EXT. A FOREST - EARLY MORNING - DAY

1

We're deep in a forest. Twisted branches. Rattling leaves. Slashes of light and ... the drumming of footsteps. *

Someone is running. Someone is scared. Someone is lost. A girl in school uniform - MAEBH - hurries through the trees. Twigs snap at her face, bracken scratches her legs. She stops, looks around. She swats at the air as though molested by mosquitos.

She spots a path. Relieved, she follows it. Comes to a fork. Which way now? Mosquitos again. She tries to bat them away. Takes the left fork. But then stops. Something rattles in the bracken. A thick cloud of what looks like mosquitos rise out of it. She turns and runs.

Crash. Whatever was in the bracken has heard and is chasing her. She keeps running until she comes to a clearing.

There, incongruously, is a blue police box. Without a backward glance she dashes over to it. Reads the sign "Assistance Available". Perfect. She knocks on the door and keeps knocking until the door opens and THE DOCTOR looks out.

THE DOCTOR is taken aback to see a visitor.

MAEBH:
I'm lost. Please can you help me?

THE DOCTOR:
(DISMISSIVE) It's ... that way.

He goes back in, closing the door behind him. But then comes back. *

THE DOCTOR: (cont'd)
Are those ... trees?

MAEBH:
I need the Doctor. Are you the Doctor?

THE DOCTOR:
Yes. Do you have an appointment?
You need an appointment to see a doctor.

MAEBH:
Please. Something's chasing me.

He goes in, leaving the door open for her. She follows him in.

CUT TO:

2

INT. TARDIS - DAY

2

MAEBH comes in. THE DOCTOR hurries to the console. *

THE DOCTOR:

When you drink a glass of Coke,
it's only this big (small) but it's
actually got this much (huge) sugar
in it? It works a bit like that ..

MAEBH:

What does?

THE DOCTOR:

This. The TARDIS. It's bigger on
the inside than on the outside. Or
did you not notice?

MAEBH:

I just thought it was supposed to
be bigger on the inside so I didn't
say anything.

THE DOCTOR:

Of course it's supposed to be. Most
people find that confusing.

MAEBH:

I find everything confusing nearly.
So I don't say anything. That's how
come I'm in the woods. I thought
Miss Oswald told me to find the
Doctor, but it wasn't her. It was
just in my head.

THE DOCTOR looks up.

THE DOCTOR:

Miss Oswald? Dark hair. Highly
unpredictable? Surprisingly round
face?

MAEBH:

Everyone says she's in love with
Mr. Pink.

THE DOCTOR:

The PE teacher?

MAEBH:

Maths. I really like him. I was in
his group.

THE DOCTOR busies himself starting up the TARDIS.

THE DOCTOR:

Mr. Pink was looking after you.
That explains why you're lost. It
doesn't surprise you that I know
all about your school?

MAEBH:

Everyone seems to know everything
about everything apart from me.

2 CONTINUED:

2

THE DOCTOR:

Not quite everything. I for instance have no idea why - when the terrestrial navigator boots up - it closes down all the other systems.

MAEBH:

You should ask someone who knows.

THE DOCTOR:

Another of the drawbacks of being the last of your species. No one to ask when your TARDIS won't start.

The TARDIS boots up. But almost immediately a Tom Tom type voice announces "You have arrived at your destination" and the engines close down again. THE DOCTOR howls.

MAEBH:
Where are you trying to get to?

*

"You have arrived at your destination."

THE DOCTOR:
No! We haven't. (TO MAEBH) We're supposed to be in the middle of London.

"You have arrived at your destination."

THE DOCTOR: (cont'd)
(TO THE SATNAV) Stop saying that!

MAEBH:
She's only saying it because it's true. We are in the middle of London.

*

THE DOCTOR:
We're in the middle of a forest.

MAEBH:
Come and see ...

*

She grabs his hand and leads him out.

CUT TO:

3

EXT. TRAFALGAR SQUARE - DAY

3

MAEBH leads THE DOCTOR through the trees, past a massive statue of a lion - half-obscured by the undergrowth. Beyond that, there's a colossal plinth and rising from it, up through the branches, a huge, fluted column.

MAEBH:
... Nelson's Column. D'you like it?

THE DOCTOR:
Do I ... I'm sorry, what?

MAEBH:
D'you like the forest being in
Trafalgar Square? I think it's
lovely.

THE DOCTOR stares at her. Then he stares at Nelson's column.

FX: Off THE DOCTOR's gaze the camera travels upwards, up the trunks of the trees, through the branches above the canopy itself ...

FX: We see the familiar landmarks of the London skyline - the Post Office Tower, Big Ben, the Shard and the dome of St. Paul's dawning over a billowing cloudbank of leaves.

TITLES: In The Forest of The Night ...

