1 **INT. BARRACKS, BRITISH QUARTERS. DAWN. DAY 22 - 0700** 1

The sound of rain drumming heavily on the roof, as 2-section sleep.

Georgie is dressed and at the window looking at the rain. She sees...

2 **EXT. BARRACKS. JAMES' QUARTERS DAY 22 - 0701** 2

...James under his canopy looking at the rain.

He sees Georgie emerging from her quarters and towards the awaiting vehicle.

She sees James and salutes before getting into the car.

She pulls away and we stay on James' face.

3 **INT/EXT. REFUGEE CAMP. ISOLATION UNIT. DAY 22 - 0702** 3

The rain continues to lash on the roof of the now crammed building. Water has started pouring in around the edges causing rivulets of mud, and god knows what else, to make a mess of the temporary flooring.

4 **INT/EXT. REFUGEE CAMP. ISOLATION UNIT DAY 22 - 0703** 4

As the rain lashes down we see a figure sprinting with a small child in his arms.

As the figure gets closer we see it is Ruby, in a desperate state.

Georgie's car pulls up and Georgie hurries out.

GEORGIE

Ruby!

RUBY

(alarmed)

His pulse is so... he's struggling to breathe, Georgie.

Georgie hurries to him and together they run inside the isolation unit.

5 **INT/EXT. REFUGEE CAMP. ISOLATION UNIT. DAY 22 - 0703** 5

Ruby and Georgie rush inside with the infant.

They lay him on a small triage bed as Georgie checks airways etc.

(CONTINUED)

GEORGIE

Oxygen.

Ruby grabs the oxygen and places the mask over the infants mouth.

RUBY

Is he going to be alright?

Ruby on the brink of tears looks at Georgie.

GEORGIE

Let's get some fluids and antibiotics in him asap.

RUBY

(nodding and getting equipment)

Medic.

With great efficiency, IVs are put into the child.

INT/EXT REFUGEE CAMP. ISOLATION UNIT. DAY 22 - 0800

6

Ruby stands outside looking up at the rain, crying.

After a beat Georgie comes outside and joins him.

RUBY

Sorry, Corporal.

GEORGIE

You've got nothing to be sorry about.

She sees him wiping his face.

RUBY

(explaining although Georgie knows the truth of the wet face)

Rain.

He smiles at her.

RUBY (CONT'D)

Is he going to be alright?

GEORGIE

Massively dehydrated. Think you got him in time.

Ruby looks up again as if about to cry. Tired and moved.

GEORGIE (CONT'D)

You care. And if you didn't care you wouldn't be you.

(CONTINUED)

She playfully punches his arm.

GEORGIE (CONT'D)
Now sort your shit out, there's
work to do.

She smiles and heads off.

INT. OUTREACH PROJECT, BARSHA'S OFFICE. DAY 22 - 0805

7

A wracked Barsha is on the phone, smoothing Sumon's hair as
he sits on her lap.

BARSHA
(in Bengali)
This is getting ridiculous. No one
will tell me anything!

Georgie enters, but pulls up when she sees Barsha on the
phone.

GEORGIE
Oh, sorry.

But Barsha holds up a hand.

BARSHA
(in Bengali)
I'm his wife... I should be
informed.
(hanging up)
Do you know what's happened to
Rathmel?

Georgie shakes her head.

GEORGIE
It's obviously a local matter but
we're asking to be kept informed.

Barsha looks desperate.

BARSHA
What am I going to do?

GEORGIE
Captain James is going to try and
find out the procedure...

Barsha half nods.

BARSHA
I'm just the wife of a criminal
now... no one will tell me
anything.

Barsha starts to cry. Sumon stares at her worried.

(CONTINUED)

GEORGIE
(quietly)
You need to stay strong... for
Sumon.

Barsha half nods.

8

INT. REFUGEE CAMP. ISOLATION UNIT. DAY 22 - 0815

8

We see Ruby doing some sort of dipstick test with a vial of water. He checks the test and suddenly looks alarmed.

He sees Georgie emerging from Barsha's office. Georgie clocks his face and hurries over.

RUBY
I just thought I'd... I was worried
about the dehydration...

GEORGIE
What?

Ruby shows her the dipstick.

RUBY
It was negative last night, I'm
sure it was and now...

GEORGIE
Cholera.

RUBY
What are we going to do?

GEORGIE
We know what to do, Ruby. We've got
it in its early stages, now we
isolate and need to establish clean
water supplies.

RUBY
With all this rain...

GEORGIE
It'll spread if we let it. We won't
let it.

