Above them, a huge crashing sound as Lazarus finally smashes through the roof door. A loud roar echoes down the stairwell.

MARTHA

He's inside!

THE DOCTOR

Then we haven't got much time.

*

CUT TO:

28

INT. RECEPTION ROOM. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - 28
CONTINUOUS

The GUESTS are becoming restless.

(CONTINUED)

28

CONTINUED:

28

THE DOCTOR, MARTHA and TISH burst through the doors and into the room.

*

THE DOCTOR

Tish, is there another way out of here?

Tish points to the far corner.

TISH

There's an exit in the corner but it'll be locked now.

*

THE DOCTOR

Martha! Setting fifty-four. Hurry.

The Doctor throws Martha the Sonic Screwdriver. She catches it and hurries toward the exit. Tish follows her.

THE DOCTOR (CONT'D)

(shouting)

Listen to me! You people are in serious danger. You need to get out of here.

Right now!

The Guests are uncertain. One sceptical FEMALE GUEST is near the doors.

FEMALE GUEST

Don't be ridiculous! The biggest danger here is choking on an olive.

*

*

FX: LAZARUS crashes into the room, fierce and raging.

A moment of shock, then complete chaos as the guests try to get away from the creature - pushing, screaming, elbowing. Tables are overturned. Bottles, trays and plates crash to the floor.

FX: LAZARUS moves into the room, pushing tables out of his path.

LEO is with FRANCINE. A table flips towards them. Leo tries to protect his mum.

*

*

LEO

Mum!

He pulls her out of the way but the table whacks him on the side of the head.

*

*

Martha - Tish beside her - sonics open the emergency exit.

(CONTINUED)

28 CONTINUED: (2)

28

MARTHA

(shouting)

Over here! This way. Everyone down the
stairs, now! Hurry.Guests start to flee downstairs, yelling, clamouring and
fighting to get out.

MARTHA (CONT'D)

Don't push! Head for the foyer! Keep
moving!

CLOSE ON: The Female Guest's face - terrified.

FX: Lazarus looms over the Female Guest - his 'tail'
moving in to 'drain' her.

The Doctor sees what's about to happen.

THE DOCTOR

No! Get away from her!

Too late. A husk falls to the floor of the room - all
that's left of the Female Guest.Francine is crouched over Leo who is on the floor, dazed.
Francine cradles his head.

FRANCINE

Leo?

Leo opens his eyes and stares at something behind
Francine. She turns to see.

FX: Lazarus looms over Leo and a horrified Francine.

The Doctor into Lazarus' field of vision to draw his
attention.

THE DOCTOR

Lazarus! Leave them alone!

FX: Lazarus turns to glare at the Doctor.

Martha hurries to help Francine and Leo.

THE DOCTOR (CONT'D)

(to Lazarus)

What's the point? You can't control it.
The mutation is too strong. Killing
these people won't help you.

FX: Close on Lazarus' face.

(CONTINUED)

28 CONTINUED: (3)

28

THE DOCTOR (CONT'D)

You're a fool. A vain, old man who thought he could defy nature. Only nature got her own back, didn't she.

FX: Close on Lazarus' face - snarling.

The Doctor - ready to run.

THE DOCTOR (CONT'D)

You're a joke, Lazarus. A footnote in the history of failure.

FX: Close on Lazarus' face - roaring.

The Doctor belts out the door.

CUT TO:

29 INT. CORRIDOR. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - CONTINUOUS

The Doctor turns a corner. Keeps going. A second or two later:

FX: Lazarus rounding the same corner, furious and fast.

CUT TO:

30 INT. RECEPTION ROOM. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - 30 CONTINUOUS

MARTHA, FRANCINE and LEO arrive back at the exit. TISH is there. There are still people crushing to get out through the door. Screaming. Martha leaps onto a table.

MARTHA

(yelling)

Listen to me! If you panic, more people will die. You've got to stop pushing, stay calm and keep moving. Do you hear me!

The GUESTS respond to her authority.

MARTHA (CONT'D)

That's it. We're all going to get out of here. Just keep calm.

She jumps down from the table and heads for the injured Leo.

TISH

What's the Doctor doing?

*

(CONTINUED)

30 CONTINUED:

30

MARTHA

He's trying to buy us some time. Let's
not waste it.

She gently examines the bump now showing on Leo's head.

*

LEO

Aow!

*

Martha checks his eyes.

MARTHA

Leo, look at me. Focus on me. Let me see
your eyes.

Leo struggles a little, still dazed.

MARTHA (CONT'D)

He's got a concussion.

She looks at the debris around them and grabs a napkin
and some ice and improvises an ice-pack. She hands it to
Francine.