INT. MUSEUM - MORNING - DAY

4 *

Come in on the a life-sized stuffed wolf. *

Spread out on the floor beneath is a group of CHILDREN from Coal Hill School, packed into sleeping bags. It's the end of an "enrichment sleepover." Suddenly a flash of blinding light blasts the faces of the groggy CHILDREN. One of the kids - BRADLEY - is shining an incredibly bright torch right into the face of one of the other kids - SAMSON.

SAMSON:
Brad-ley!! Sir!! Tell him, sir.
He's blinding me.

His pleading has no effect on BRADLEY.

DANNY:
Give me that, Bradley.

BRADLEY:
I'm allowed a torch, sir. I've got a note. I'm darkness phobic.

SAMSON:
Just because he's scared of the dark, sir, does that mean he's allowed (... to blind me?).

DANNY:
You're allowed a torch, Bradley,
not a pocket supernova.

The teachers in charge are DANNY and CLARA. DANNY is already addressing the KIDS ...

DANNY: (cont'd)
OK listen up. A few things to run through before we head home. Put your phone away, Bradley.
(MORE)

4 CONTINUED:

DANNY: (cont'd)
First of all, collect any rubbish
you've generated through midnight
feasts or whatever ...

CUT TO:

5

INT. MUSEUM. MAIN DOOR / EXT. MUSEUM - DAY

5 *

DANNY is now leading the KIDS towards the main door. It's still locked. There seems to be no sign of life.

DANNY:
Hello, hello!

The lack of response is unsettling. The KIDS are unsettled. SAMSON buries his head in the hood of his coat.

DANNY tries the door. It won't budge. From somewhere unseen, there's a cough. An unhappy elderly security guard (GEORGE) appears. *

GEORGE:
I'm supposed to have been relieved
you know.

DANNY:
Coal Hill School. Sleepover.

GEORGE shushes him. Apparently opening the doors is a taxing process, including key codes, something to do with a green button and the drawing of the noisy bolts.

DANNY: (cont'd)
Our coach back to school should be
here.

GEORGE stops what he's doing and stares at DANNY.

GEORGE:
It's not like opening a jar of
pickles you know. This is a high
security installation. *

DANNY accepts the need for quiet. GEORGE gets on with it. *

CLARA notices that RUBY has drifted off to the tree cross-section.

RUBY:
Why is this one so fat, Miss?

CLARA:
Because it was alive so long.

RUBY:
This ring though. All the other
rings are thin but this one's fat
and red, see?

CLARA:
Must have been a good year to be a
tree. Come on, Ruby.

Finally the door unlocking is completed. GEORGE tries to barge it open, but nothing happens.

GEORGE:
Hang on. There's a knack to this.

He tries to begin the whole thing again.

DANNY:
No. It moved. It's not locked, it's
jammed. Come on team ...

He puts his shoulder to the door. The KIDS don't move. He strains against the door. Notices he's on his own.

DANNY: (cont'd)
I said, come on, team.

SAMSON:
What team?

CLARA shoves them all against the door. Even GEORGE joins in. The door creaks open a little way. Enough for SAMSON to slip through. From the other side of the door ...

SAMSON: (cont'd)
Wow. Sir, where are we?

DANNY:
What d'you mean where are we?

RUBY goes through next and also expresses amazement. Finally DANNY and CLARA wriggle through ... and we see what the others have been seeing.

They are not looking out onto London but into a thick, deciduous forest.

RUBY:
We can't have been asleep that long, can we?

Her first instinct is to take a picture with her phone. The other KIDS all get their phones out and start taking pictures. The moment they do so their phones buzz.

SAMSON checks his.

SAMSON:
Woah look at this. That's our Robbie. That's outside school. Coal Hill is bare trees, too.

CLARA looks at the phone. There's a picture of a couple of TEENAGE LADS giving the thumbs up in front of the Coal Hill sign, in what seems to be the middle of the greenwood.

INT. BBC BREAKFAST - DAY

6

BILL TURNBULL is speaking from the studio.

BILL:

Perplexing reports from all over the country of; what would you call it? An unexpected horticultural development ... Jenny ...

CUT TO NEWSREEL
OF THE DISASTER
FROM ALL OVER
THE WORLD:

EXT. WEST COAST MAIN LINE - DAY

7

Footage of the reporter JENNY HILL standing on what seems to be a disused railway line with a fine looking oak tree growing up between the sleepers.

JENNY HILL:

Well, Bill, you've heard of leaves on the line. This is going to be slightly harder to clear. Believe it or not this is the West Coast Main line. Until midnight yesterday it was carrying thousands of passengers North from London. Today ... it's completely overgrown. We're getting similar reports from the M25 ...

Insert shots of the unexpected M25 alder grove.

JENNY HILL: (cont'd)
And the Scottish Parliament ...

A REPORTER stands outside the Scottish Parliament, but it looks like he is in Center Parcs.

CUT TO:

A PARIS REPORTER is standing amongst the trees.