Barsha emerges from the office. She looks across at them, it is as if she knows, almost fatalistically expecting it.

BARSHA
Cholera?

Georgie half nods.

(CONTINUED)

BARSHA (CONT'D)
(quietly, undramatically)
This is purgatory.

She goes back inside.

Georgie and Ruby exchange a look.

CUT TO TITLES

EXT. OUTREACH PROJECT. TEMPORARY BRIEFING TENT. DAY 22 - 1000

2 section are donning plastic protective gear and getting their digging equipment ready.

JAMES
Guys, basically we want to shift all potentially contaminated water away from the buildings.

KINGY
We trench from the water butts all the way down to the ditches.

GEORGIE
And let's stay properly alert guys. We don't want any kids playing in the water.

MONK
All the water's contaminated yeah?

GEORGIE
Cholera is now in the water supply...

JAMES
New water butts requested...

GEORGIE
But the rain will be carrying contaminated water down to all the dwellings.

KINGY
Right, ready to move guys.

GEORGIE
Dehydration and diarrhoea. Any of you guys show any symptoms, straight to me.

MAISIE
(gently, anxious)
Is this... don't thousands die, Georgie?

(CONTINUED)

GEORGIE

Potentially. We need to get on top of it.

JAMES

How we respond in the next few hours will determine whether this is a contained outbreak or an epidemic.

James makes to leave. Georgie follows him.

GEORGIE

Anything on CHOWDHREY?

JAMES

Captain Das, military intelligence for the province, has said he'd keep me in the loop, but... that due process will take its course.

GEORGIE

I have a duty of care to Barsha and Sumon.

JAMES

But it's not our gig, Georgie. And... think maybe you've got enough on your plate.

He half smiles as they exchange a look. They hold the look longer than necessary. Broken by Kingy's shout.

KINGY

Right guys, time is of the essence... let's move.

They all start to hurry out, spades and digging equipment at hand.

EXT. OUTREACH PROJECT. DAY 22 - 1015

10

Georgie sees Barsha putting Sumon into a car.

GEORGIE

Barsha...

BARSHA

I'm taking him to his school... he's going to stay with my mother for a while.

Georgie nods and ruffles Sumon's hair.

BARSHA (CONT'D)

He can't stay here.

(CONTINUED)

GEORGIE
Of course.

BARSHA
(looking around)
He's the lucky one... with
somewhere else to go.

Georgie looks around at the children walking about unaware of
the potential dangers. Barsha pulls away in the car.

GEORGIE
We need to isolate then relocate
the orphanage Room.

11 **INT. CHOLERA UNIT. DAY 22 - 1030**

11

Crack team operation as Georgie and Ruby - wearing plastic
gowns and gum boots - glove up and enter the hastily set up
Cholera Treatment Centre. They finish disinfecting their
boots in the newly installed foot baths at the entrance. The
room has been divided into sections.

Ruby watches as NGO's are erecting a hard plastic wall.

RUBY
What's that, another isolation
unit?

Georgie flashes him a look.

RUBY (CONT'D)
What?

GEORGIE
We need to be prepared.

Ruby looks momentarily thrown.

GEORGIE (CONT'D)
We are going to lose people, Ruby.
Temp morgue, bodies need to be
buried away from the project.

Ruby takes this in.

GEORGIE (CONT'D)
We'll save as many as we can.
Anyone with symptoms brought in
here... isolated and IV fluids.
Some are already so weak...

(CONTINUED)

RUBY
It's so fucking unfair.

GEORGIE
Yep.

They turn as they see local medical NGO's bringing in a line of sick people.

NGO WORKER
People displaying symptoms medic...

RUBY
(steeling himself)
Right, let's get them over here for triage... the most poorly we'll find beds for.

Georgie looks at Ruby on his mettle and nods, proudly.

12

INT. OUTREACH PROJECT. TEMP ORPHANAGE ROOM. DAY 22 - 1130 12

A dozen or so children are sitting around looking up at Georgie who is talking to a local NGO.

GEORGIE
We need them isolated and kept here. Only bottled water... any food must be heated thoroughly... hands washed in clean water...

The NGO worker nods and translates for the children.

NGO WORKER 2
(in Bengali)
So we're all staying here today...

GEORGIE
Don't frighten them but we need to know if any of them are feeling poorly.

The NGO worker nods.

NGO WORKER 2
(in Bengali)
The water outside is dangerous and can cause bad tummy's... so you must let us know if any of you feel unwell.

Suddenly Monk rushes in with Asha in his arms.