MARTHA (CONT'D)

Mum, you'll need to help him downstairs.
This'll keep the swelling down.

*

Francine notes Martha's coolness and authority.

MARTHA (CONT'D)

Go on. I'll be right behind you.

Francine helps Leo through the exit.

MARTHA (CONT'D)

Tish, move! We need to get out of here.

Tish follows her mum. Martha yells into the stairwell.

*

MARTHA (CONT'D)

Don't block the stairs. Keep moving!

Martha looks back into the room, it is trashed but empty.
She glances at the door where Lazarus disappeared after
the Doctor. Then she turns and follows the others.

CUT TO:

31 INT. CORRIDOR. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7

31

THE DOCTOR running.

(CONTINUED)

31 CONTINUED:

31

He turns a corner and finds himself at a dead end - a single doorway facing him. He tries the door. It is unlocked.

CUT TO:

32 INT. STORE ROOM. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - CONTINUOUS

THE DOCTOR enters the store room. It is a large room with various boxes stacked on rows of metal shelving. With the emergency lighting, the room is in near-darkness.

The Doctor moves behind one of the racks and hides.

FX: LAZARUS sinister in shadow.

The Doctor listens to the creature's movements.

LAZARUS (O.S.)

It's no good, Doctor. You can't stop me.

The Doctor moves between the racks, trying to confuse Lazarus.

THE DOCTOR

Is that the same arrogance you had when you swore that nothing had gone wrong with your device?

He moves quietly toward the back of the room.

FX: CLOSE Lazarus with drooling mouth.

The Doctor still again, listening. The sound of Lazarus creeping along nearby.

LAZARUS (O.S.)

(rasping)

The arrogance is yours. You can't stand in the way of progress.

THE DOCTOR

You call feeding on innocent people 'progress'? You're delusional!

The Doctor moves quietly again. Cat and Mouse with Lazarus. He begins to creep back toward the door.

LAZARUS (O.S.)

(rasping)

It is a necessary sacrifice!

THE DOCTOR

That's not your decision to make.

(CONTINUED)

32 CONTINUED:

32

The Doctor makes a final move. He is close to the door again - but he can hear Lazarus nearby. He stops and waits.

CUT TO:

33 INT. FOYER. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - CONTINUOUS 33

The foyer is busy with shocked and panicking GUESTS filing into the space from the stairwell. Security shutters have closed on the front door, preventing escape.

Alarms are sounding. People shouting, crying, banging on the shutters. 'Help us' 'We're going to die!'

MARTHA emerges from the stairwell behind TISH, LEO and FRANCINE. Tish starts to panic.

TISH

We can't get out! We're trapped!

Martha grabs her.

MARTHA

There must be an over-ride switch.
Where's the security desk? Tish!

Tish points.

TISH

There.

*

Martha starts to force her way through the mob.

CUT TO:

34 INT. SECURITY STATION. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - 34
CONTINUOUS

MARTHA finds the security station and clammers over the counter.

On the other side - monitors and warning lights are flashing, alarm buzzers are sounding. There is a keypad mounted on the wall - with flashing red light.

Martha sonics the key pad.

The emergency lighting cuts out. The main lights flicker back on. The alarms stop. The security shutters start to rise.

(CONTINUED)

34 CONTINUED:

34

Martha stands up, laughing with relief.

CUT TO:

34A INT. STORE ROOM. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - CONTINUOUSTHE DOCTOR is at the door of the store room when suddenly
the main lights flicker on and the room is fully lit.FX: Right in front of the Doctor stands LAZARUS - nose to
nose.

THE DOCTOR

Oh. Hello!

The Doctor yanks open the door to make his escape.

CUT TO:

35 INT. CORRIDOR. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - CONTINUOUS

THE DOCTOR comes running out of the store room -

CUT TO:

36 INT. FOYER. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - MOMENTS LATERThe foyer is clearing as GUESTS flood out the opened
doors. FRANCINE, LEO and TISH are at the back of the
throng heading outside. MARTHA is still with them.

TISH

Thank God! I didn't think we were ever
going to make it out of here.

Martha stops.

MARTHA

I've got to go back.

FRANCINE

You can't! You saw what that thing did.
It'll kill you.

MARTHA

I don't care. I have to go.

Francine realises - gripping Martha's arm.

FRANCINE

It's that Doctor, isn't it. That's
what's happened to you. That's why
you've changed.

(CONTINUED)

TISH

He was buying us time, Martha. Time for
you to get out too.

MARTHA

I'm not leaving him.

Martha pulls free from Francine's grip and heads back
toward the stairwell door.