10 CONTINUED:

PARIS REPORTER:
C'est Bois de Boulogne? Non. C'est
L'ille de la Citie. Incroyable.
Caché dans les arbres - c'est Notre
Dame. Qu'est-ce se passe?

CUT TO:

11 EXT. FOOTBALL PITCH. ACCRA - DAY 11 *

An ACCRA REPORTER stands forlornly in front of some goal
posts that have trees growing in them. *

ACCRA REPORTER:
In three hours time the Ghana Black
Stars are due to play Sierra Leone
in the African Cup of Nations. It
does not look like the pitch will
be ready. *

CUT TO: *

12 INT. TARDIS - DAY / EXT. MUSEUM - DAY 12 *

CLARA rings THE DOCTOR - who is rooting around in the
TARDIS's works while MAEBH hovers. *

CLARA is on the steps of the museum, marvelling at the
forest. *

CLARA:
You're always showing me amazing
things, I've finally got something
amazing to show you. Something even
you have never seen. Right here in
London. *

THE DOCTOR:
There are some things I've never
seen, but that's usually because
I've chosen not to see them. Even
my incredibly long life is too
short for Les Miserables. *

CLARA:
You're going to love this. *

THE DOCTOR:
When you come to collect this
child, you can show me then.

CLARA:
What child?

He looks at MAEBH.

THE DOCTOR:
Well ... young human female.
Standard defenceless little girl.
(MORE) *

THE DOCTOR: (cont'd)
Your friend Mr. Pink was supposed
to be looking after her ...

CLARA:
She probably has a name.

THE DOCTOR:
Good point. You. Do you have a name
at all?

MAEBH:
Maebh. My name's Maebh. What's
yours?

CLARA:
Maebh? No. Where are you? *

THE DOCTOR:
Trafalgar Square. I found her
wandering in the brand new forest.

CLARA:
Brand new forest? *

THE DOCTOR:
Like The New Forest. Only even
newer. *

CLARA:
Is that the forest that's covering
London? *

THE DOCTOR:
London, yes, and also the
surrounding planet. Oh. Was that
the amazing thing you were going to
show me? It is amazing, but I saw
it first.

CLARA:
Is she alright? Can you bring her
over?

THE DOCTOR:
No I can't bring her over. I'm a
Time Lord not a childminder. *

CLARA:
You've got a space ship. All we've
got is Oyster cards.

THE DOCTOR:
And I've got a global Rapid
Afforestation crisis to deal with.

CUT TO:

13 EXT. MUSEUM ROOF - DAY 13 *

DANNY is on the roof looking out over the city. *

FX: DANNY's POV - the whole of London town covered in trees. *

DANNY heads back inside. *

CUT TO: *

*

13A INT. MUSEUM - DAY 13A *

DANNY comes back in to address the KIDS. CLARA will walk in during the following, putting her phone away. DANNY is a whirling vortex of energy and decision-making. We're seeing him doing what he does best. *

DANNY:

OK so it stretches for several miles at least. In all directions. *

GEORGE:

Is it some kind of protest? It's very inconvenient. *

DANNY:

An inconvenience, rightly viewed, is just another name for an adventure. Isn't that right, team? *

He strides past the CHILDREN, expecting them to follow.

BRADLEY:

What team? This is confusing me.

SAMSON:

Yeah. If there was a team - why would anyone pick you?

DANNY stops as he passes CLARA.

DANNY:

What did they say?

CLARA:

Who?

DANNY:

School. Parents. You were just on the phone.

CLARA:

Oh. Yeah. Rang school and parents. Course. Thought that was the priority.

DANNY:

And?

13A CONTINUED:

13A

CLARA:
Couldn't get through. Left
messages. I'll try again.

She takes out her phone again.

DANNY:
You didn't call the school. You
called him. *

CLARA:
He called me actually. I can't stop
him calling me, can I? *

DANNY:
I thought you weren't in touch. *

CLARA:
London has just turned into a
forest. Who do you want to talk to?
Monty Don? *

DANNY:
I want to do my job, which is to
look after the kids. *

CLARA:
Oh really? How many kids? *

DANNY:
What? *

CLARA:
Where's Maebh Arden? *

DANNY looks around in panic.

CLARA: (cont'd)
She's with the Doctor. *

DANNY:
What? No, no. Maebh is a vulnerable
kid. She's on medication. She's had
an emotional trauma. He ... has he
even been CRB checked? *

CLARA:
He didn't abduct her. She was lost.
He found her. *

They're hissing at each other. Pick up on the fact that two
of the kids - BRADLEY and RUBY - are watching them from a
distance. *

BRADLEY:
I thought you said they were in
love. Why are they shouting at each
other? *

RUBY:
That's what people do when they're
in love. Don't you know anything?

CUT TO:

14 OMITTED

14

15 EXT. LONDON. CROMWELL ROAD - DAY

15

DANNY leads the KIDS through the trees.