MONK
(clearly delighted)
I found her! She was outside on a little bike.
(MORE)

(CONTINUED)

MONK (CONT'D)
(stroking Asha's hair)
Never been so pleased to see
anyone.

Monk places Asha on the floor by her friends.

MONK (CONT'D)
(to Georgie)
She's alright, she hasn't got it.

GEORGIE
We don't know that yet, Monk. We
isolate and if they display no
symptoms, we relocate.

MONK
Please let her be alright, Georgie.

Georgie half nods.

GEORGIE
Don't worry, most use you can be
now Monk is on the trenching.

Monk nods, flashes a smile to Asha and heads off.

13

EXT. BARRACKS, TOWARDS JAMES' OFFICE. DAY 22 - 1145

13

Captain Das and James are walking across the courtyard
towards the offices.

JAMES
It will still be a Bangladeshi
police operation.

Captain Das looks up at James.

JAMES (CONT'D)
I'm just offering British military
assistance.

CAPTAIN DAS
I think we can transport a prisoner
from A to B.

JAMES
Of course. But there are quite a
lot of people with a vested
interest in CHOWDHREY not making it
to B.

Captain Das half nods in agreement.

JAMES (CONT'D)
I think there's less likelihood of
being attacked if an armed unit is
assisting you.

(CONTINUED)

CAPTAIN DAS

Thank you.

They head on into the offices.

14 **INT. OUTREACH PROJECT. STORE ROOM. DAY 22 - 1150**

14

Ruby is taking a box of antibiotics from the fridge. He searches in other cold storage units but he can only find the one box.

15 **INT. OUTREACH PROJECT. CHOLERA UNIT. DAY 22 - 1151**

15

Georgie is setting up IV's on some patients, Barsha is assisting.

Ruby comes in with the box.

RUBY

This is all there was in cold storage.

Georgie looks in the box and flashes a look to Barsha.

GEORGIE

We'll need to shout up some more antibiotics. We'll need them today.

BARSHA

I've made the phone call but...

GEORGIE

They'll come today, yeah?

BARSHA

I can't guarantee anything anymore.

GEORGIE

What do you mean? You can get antibiotics, yes?

BARSHA

(snaps)

I'm trying my best!

RUBY

If we don't get them today...

BARSHA

I know. I am aware. But... the company that have been supplying us have said... at the moment they can't get any more.

Georgie and Ruby exchange an alarmed look as Barsha storms off.

(CONTINUED)

GEORGIE
Let's hydrate and use the remaining
antibiotics sparingly.

RUBY
How? How can we do that!

GEORGIE
On those we deem strong enough to
survive.

Ruby looks at the mass of people in need.

RUBY
We play God, yeah?

GEORGIE
We play medics, yeah.

Georgie starts to set up fluid drips on another patient.
James comes in.

JAMES
Lane, word.

She follows him out.

16 **OMITTED**

17 **INT/EXT. OUTREACH PROJECT. JAMES' VEHICLE. DAY 22 - 1206**

17

James and Georgie sit in the vehicle looking at the rain
lashing down on the windscreen.

GEORGIE
Stair rods.

JAMES
And you're from Manchester.

Georgie looks at him, clearly not in the mood for bantz.

GEORGIE
We're running out of medicines, the
morgue is filling and... I've never
felt so powerless in my life.

JAMES
Sorry.

GEORGIE
Did you manage to sort the water
butts?

JAMES

Solicited the help of the high
commission.

GEORGIE

Thank you.

JAMES

And persuaded Captain Das we can
help with the transfer of
CHOWDHREY.

Georgie looks at James, appreciatively.

JAMES (CONT'D)

If we leave Ruby here I'd
appreciate you with me... we'll
need CHOWDHREY assessed fit to
travel.

GEORGIE

(puzzled)

Has he...?

JAMES

I think when a policeman goes bad
other policemen take umbrage. No
doubt he's had a bit of a kicking.

Georgie nods.

GEORGIE

Can the high commission help with
medicines?

JAMES

I can try. What's happened to the
suppliers this end?

GEORGIE

Thanks to CHOWDHREY I presume this
outreach project is now considered
corrupt and untouchable.

James nods. They look at each other.

JAMES

(gently)

Are you okay?

GEORGIE

I just want to sit in a darkened
room and rock... but I'll get over
myself.

He goes to take her hand.

18 OMITTED

18

19 EXT. FIELD. DOWN HILL FROM REFUGEE CAMP. DAY 22 - 1230

19

We see 2 section, Kingy, Brains, Monk, Fingers, Maisie and Rab now all digging graves.

