- Run by the BBC Writers
- Used to select around 100 writers for our writer development schemes, Voices and Scripted




You can apply if:

- You have a Drama or Comedy/Drama script written for Film, TV, Radio, Stage or Online for adults or young adults
- You are aged 18 or over
- You are a resident of the UK, Channel Islands, Isle of Man or Republic of Ireland.



We do not accept:

- Resubmissions of work which has previously been submitted to past windows.
- Multiple submissions from an entrant.
- Video/audio material.
- Scripts written for existing shows and/or characters. Scripts written for children.
- Prose or poetry.
- Comedy (sitcoms, series or sketch shows).





If you haven't submitted before, you'll need to create a free E-Submissions account before you apply.

It will ask for things like:

- Your name
- Where you live
- Your phone number and email
- A password



What to submit:

- One complete script in PDF format (minimum 30 pages).
- A script for Film, TV, Radio, Stage or Online.
- A paragraph about your writing history (you do not need to have any credits or professionally produced work. We just want to understand your passion for writing)
- A short paragraph about what you would like to gain from this programme if you are successful.
- a Diversity Monitoring Form (asking you questions about Ethnicity, Disability, Gender and sexuality)

If you do not want to answer them then please put 'prefer not to say'.

There is a [downloadable PDF](#) which details what the applicants will be asked for in E-Submissions to help writers prepare offline before submitting via the system.