DANNY:
Who wants to be navigator?

BRADLEY and SAMSON's hands shoot up. DANNY hands BRADLEY a compass.

DANNY: (cont'd)
Good lad. Let's do this.

BRADLEY is chuffed but as they go, he asks SAMSON.

BRADLEY:
What's a navigator?

DANNY is already charging off through the forest.

DANNY:
Follow the lamp posts, that will
keep us on Cromwell Road. We'll be
able to orientate ourselves.

RUBY questions DANNY.

RUBY:
I thought we were getting a coach.
Where's the coach?

DANNY:
Well, Ruby, it seems the road is
blocked with trees.

RUBY:
Can't we just wait here until
they've gone?

DANNY:
Trees don't just go, Ruby.

RUBY:
They just came. Why wouldn't they
just go?

CLARA gets next to DANNY.

CLARA:
The question is, how did they get here? Can a forest grow over night? Or have we been asleep for years like Sleeping Beauty?

DANNY:
No. The question is, how do we get these kids home?

CLARA:
Oh. Absolutely. That's the big question.

He addresses the KIDS.

DANNY:
OK. Come on, keep up. It's crucial that we stick together. If you start to fall behind - don't. Bradley, we are going to head North East first to collect Maebh from Trafalgar Square, then we'll go South to the river. In densely forested terrain a river will always be your easiest form of transportation.

He pushes the pace. CLARA falls into step with him.

CLARA:
You're enjoying this a little bit too much. Are you not even a little bit curious about how? Who? Why?

DANNY:
I am curious. I am bewildered. I am in fact enchanted. But I am not the priority. These kids are.

CLARA:
See now that attitude is ... actually very attractive.

CUT TO:

16

INT. GOVERNMENT OFFICE - DAY

16

Shot of a GOVERNMENT MINISTER on television appealing for calm.

MINISTER:
The government emergency committee - Cobra - has formulated an action plan. We will create pathways through the trees, using carefully controlled fires. This will facilitate the movement of essential services. We are therefore asking you to stay in your homes.

(MORE)

16 CONTINUED:

16

MINISTER: (cont'd)
Fill your baths, sinks, and any
buckets with fresh water to ensure
a supply. We advise you to keep
your radios and mobile phones on so
that we can update you. Above all,
stay indoors.

*

CUT TO: *

17 EXT. TARDIS - DAY 17 *

THE DOCTOR is scanning the trees with his sonic screwdriver. *

MAEBH:
I thought everyone would like it.
But you don't like it.

THE DOCTOR:
Why would there be no reading?
Because they are actually made of
wood. No circuits. No mechanism ...
wood.

He examines the growth nodes.

THE DOCTOR: (cont'd)
They're still growing. If you look
long enough you can actually see it
growing.

MAEBH:
What's this for? *

She goes to touch the sonic screwdriver, but THE DOCTOR
snatches it away.

THE DOCTOR:
This is a sonic screwdriver. It
interacts with any form of
communication you care to mention
... Sadly trees have no moving
parts and don't communicate.

MAEBH:
They communicate a bit though.

THE DOCTOR:
What?

MAEBH:
Otherwise they wouldn't all grow at
the same time, would they?

THE DOCTOR:
You think that's how Spring
begins? With a group message on
Tree FaceBook? They send each other
texts?

17 CONTINUED:

17

MAEBH:
You don't need a phone to
communicate, do you? I haven't
phoned home, but I know my Mum is
worried about me.

CUT TO:

18 INT. MAEBH'S HOUSE - MORNING - DAY / EXT. MAEBH'S HOUSE - DAY 18*

MAEBH's MUM is having a phone conversation whilst frantically looking for her car keys.

MAEBH'S MUM:
You said you'd collect her. No. YOU
said you'd collect her. It's
alright, I'm collecting her. Soon
as I find my car keys. Can't see a
thing. Next door have planted
bloody leylandii and they've gone
mental. Taking all my daylight ...

She's looking at the window which is totally obscured by leaves and branches. She spots her keys and heads for the door.

MAEBH'S MUM: (cont'd)
I've had words with her about it
before. She's...

She has now opened the front door. Outside the front door there is a forest.

MAEBH'S MUM: (cont'd)
Oh. I'll call you back.

CUT TO:

19 EXT. MAEBH'S HOUSE - DAY

19

Entranced and bewildered, MAEBH's MUM drifts out into the woods. The NEIGHBOURS are out - similarly enchanted and confused. But also charmed.

NEIGHBOUR ONE:
I think we should have been
consulted. What's it in aid of
even? How am I going to get my car
out?

*

The cars are blocked in the drives by the sudden trees.

MAEBH'S MUM:
Maebh's on a school trip. She needs
her medication. I was supposed to
collect her. How far does this go?

19 CONTINUED:

19

She looks up and down the street, hoping to see an end to it, but there's no end in sight.