FRANCINE

Martha!

Tish pulls Francine and Leo toward the exit.

CUT TO:

37

INT. LAB ROOM. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - CONTINUOUS

THE DOCTOR comes belting into a long darkened lab room, breathless. He looks around for possible weapons but the room is pretty bare. The lab has two doors - one at each end.

He has an idea. He hops up onto one of the benches and yanks the bulb fitting from the light, exposing the bare wires. He adjusts the wires so they are barely touching.

CLOSE ON - The Doctor's face, waiting, listening. Then a noise - claws on floor tiles. Stools being knocked aside.

LAZARUS (O.S.)

(rasping)

More hide and seek, Doctor? How
disappointing. Why don't you come out
and face me?

The Doctor, still hiding.

THE DOCTOR

Have you looked in a mirror lately?

He stands up.

THE DOCTOR (CONT'D)

Why would I want to face that?

FX: LAZARUS - glaring at him, menacing in the half-light.

(CONTINUED)

37 CONTINUED:

37

The Doctor meeting his gaze - like two gunfighters. Then the Doctor dives out the door at his end of the room - banging on the light switch as he goes.

CUT TO:

38 INT. CORRIDOR. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - CONTINUOUS

FX: THE DOCTOR comes flying out the door. Behind him the Lab explodes.

CUT TO:

39 INT. CORRIDOR. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - CONTINUOUS

MARTHA looking for him, hears the explosion. She starts to run in the direction of the sound.

CUT TO:

40 INT. CORRIDOR. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - MOMENTS LATER

MARTHA running, turns a corner and bangs straight into THE DOCTOR coming in the opposite direction.

THE DOCTOR
What are you doing here?

MARTHA
Returning this.

She hands him the sonic screwdriver.

MARTHA (CONT'D)
Thought you might need it.

THE DOCTOR
How did you -

MARTHA
Heard the explosion. Guessed it was you.

THE DOCTOR
I blasted Lazarus.

MARTHA
Did you kill him?

A roar, they look up to the end of the corridor.

FX: LAZARUS comes round the corner, furious and fast toward them.

(CONTINUED)

40 CONTINUED:

40

THE DOCTOR
More, sort of, annoyed him, I'd say.

The Doctor and Martha run.

CUT TO:

41 EXT. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7

41

The shocked and injured are huddled in weeping clusters around the front of the building.

TISH, FRANCINE and LEO stand together, looking back at the building they evacuated - worried.

TISH
(uncertain)
She'll be alright. The Doctor and her.
They'll look out for each other.

FRANCINE
She turned her back on us and went in there with that thing. For him.

LEO
Must be some guy.

TISH
Maybe she loves him.

FRANCINE
She's just met him!

A MAN approaches - the mysterious stranger who spoke to Francine earlier.

MAN
Is your daughter still in there? With the Doctor?

FRANCINE
Do you know him?

MAN
He's dangerous. There are things you should know.

Francine urgent, moves close to him.

FRANCINE
What things?

The Man looks around. He leans in close to Francine and begins to whisper in her ear.

(CONTINUED)

CUT TO: *

42 INT. RECEPTION ROOM. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - MOMENTS LATER

The now-deserted reception room. MARTHA and THE DOCTOR come running through the doors - breathless. *

MARTHA

What now? We've gone round in a circle. *

The Doctor sizes the place up - fast. *

THE DOCTOR

Come on.

He jumps onto the platform and goes to the capsule. *

THE DOCTOR (CONT'D)

Get inside. Quickly.

Martha is confused but steps into the capsule. The Doctor squeezes in beside her.

FX: LAZARUS coming into the reception room. He spots them.

The Doctor pulls the capsule door closed.

CUT TO:

43 INT. CAPSULE - NIGHT 7 - CONTINUOUS

THE DOCTOR and MARTHA are pressed together - very intimate.

MARTHA

(whispering)

Are we hiding?

THE DOCTOR

No. He knows we're here. But this is his masterpiece, I'm betting he won't destroy it - not even to get at us.

MARTHA

But we're trapped.

THE DOCTOR

Well, yeah, that is a slight problem.

(CONTINUED)

MARTHA

You mean you don't have a plan?

THE DOCTOR

Yes. The plan was to get inside here.

MARTHA

Then what?

THE DOCTOR

Well, then I would come up with another plan.

A noise from outside.

MARTHA

MARTHA reflecting while THE DOCTOR fiddles beneath her.

I still don't understand where that
thing came from. Is it alien?

THE DOCTOR is working urgently at her feet on the wiring
on the floor of the capsule with the sonic screwdriver *

No. For once. It's strictly human in

Exactly.