They are working hard and clearly focused. Kingy looks up and see James heading over.

Some of the guys brace up but Kingy knows they are on task.

KINGY

As you were guys, carry on.

They carry on digging. James greets Kingy.

JAMES

(looking around)

Excellent work, guys. Thank you.

ALL

Boss.

KINGY

We need the bodies buried asap.

JAMES

Of course. Just want to say guys,
your attitude on this tour has been
fucking exemplary.

They clearly appreciate this. James and Kingy walk off a few paces.

KINGY

Boss?

JAMES

Getting a small team together to
collect CHOWDHREY. I'll need
Richards to drive an A.N.Other. Who
would you least miss?

KINGY

Like you say, they're all doing the
cap proud but...

(calling)

Richards, Kalil... On the boss.
Rest of you, carry on.

James nods and starts to head off. Rab and Maisie following.

(CONTINUED)

FINGERS

Did the boss say they're going to
get CHOWDHREY, Kingy?

KINGY

We should call you Ears not
Fingers.

FINGERS

CHOWDHREY needs putting in one of
these graves, mate.

KINGY

Not your call though is it,
Fingers.

MONK

But if it wasn't for CHOWDHREY,
Bones would still be alive.

KINGY

And he'd be proud to see your work
here so... let's crack on.

They all work away industriously.

Brains looks up and sees some more bodies being brought
towards them by NGO's.

BRAINS

There'll never be a moment back
home where I won't...

He sees the others looking at him.

BRAINS (CONT'D)

...count my friggin' blessings.

They nod and work on with even more vigour.

20

INT. CHOLERA UNIT. DAY 22 - 1430

20

Ruby is sitting on the bed of the small boy he bought in at
first light (pre-titles).

The child, named Sayed, is still on drips but is looking a
lot better.

Ruby has a small puppet from the box of toys in the corner.

(CONTINUED)

RUBY
(as puppet)
Sayed! Sayed!

The puppet shakes Sayed's hand as Ruby looks up and sees Georgie come in, full battle, helmet in hand.

RUBY (CONT'D)
Look Georgie! Look!

Ruby points to Sayed, and smiles.

GEORGIE
Magic medicines.

RUBY
He's going to be alright, isn't he.

GEORGIE
You got him here early enough. Nice one.

RUBY
(as if suddenly noticing)
What's happening?

GEORGIE
On a mission, they need a medic.
You're okay here.

Ruby nods.

RUBY
Any word on the medicines?

Georgie shakes her head.

GEORGIE
I'm not going to be long... we're transporting CHOWDHREY back to the police station for questioning.

RUBY
Can't believe that bastard.

GEORGIE
There's nowt so queer as folk.

RUBY
Why would he shit on everything...
on everyone?

(CONTINUED)

GEORGIE

What is it they say, money is the
root of all evil. There's a bit of
truth in that.

RUBY

(pointing to Sayed)

I tell you what... money couldn't
buy that smile he just gave me.

Georgie winks and heads off.

21

EXT/INT. ROADWAY, BRITISH ARMY TRUCK. DAY 22 - 1445

21

We see a Bangladeshi police car in front, followed by the
British Army truck, followed by another police car.

22

EXT/INT. ROADWAY, BRITISH ARMY TRUCK. DAY 22 - 1450

22

Maisie is driving, Rab, James and Georgie in the rear.

MAISIE

Are we coming back the same route,
boss?

JAMES

That's the plan.

Maisie looks up at bridges/vulnerable points.

MAISIE

There's a few... vulnerable points,
that's all.

JAMES

Aware of that, Richards. Which is
why we're here.

RAB

Deterrent?

JAMES

Yep.

GEORGIE

Let's hope the union flag is enough
to make them think twice.

Rab looks out the back and around.

RAB

They wouldn't try and spring him
here, would they?

(CONTINUED)

MAISIE
(with a little laugh)
'Spring him'? Hark at you!

RAB
That's you and your 'cor blimey'
influence, Richards.

MAISIE
I'll make a cockney of him yet,
boss.

JAMES
What aspirations you have,
Richards.

They travel on, Rab on alert. James and Georgie exchange a
look.

23

EXT. RURAL POLICE STATION. DAY 22 - 1500

23

We see the police cars and British military truck pulling up
outside.

24

INT. RURAL POLICE STATION. CELL. DAY 22 - 1505

24

We see a somewhat battered and bruised CHOWDHREY sitting on
the floor, a blanket over his shoulders.

He looks up as his cell door opens.

Captain Das comes in followed by James and Georgie. Rab and
Maisie stand guard by the open door.