CUT TO:

20 EXT. LONDON. KNIGHTSBRIDGE. FOREST - DAY 20 *

DANNY leads the CHILDREN through the lovely, inexplicable forest. Blossom blows by on the breeze. Every now and then their way is illuminated by a lamp post.

RUBY:

Miss, in the museum, right, I was reading about Reproduction.

CLARA:

Oh, Ruby, this isn't really the right moment.

RUBY:

And that said trees have blossom and then that turns into fruit or nuts or seeds. Right?

CLARA:

Right, Ruby.

RUBY:

These trees have got blossom and nuts on at the same time. See? Blossom and nuts.

CLARA:

That is strange. And that's very good observation skills, Ruby.

*

SAMSON:

Nuts. That's unlucky for you isn't it, Bradley, because you've got an allergy, haven't you, Bradley? What happens if one of them falls on your head, Bradley? You'll die, Bradley, yeah? You'll swell up like a massive melon ...

BRADLEY:

Shut it.

They shove each other about. Meanwhile, RUBY pulls at CLARA.

RUBY:

Maebh's on medication, Miss. What'll happen if we don't get to her in time? When her medication wears off she'll go mental. Her head goes funny. It's like ...

CLARA:
I think Mr. Pink will get us there
in time, don't you? I think we're
in good hands with Mr. Pink.

She looks ahead to where he is chivvying the CHILDREN along
and feels a rush of fond admiration for him.

CLARA: (cont'd)
Yes. We are in really good hands.

*

CUT TO:

21

INT. TARDIS - DAY

21

THE DOCTOR is talking to himself, trying to work things out.

THE DOCTOR:
They are already blocking roads and
railway lines. So no food is being
delivered. No medical supplies.
Plus they're still growing so it's
only a matter of time before the
roots cut through the power lines,
water mains. Water, electricity and
wood - great combination. You know,
if it wasn't a forest it would be a
very effective weapon.

Meanwhile, MAEBH is muttering (it's coming, it's coming). She *
seems to be having some kind of dialogue with herself. *

MAEBH:
Ssssh! Stop talking. Leave me
alone.

*

He stares at her.

MAEBH: (cont'd)
Not you. I'm talking to ... myself.

*

THE DOCTOR:
I was talking to MY self but you
interrupted.

MAEBH looks increasingly agitated. Her medication is wearing
off. She's making that swatting gesture we saw earlier.
She's muttering to herself - or possibly not to herself.

CUT TO:

22

EXT. TRAFALGAR SQUARE - DAY

22

CLARA has spotted the TARDIS. She heads for it.

CLARA:
There it is. Come on.

The KIDS are more interested in the great stone lions gazing
at them through the leaves and branches.

22 CONTINUED:

22

The streetlights dotted around the square are all illuminated, making the leaves shimmer and glow. And there's that column of stone.

There's no one else there but the children.

DANNY:
Trafalgar Square! Well done Bradley. Excellent navigation skills.

*

BRADLEY beams. This is magical. The KIDS are amazed.

CLARA's heading straight for the TARDIS.

CLARA:
Nearly there. All sorted now.

DANNY grunts his agreement. She's tickled by his distrust of THE DOCTOR.

Meanwhile, the KIDS are excited by the stone lion.

BRADLEY:
Can we have pictures with that lion, sir? Please?

DANNY:
Stay together. But OK.

The KIDS go off to take selfies with the stone lion.

CLARA:
Can't believe that Bradley said please.

DANNY:
Really.

CLARA:
Yeah he usually prefers other means of persuasion ...

CUT AWAY TO:

23

INT. COAL HILL SCHOOL - DAY

23

A glimpse of BRADLEY's usual method. He's threatening a YOUNGER KID. CLARA isn't looking at him.

BRADLEY:
Miss, he won't lend me his calculator, Miss.

CLARA doesn't look up but does make a suggestion.

CLARA:
You could try saying please, Bradley.

23 CONTINUED:

23

There's a crash. Now she does look up and there's a KID crying on the floor, a desk on its side and the door swinging on its hinges.

BACK TO:

24 EXT. TRAFALGAR SQUARE - DAY

24

CLARA and DANNY are still watching the KIDS. BRADLEY is going * to take a picture. RUBY bosses everyone into position. *

CLARA:
And Ruby ...

CUT AWAY TO:

25 INT. COAL HILL SCHOOL. MATHS LESSON - DAY

25

DANNY is teaching a maths lesson. He's drawn a right angled triangle on the white board and marked the hypotenuse "X".

DANNY:
How do we find X? ... Ruby.

RUBY looks like she's been tasered. She stares at the white board.

RUBY:
"X"? It's there, sir. At the top.

DANNY:
How do we find ...

RUBY:
It's not lost. It's there. At the top, look.

DANNY:
... the VALUE of X?

RUBY:
Why am I being asked all the questions? Give someone else a go.