A moment. *

THE DOCTOR (CONT'D)

Nice shoes, by the way. *

CUT TO:

48 INT. RECEPTION ROOM. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - 48
CONTINUOUS

FX: LAZARUS pushes the red button to activate the GMD.

Power buzzes through the arches once more.

CUT TO:

49 INT. CAPSULE - NIGHT 7 - CONTINUOUS 49

MARTHA suddenly alert and anxious as the capsule lights up and she hears the noise of the power-up. *

MARTHA

Doctor? What's happening? *

THE DOCTOR

It sounds like he's switched the machine on. *

And that's not good, is it. *

At her feet, THE DOCTOR frowning with concentration as he tries to finish his rewiring job.

Well, I was hoping it might take him a little bit longer to work that out. *

We're going to end up like him!

THE DOCTOR tense.

THE DOCTOR
Just one more -

The final wire is plugged in.

CUT TO:

CONTINUOUS

FX: The GMD stops spinning suddenly. Lazarus is caught
in a wave of sonic energy. He screams in agony.

FX: Lazarus falls down dead, hits the floor with a smack!

The GMD is shrouded in smoke.

After a moment, THE DOCTOR and MARTHA emerge unsteadily from the capsule.

MARTHA

(shaken)

I thought we were going to go through the blender then.

THE DOCTOR

It shouldn't really take that long just to reverse the polarity. I must be a bit out of practice.

They cross to the body.

Lazarus' body - young man - is lying naked and lifeless.

They gaze down.

MARTHA

He seems so ... human again. It's kind of pitiful.

THE DOCTOR

Death is, mostly. Eliot saw that too.
"This is the way the world ends, Not with a bang but a whimper"

CUT TO:

51 OMITTED
AND
52

51
AND
52

53 EXT. LAZARUS LABORATORIES - NIGHT 7 - MOMENTS LATER

53

Sound of sirens as emergency services finally begin to respond.

THE DOCTOR and MARTHA emerge from the building.

The Doctor turns and watches PARAMEDICS emerge behind them with LAZARUS on a stretcher. They pull the blanket over his face - dead. The stretcher is loaded into an ambulance.

TISH rushes over and flings her arms round her sister.

TISH

She's here! She's alright!

The Doctor is watching the ambulance pull away.

Look around you. Nothing but death and
destruction.

MARTHA

This isn't his fault. He saved us. All

And it was Tish who invited everybody to

say, technically, it was her fault.

Tish punches Leo on the arm.

Loud sound of a car crash.

The Doctor is immediately alert. He looks at Martha then
runs off to investigate.

Martha hesitates - a long look from Francine.

(CONTINUED)

FRANCINE

Leave him.

Martha shakes her head. She goes off after him.

TISH

(concerned)

Martha?

Tish moves to go after her sister. Francine is shocked.

FRANCINE

Not you too.

TISH

(shrugs)

Sorry.

Tish runs after Martha.

CUT TO:

54 EXT. STREET. LONDON - NIGHT 7 - CONTINUOUS

54

The ambulance has veered off the road and crashed into a wall. The back doors swing open.

The Doctor arrives. Martha just behind him. They fear the worst. Cautiously, they look inside the ambulance. They find two husks - the paramedics.

THE DOCTOR

Lazarus, back from the dead. Should've known, really.

MARTHA

Where's he gone?

The Doctor has the sonic out, working out which direction Lazarus has gone. TISH arrives.

Cathedral. It's Southwark Cathedral.
He told me.

FX: Behind the ambulance rises Southwark Cathedral.

They head toward it.

CUT TO:

THE DOCTOR, MARTHA and TISH enter the Cathedral cautiously. At first glance it appears deserted. The Doctor scans with the sonic screwdriver.

MARTHA

The screwdriver picks something up. They head slowly down the aisle toward the transept.

So are you.

Lazarus laughs then spasms again - still unstable.

The Doctor is looking around him - trying to see if there is anything he can use. Trying to come up with a plan.

LAZARUS

In the morning. The fires had died but I was still alive. I swore I'd never face death like that again. So defenceless. I would arm myself. Fight back. Defeat it.

THE DOCTOR

That's what you were trying to do today?

LAZARUS

That's what I *did* today.

THE DOCTOR

And what about the other people who died?

LAZARUS

They were nothing. I changed the course of history.

THE DOCTOR

Any of them might've done too. You think history is only made with equations?

The Doctor still checking out the interior of the Cathedral. Organ. Tower. Pulpit. Choir. The seed of an idea forming.

LAZARUS

That's a price worth paying.

THE DOCTOR

Is it?

Martha moves away from the Doctor. Tish follows.