CHOWDHREY
Captain.

CAPTAIN DAS
(ignoring CHOWDHREY and
turning to James and
Georgie)
Examine and confirm he's fit to
travel.

Georgie nods and moves to CHOWDHREY. She starts to examine
his cuts and bruises.

CHOWDHREY
(in Bengali to Captain
Das)
What's happening, Captain.

CAPTAIN DAS
(pointedly to James)
We take the prisoner back to the
police station for questioning.

(CONTINUED)

GEORGIE

What's happened to your face?

CHOWDHREY

I fell off the bed.

Georgie looks into his eyes and ears.

JAMES

How is he, medic?

GEORGIE

Superficial lacerations, bruising
to the face...

CHOWDHREY

I shall refuse to comment.

A Bangladeshi policeman walks past the open door and spits in
at CHOWDHREY whilst cussing him in Bengali.

RAB

Calm yourself please, sir.

CAPTAIN DAS

(shouts in Bengali to the
policeman)

Move away now. That's an order.

The policeman heads off muttering. We see James assessing the
situation as Georgie continues to examine CHOWDHREY.

GEORGIE

(quietly to CHOWDHREY)

I just hope it was worth it.

CHOWDHREY

Oh it was.

CAPTAIN DAS

(fuming)

We should just let them kill you!

CHOWDHREY

Then maybe you'd be as bad as me.

GEORGIE

Follow my finger with your eyes.

Georgie moves her finger as CHOWDHREY follows with his eyes.

GEORGIE (CONT'D)

Any blurring to your vision?

CHOWDHREY shakes his head.

(CONTINUED)

JAMES
Richards, Kalil, clear the
corridor... I want it completely
clear as we come bring him through.

RAB
Boss.

Maisie and Rab head outside.

25

INT. RURAL POLICE STATION. DAY 22 - 1507

25

Rab and Maisie politely but firmly move a few police officers
who are clearly hanging about to catch a glimpse/throw a
punch at CHOWDHREY.

26

INT. RURAL POLICE STATION. CELL. DAY 22 - 1509

26

James is handcuffing CHOWDHREY to himself.

Rab and Maisie come back in.

JAMES
Captain Das... blanket over your
head... he's your charge, Georgie.
I'll have CHOWDHREY.

They nod.

JAMES (CONT'D)
We head out at speed. The Captain
placed in the first vehicle with
the Bangladeshi police... blanket
on for journey. CHOWDHREY into the
back of our truck where no one will
have eyes on. Prepare to move,
guys...

They all prepare to move.

27

EXT. RURAL POLICE STATION/MILITARY TRUCK. DAY 22 - 1510

27

We see the two hooded figures emerging at speed from the
police station and placed in vehicles as directed.

28

EXT/INT. RURAL POLICE STATION/MILITARY TRUCK. DAY 22 - 1511²⁸

A covered CHOWDHREY is put into the back of the van. Maisie
jumps into the drivers seat.

James is in the back with CHOWDHREY still handcuffed to him.

JAMES
(into mic)
All call signs, this is zero alpha.
Primary on board, let's move. Out.

They start to pull away.

29 **EXT. ROAD, CONVOY. DAY 22 - 1512**

29

We see the three vehicles pulling away, and down the road.

30 **INT. BRITISH ARMY TRUCK. DAY 22 - 1513**

30

We see Rab in the back.

RAB
(bit pleased)
Text book.

MAISIE
Don't Jonah it.

RAB
What's that mean?

MAISIE
Put a curse on it.

GEORGIE
Clearly some way to go on his
cockney vocab.

RAB
Colchester is nowhere near East
London.

MAISIE
Essex mate. Near enough.

CHOWDHREY
(from under the blanket)
Can I take the blanket off?

JAMES
I don't think we want to look at
you.

CHOWDHREY
I can't breathe.

James flashes Georgie a look who half nods and takes the
blanket off.

James and CHOWDHREY exchange a glance as they sit side by
side, handcuffed together.

(CONTINUED)

Rab is now on watch out of the back.

We see Maisie all eyes in front.

31 **EXT. ROAD. UNDERPASS. DAY 22 - 1520**

31

We see the lead police car approaching heavy traffic. The British Army Truck and following vehicle are behind. Roadworks ahead are creating a single lane system. Traffic lights controlling which lane moves.

32 **INT. BRITISH ARMY TRUCK. DAY 22 - 1521**

32

Maisie is slightly anxious as an open back truck with some men in the back pulls in front of her, creating distance between the British Army Truck and the Lead Vehicle.