BACK TO:

26 EXT. TRAFALGAR SQUARE - DAY

26

CLARA and DANNY still discussing the KIDS.

CLARA:
You bring out the best in them. And you got us here. Thanks.

She tugs him towards the TARDIS but he hangs back.

26 CONTINUED:

26

CLARA: (cont'd)
The Doctor will help get us the
rest of the way home. In fact he'll
probably be able to sort out this
whole forest thing. Come on then.

DANNY:
I'll keep an eye on the kids.

Suddenly there's a yelp of fear from BRADLEY and SAMSON. And
a cry of alarm from DANNY.

Nelson's Column groaned and shook.

*

RUBY meanwhile has broken a branch. She brings it to DANNY.

RUBY:
Look, Sir. No rings. Trees normally

THE DOCTOR:
The rings mark the years of growth.
One ring for each year. This grew
up over night. That whole tree is
just one night's growth. And
they're still growing.

RUBY is thrown but CLARA smooths things.

CLARA:
Everyone, this is the Doctor and
he's going to sort everything out.
Isn't that right, Doctor? That's
what he does.

THE DOCTOR:
Well having looked into things I
think the answer to that is
probably no.

CLARA:
He always says that. He's really
clever.

We reveal that MAEBH has hidden herself behind a tree. She's
peering out, watching the others anxiously.

THE DOCTOR:
Oh I am really clever. But I'm
afraid clever isn't much use
against trees. They don't listen to
reason. You can't lie to them. You
can't plead with them. They have no
moving parts, no circuits, no wi-
fi. You wave your sonic screwdriver

hurries back into the TARDIS, followed by CLARA and the

While they're talking, DANNY notices a pile of school books in the corner. Puzzled, he flicks through them with a frown.

Unnerved, MAEBH's MUM tries turning the radio on and off.
Nothing.

It's suddenly frighteningly, impossibly quiet.

CUT TO:

31 EXT. LONDON. FOREST - DAY

31

The terrible creaking, squealing noise of stone on stone. The *
column is about to fall. *

Somewhere below, the unsuspecting DOCTOR and CLARA ... *

THE DOCTOR:
Gifted and talented? Really?

CLARA:
Furious. Fearful. Tongue-tied.
They're all superpowers if you use
them properly. Are they going to be
alright?

THE DOCTOR:
They're in the TARDIS. Safest place
on the planet.

CRASH! Nelson's column comes crashing down. They manage to
get out of the way. Dust, twigs, noise, as it plunges through
the trees. The Doctor surveys the ruin.

I'm actually frightened. I never
get frightened. Why am I
frightened?

You just lost a little girl.

CLARA:

That's a worry. But I know you'll
find her. This isn't a worry, this
is... a dread. (SHOUTS) Maebh!

THE DOCTOR:

You're pursuing a little lost girl
through a mysterious forest. The

strangely compelling masculine

THE DOCTOR:

Exactly. The Forest. It's in all

MAEBH'S MUM is on her doorstep, frantically trying to call Maebh's phone. Her NEIGHBOUR is trying to coax her out.

NEIGHBOUR:

We've got a little camping stove. We're going to make a nice big pot of tea. Number 6 are coming. Come on Siobhan. We never have time to just sit and talk. Before we know it, they'll have this all sorted.

*

MAEBH'S MUM:

And just how do you sort out a forest?

NEIGHBOUR:

Haven't you heard? It was on the radio. It's quite clever. The army are going use the Underground tunnels to get around. They're going to pop up out of every station on the Central Line and burn pathways North and South and then they're going to do the same on the Piccadilly Line so ...

She demonstrates the theory by interlacing her fingers but MAEBH'S MUM is just staring at her in absolute horror.

MAEBH'S MUM:

Burn it? They're going to set fire to the trees? But ... Maebh's still out there.

NEIGHBOUR:

Now you don't know that. The school will look after her. And the army know what they're doing. Come on. The kettle's on. We've got ...

But MAEBH'S MUM has already disappeared around the back of the house. Now she reappears with a mountain bike. Jumps on and careers off into the trees.

NEIGHBOUR: (cont'd)

... Ginger Hob Nobs.

CUT TO:

35

EXT. FOREST - DAY

35

MAEBH is running and also still swatting and ducking whatever invisible presence it is that is flying around her head. That's what she's running away from - dodging and swerving.

She pauses and drops her lunch-box carefully in the middle of the trail.

35 CONTINUED:

35

Then she notices ribbons of smoke, thickening into blankets of smoke, blowing into her path. She coughs Stumbles forward.

She comes to a set of wrought iron railings, surrounding the entrance to a tube tunnel.

A team of soldiers in protective garments are running a hose pipe up from the underground. Also carting big chunky bits of kit into place - a sense that something massive is about to happen. MAEBH deliberately drops her school pencil case and turns it so that the school logo is uppermost. *

MAEBH looks back the way she came. She'd like to run back to the TARDIS but then she starts to swat the air again. She's being driven on and on by the invisible mosquitos.

She keeps running. *

CUT TO:

EXT. THE FOREST - DAY

36

THE DOCTOR and CLARA are still moving along. THE DOCTOR spots something.

THE DOCTOR:
Clara ...

He points to a Coal Hill pencil case he's just found. *

THE DOCTOR: (cont'd)
Is it hers?

CLARA:
Yes. Clever girl.

THE DOCTOR:
Trail of bread crumbs. Hansel and Gretel. Gingerbread cottage

CLARA:
You do know that the gingerbread cottage was a very bad place to be?

They go on. CLARA is still clearly on edge.

Thick smoke is been piling up around them. CLARA coughs. They both go forward through the smoke. *

An EMERGENCY SERVICES OFFICER bursts through the smoke in front of them. Breathing apparatus and heavy goggles give him/her the look of an alien.

EMERGENCY SERVICES:
Get back. We're burning here. Get right back.

CLARA:
We're looking for a little girl.

EMERGENCY SERVICES:
Right back. Right, right back.
We're about to burn ...

THE DOCTOR and CLARA watch as a team aims a flame thrower into the branches of the tree. A sheet of fire leaps out and ravages the branches. They burn brilliantly. Black smoke curling. Wood blazing. The crew cheer and move on to set up for the next tree. But then ... the fire goes out. Like a candle snuffed by invisible fingers.

EMERGENCY SERVICES: (cont'd)
Go again. Go on. Get on it. Move.

Another sheet of fire. Another immediate blaze. Another invisible hand snuffs it out.

PICK UP ON the OFFICER on his radio.

EMERGENCY SERVICES: (cont'd)
Copy for us. Not working here
either, Big Ben.

THE DOCTOR nods to CLARA that they should move on. They sneak through the crowd of pre-occupied emergency service workers.

She stops. Stares. There are eyes in the shadows.

MAEBH sees eyes glinting in the trees. Then more eyes and

She screams and runs. *

Then BLAM! Suddenly MAEBH's stopped dead in her tracks.
There's a high metal railing in front of her. How can she
climb over? She can't. She looks behind her. The WOLVES are
coming closer and closer.

She looks through the railing.

On the other side, THE DOCTOR and CLARA burst into view.

CLARA:
Maebh! Quick!

CLARA runs to the fence to try and help her over.

CLARA: (cont'd)
(to the Doctor) Give me a boost so
I can pull her over ...

The WOLVES howl ever nearer.

MAEBH walks away from the fence. At first CLARA thinks she's
going back to the WOLVES.

CLARA: (cont'd)
Maebh!

In fact, MAEBH has spotted something a little way off in the
fence ... a gate! With complete composure, she opens it,
dodges through, and shuts it firmly behind her. As she walks
away, a WOLF slams into it.

MAEBH:
Hi.

She does not seem surprised to see CLARA.

CLARA:
Maebh.

THE DOCTOR gets straight into questioning MAEBH.

You came looking for me. You didn't just stumble into the TARDIS. You know who is doing this. Tell me what you know ...

She is about to speak when there is a terrible crash of undergrowth and clang of metal behind her.

Could we possibly deal with the wolves first, Doctor?

THE DOCTOR:
All we have to do is look like we're too much bother to eat. Stay still. Stay together. Look big. Like a three headed six legged scary thing.

THE DOCTOR, CLARA and MAEBH are paralysed with fear watching
the TIGER patrol the fence, working its way up to a jump ...

CLARA:
Please tell me the tiger's
reputation is based on fairy tales
and not on zoology ...

THE DOCTOR:
There are very good solid
scientific reasons for being really
quite frightened just now.

MAEBH:
I'm sorry!

This is her response to the fact that the TIGER is taking a
run at the fence and is ready to leap. This is it.

The TIGER recoils, snarls, bites the air in fury and
frustration. Its eyes blaze. A figure is reflected in them.

Only as the TIGER turns tail to flee do we see what has
happened. DANNY has appeared out of the undergrowth with his
"team" behind him. DANNY has just shone BRADLEY's improbably
bright torch straight into the tiger's eyes - confusing and
frightening the creature.

As it retreats, BRADLEY, SAMSON and RUBY are almost over the
fence hurling branches and insults after it, yelling - full
of confidence and energy.

They turn to face CLARA, THE DOCTOR and MAEBH.

CLARA:
Mr. Pink ... errrmmm ... thank you
very much.

DANNY:
No problem. Decided it was better
not to leave you alone. With him.

BRADLEY:
See what we did? We totally put the
fear on a tiger!

They're thrilled with themselves.

DANNY:
They've worked well together.
Noticeable increase in confidence
and energy levels.

CLARA:
Well done - and for saving us from
a tiger, too.