MAISIE

Boss...

JAMES

They don't know what vehicle he's in. Keep them in your sights but don't do anything... unnecessary.

MAISIE

Boss.

James turns and looks at CHOWDHREY.

CHOWDHREY

I won't make a statement.

GEORGIE

Why would you not want to make a statement?

CHOWDHREY looks at her.

GEORGIE (CONT'D)

All the harm you've done... and you have a chance... one chance to slightly make amends.

CHOWDHREY

You want me to stop the Yaba trade in Bangladesh?

JAMES

You've got an opportunity to help. She's right.

CHOWDHREY

We've already lost.

(CONTINUED)

Who? GEORGIE

CHOWDHREY

The good guys.

JAMES

You're saying you're a good guy
now?

CHOWDHREY turns and looks at James. He smiles an almost
philosophical smile.

JAMES (CONT'D)

If you're a good guy maybe you're
right, we've lost and should throw
in the towel.

CHOWDHREY

The thing I've always found strange
about you Westerners... you need
everything to be very black and
white. That helps you sort
everything out in your tiny heads.

GEORGIE

Maybe it's time we put the blanket
back on.

CHOWDHREY

Of course. Don't look at something
other.

JAMES

Something other?

CHOWDHREY

You could never understand. So put
the blanket on... bury your head in
the sand.

RAB

(looking out of the back)
Boss.

JAMES

What is it, Kalil?

RAB

Following vehicle getting left
behind.

MAISIE

Boss, what do I do... follow the
lead vehicle or wait for the tail?

CHOWDHREY

Follow the lead or wait for the
tail.

(CONTINUED)

CHOWDHREY laughs. Georgie puts the blanket over him.

RAB

Well, that always worked with my
grandma's budgie.

James is now leaning forward and on Maisie's shoulder, as
best he can whilst still handcuffed to CHOWDHREY.

JAMES

Keep eyes on the lead. As best you
can.

Maisie nods and drives. James turns and looks at Georgie who
is looking at him. He tries to smiles reassuringly.

33

EXT. ROAD, BRIDGE. DAY 22 - 1530

33

We see the lead vehicle get through the lights and go into
the underpass. The British Truck is still behind the open
back truck, now held at the temporary traffic lights.

RAB (V.O.)

Well no one knows which vehicle
CHOWDHREY's in.

34

INT. BRITISH ARMY TRUCK. DAY 22 - 1544

34

Maisie drives on. James eyes up front, Rab eyes on rear.

There is an element of tension. All on high alert.

Everyone's a suspect - The men in the truck in front; the
beggars going from car to car; the street sellers weaving in
between the vehicles; the grass cutters on the grass verge, a

I did!

JAMES

And they threatened you? Your family?

CHOWDHREY

(emphatically)

No! No, nothing like that. You can't understand. It wasn't them, it was me!

CHOWDHREY half shakes his head.

CHOWDHREY (CONT'D)

Barsha had no idea for years.

CHOWDHREY turns and looks at Georgie.

CHOWDHREY (CONT'D)

If you think this is about us taking the easy option, accepting money for our own greed... you couldn't be further from the truth.

BARSHA

It was my fault.

CHOWDHREY

No.

BARSHA

I begged you!

CHOWDHREY

All you've ever done, is good Barsha. Motivated by good.

(to Georgie and James)

A terrible pneumonia epidemic was sweeping through the camp... hundreds had died... we had no medicines...

BARSHA

We had nothing apart from half a dozen volunteers and nine thousand starving and dying children.

(CONTINUED)

CHOWDHREY

Barsha was desperate... I told her
that I was knocking on the door of
every business in the district
begging them to make charitable
donations...
(MORE)

(CONTINUED)

CHOWDHREY (CONT'D)

then I was approached again about taking a supply of yaba from Burma and taking it across the border. That one action would provide us with sufficient funds to buy the necessary medicines...

BARSHA

We entered the tunnel...

CHOWDHREY

I'd told Barsha I'd been gifted the money from a factory owner.

GEORGIE

And you believed him?

Barsha nods.

CHOWDHREY

It started to be a weekly transaction. I'd pick up the drugs and tell Barsha we'd had another donation. Every single penny has gone into the outreach project.

GEORGIE

(to Barsha)

So when did you...

Barsha shrugs.

BARSHA

I started to suspect... but didn't want to know.

JAMES

But you knew?

Barsha nods.

GEORGIE

But if you didn't know...

Barsha looks up at Georgie.

GEORGIE (CONT'D)

...and your husband made a full and frank confession, giving the authorities names to close down this trade...