BRADLEY:
We totally rule this forest.

DANNY:
Has she had her medication yet? *

She realises she's still carrying MAEBH's homework book and
tries to hide it.

CLARA:
Oh. No. I ...

She roots around in her bag.

THE DOCTOR:
No. Not the medication. Don't shut
her up. We need to know what she
knows. Maebh, why do you keep doing
this? *

He imitates MAEBH's swatting gesture. This annoys DANNY.

DANNY:
Apart from being almost savaged by
a tiger and abducted by a Scotsman,
Maebh Arden has recently
experienced a personal trauma.
She's allowed any nervous tics she
likes. OK? *

THE DOCTOR:
That is not a nervous tic. She is
(... reacting to something). *

RUBY:
Please just give her her tablet. *

MAEBH gets more agitated. She plunges off into the forest. *

DANNY:
Maebh! *

THE DOCTOR is the first to go after her. They all crash
through the trees.

CUT TO:

44

EXT. HEART OF THE FOREST / THE MALL - DAY

44

MAEBH charges into a clearing. The moment she does, great shafts of light stab through the branches - as though the Sun has just risen to tree height - making a kind of cage of light. Huge spider webs are draped through the sunlight. Millions of tiny mites dance in the light.

Beyond the clearing we can see what must be the Mall. There are flags and a glimpse of Buckingham Palace.

First THE DOCTOR, then the CHILDREN and their teachers all follow her into the clearing. All step back in surprise at the sight, the sense of magic.

RUBY:
Miss, what is it, Miss?

MAEBH:
It's coming. It's coming for everyone. I can't unthink it.

The shafts of sunlight increase in intensity.

THE DOCTOR:

They're lovely. They don't like it that you're holding them. They want you to let them go ...

THE DOCTOR:
Who are they?

The shining host speaks in a thousands strong chorus of tiny voices. MAEBH repeats what they're saying but in unison with them - as though she's thinking in tune with them.

MAEBH: / THE HERE:
We are Here. Here always since the beginning and until the end.

When she speaks the others hear a faint shimmer in her voice - as though they can pick up the echo of the "Here".

THE DOCTOR:
"Here" that's it?

We are Here. Always. We are the
green shoot that grows between the
cracks, the grass that grows over
the mass graves. After your wars
are over. We'll still be here. We

We hear the call and we come. As we
came before to the great North
Forest where we lie still in a
great circle. As we came to the
vast Southern forest.

THE DOCTOR:
Now. Who is calling you now?

MAEBH: / THE HERE:
The Sun. The Sun that creates. The
Sun that destroys. You are hurting
us. Let us go ...

THE DOCTOR:
You sent for me. The girl came
looking for me. Why? Why me? What
did you ...

MAEBH: / THE HERE:
We did not send ... pain ... did
not send for you ... we don't know
you ... we were here before you and
we will be here after you ..

BRADLEY:
That is harsh.

But the TARDIS makes a sound like a TARDIS starting up.

BRADLEY: (cont'd)
Where's he going?

CLARA:
Home. He's going home. Which is
exactly where we're all going.

The TARDIS now beginning its take-off procedures.

CUT TO:

50 INT. TARDIS - DAY 50

THE DOCTOR is looking at the TARDIS screens. An image of the Sun with a droplet erupting from its surface.

CUT TO:

The same images but seen on a screen, in the Nethersphere. MISSY is watching.

DANNY and CLARA are leading the KIDS away. The sound of the TARDIS take-off routine beginning kicks in behind them.

CLARA:
Something's about to happen.

DANNY:
We should catch up with the kids.

CLARA:
It doesn't matter, Danny. Not now.

THE DOCTOR is braced for take-off, still watching the solar flare on one of his monitors. A thought strikes him, a thought that burns through his body like electricity.

THE DOCTOR:
Flame proof forest. Flame. Proof.
Forest. A thousand atom bombs and
no one hurt ... I am Doctor Idiot.

CUT TO:

EXT. TRAFALGAR SQUARE - DAY

57

DANNY, CLARA, and the CHILDREN are heading through the trees when THE DOCTOR's voice booms through the shade. *

THE DOCTOR: (OOV)
Clara! Come back here! Come back!

DANNY:
He's calling you.

CLARA:
Let him call. This is more
important. *

THE DOCTOR:
Clara! Mr. Pink! Maebh! All of you!

I want my Mum.

I slightly want my Mum, too.

CLARA:
Tell them, Mr Pink, what an educational opportunity ...

DANNY is clearly going to say nothing of the sort.

He goes to one side and speaks to her quietly.

DANNY:
You go. This is enough for me.

CLARA:
What?! Coronal ejection.
Geomagnetic storm. How often do you get a playlist like that?

DANNY:
I was a soldier. I put myself at risk. I didn't try too hard to survive but somehow here I am. And now I can see what I nearly lost. And it's enough. I don't want to see more things.