CHOWDHREY

If I confess, Barsha is looked after... protected? I give names they will want revenge.

(beat, as Georgie nods.

(MORE)

(CONTINUED)

CHOWDHREY (CONT'D)

Chowdhrey looks to James)

Barsha won't be put in prison?

GEORGIE

Well if she didn't know anything
about it, why would she be put in
prison when she has a son to look
after?

All eyes on CHOWDHREY as he leans forward and hugs his wife,
clinging on to her desperately.

INT. LOCAL POLICE STATION. CORRIDOR. DAY 23 - 1215

72

James and Captain Das are walking along at speed, followed by
Georgie and Barsha.

JAMES

We need to get Barsha to a place of
safety before...

(flashing a look to the
policemen observing them)

...before it becomes known
CHOWDHREY is willing to sign a
statement.

CAPTAIN DAS

Agree.

BARSHA

I need my son.

GEORGIE

We'll get your son.

JAMES

Let's get them into the barracks...

GEORGIE

There are living quarters there.

BARSHA

What about the outreach project?

JAMES

You can still go there with us of
course...

GEORGIE

You'll just need to stay at the
barracks with Sumon.

JAMES

You mustn't put yourself in
vulnerable situations.

GEORGIE

But you will always have
protection.

(CONTINUED)

Georgie nods and Barsha heads outside, allowing Georgie and James to have to the briefest of moments.

GEORGIE (CONT'D)
Thank you, Charlie.

JAMES
Thank 'you'.

They head outside.

EXT. OUTREACH PROJECT. TEMP ORPHANAGE ROOM. DAY 23 - 1220 73

Kingy, Monk, Fingers, Rab and Brains are sorting the kids and putting them onto a rickety old local bus.

KINGY
Right, come on kids, all on the bus... let's get you to your nice, new, uncontaminated dwelling.

Monk emerges with Asha in his arms.

MONK
I'm going to come and see you, understand? Rab! Translate.

RAB
(in Bengali to Asha)
He says he's going to come and see you.

ASHA
(in Bengali)
I like it he is always smiling.

MONK
What she say?

RAB
She's going to come and live with you and Doris.

MONK
I wouldn't actually mind that!

Monk puts her on the bus and waves as they see a vehicle pulling up and James, Georgie and Barsha alright and hurry towards her office, clearly serious.

FINGERS
(nodding towards James)
What's going on, Kingy?

BRAINS
Just hope it's not about Ruby.

(CONTINUED)

This pulls them all up, sharp. They put the kids on the bus with a degree of solemnity.

INT. BARSHA'S OFFICE. DAY 23 - 1225

74

Barsha is throwing some things into a bag. Some NGO's have gathered and she is talking to them as she packs.

James and Georgie are standing by the door.

BARSHA
(in Bengali)
I'll be back in the morning. Need you to sort out your rota's so someone is always on duty, 24 hours.

They nod.

GEORGIE
I'll arrange for someone to collect Sumon.

BARSHA
Can't I collect him?

JAMES
You'll be putting yourself in a vulnerable situation.

GEORGIE
We'll go and collect him and bring him to you at the barracks.

Barsha understands and nods.

75

EXT. BARRACKS. DAY 23 - 1230

75

We see James, Georgie and Barsha swinging into the barracks. Maisie is looking out of the isolation unit window.

76

INT. BARRACKS. ISOLATION UNIT. DAY 23 - 1231

76

Georgie comes in and see's Maisie.

MAISIE
He's gone back to sleep but... he opened his eyes.

GEORGIE
Did you talk to him?

MAISIE
A bit. Is that alright?

(CONTINUED)

Georgie checks on Ruby.

GEORGIE
His temperature is coming down.

MAISIE
Is that a good sign?

Georgie nods.

GEORGIE
We're going on a drive.

MAISIE
Are we?

GEORGIE
Barsha's staying here, we're going
to pick up her little boy.

Maisie looks a little surprised.

MAISIE
I won't ask.

GEORGIE
Need to know basis.

They smile and head out.

INT. MILITARY VEHICLE. DAY 23 - 1245

77

Maisie is driving, Georgie as co-driver/navigator sits next to her, maps spread out across her lap.

MAISIE
(tapping the sat-nav on
her phone)
I'm way ahead of you, Corporal.

Georgie flashes her a look.

GEORGIE
Belt and braces, Private. And I've
never had a map crash on me. Those
things...

MAISIE
I know what you mean.

They drive on.

78

EXT. SMALL NURSERY SCHOOL. DAY 23 - 1300

78

We see Maisie waiting in the vehicle as Georgie heads inside the school.

79

INT. SMALL NURSERY SCHOOL. DAY 23 - 1301

79

Georgie watches as all the children are leaving and heading on their way.

The teacher arrives holding Sumon's hand.

TEACHER

Mrs. CHOWDHREY rang...

GEORGIE

Excellent. I've also got a letter, signed, if you need that and my identification.

The teacher takes the letter and smiles.

TEACHER

(in Bengali)

Goodbye Sumon... we'll see you tomorrow.

They head off.

80

EXT. SMALL NURSERY SCHOOL. DAY 23 - 1303

80

Maisie waves as Georgie and Sumon get into the vehicle.

81

INT. MILITARY VEHICLE. DAY 23 - 1310

81

Maisie is driving, Georgie and Sumon now in the back.

MAISIE

(sings with gusto)

"As soon as I wake up, every night, every day. I know that it's you I need to take the blues away..."

GEORGIE

(laughing)

What the hell's that, Richards?

MAISIE

My dad used to sing it to me all the time when I was little.

GEORGIE

Really? That's sweet.

MAISIE

(sings with passion)

'It must be love, love, love. It must be love, love, love. Nothing more, nothing less, love is the best...'

(CONTINUED)

Maisie is clearly moved at the memory and cries. Georgie is astounded.

GEORGIE
Are you alright, Maisie?

MAISIE
I'm just... having a moment.

GEORGIE
(hugging Sumon)
We think it's lovely, don't we Sumon?

SUMON
(in Bengali)
Sing!

MAISIE
(sings gently)
'It must be love, love, love. It must be love, love, love. Nothing more, nothing less, love is the best...'

Maisie looks out of her window and sees a suspicious car pulling behind them. *

She immediately knows it's a situation.

MAISIE (CONT'D)
Have you got your belts on?

They have. Georgie suddenly realises something's occurring as Maisie slams the accelerator to the floor and zooms ahead.

The dubious car pursues them. *

82 **EXT. ROAD/INT. CARS. DAY 23 - 1311**

82

The dubious car pulls alongside them. Maisie sees the passenger wave a gun, signalling for her to pull over. *

83 **INT. MILITARY VEHICLE. DAY 23 - 1311**

83

Maisie rams on the brakes, forcing the other car to go ahead.

Maisie does a sharp turn down a side road. *

84 **EXT. ROAD/INT. CARS. DAY 23 - 1312**

84

The dubious car turns and pursues. *

85

INT. MILITARY VEHICLE. DAY 23 - 1312

85 *

Maisie makes another sharp turn down another side street. The
dubious car has missed it and shoots past. *

Georgie holds a petrified Sumon.

GEORGIE
We lost them, Maisie?

MAISIE
Yep.

GEORGIE
(resting a hand on
Maisie's shoulder)
Nice one, Richards.

MAISIE
That's the first time you've said
that and not been sarcastic.

GEORGIE
(into radio)
Hello zero alpha, this is alpha
one zero. We were being pursued by
suspect vehicle. Seems to be
resolved. Heading back to barracks
now. Out.

They drive on. Maisie going fast but totally in control.

MAISIE
Maybe time for you to sing a song,
Georgie.

They drive on. All eyes, but situation seems under control.

EXT. STREETS. DAY 23 - 1320

86

We see the military vehicle alone and driving back.

87

INT. MILITARY VEHICLE. DAY 23 - 1325

87

Maisie is driving along. Georgie is in the back with a calmer
Sumon.

Suddenly out of nowhere, a car smashes into the side of their
vehicle. Side impact. Chaos. Screams. Air bags. Contents
flying through the air. Glass shattering.

We see the three of them thrown around like rag dolls as the
vehicle comes to a shuddering stop.

88 **EXT. STREETS. DAY 23 - 1326**

88

We see the two guys from the another dubious 4x4 vehicle that we now see rammed them, approaching the military vehicle, guns drawn.

In the back of the 4x4 are another half a dozen heavily armed men.

Georgie and Maisie are completely outnumbered.

89 **INT. MILITARY VEHICLE. DAY 23 - 1327**

89

Georgie and Sumon seem shaken but alive.

Georgie looks at Maisie, slumped over the steering wheel, seemingly unconscious. Georgie rests her hand on her weapon, preparing.

Just as the guys reach the car, Maisie rams her foot on the accelerator and away.

90 **EXT. STREETS. DAY 23 - 1328**

90

We see the badly damaged military vehicle speeding down the streets, turning left and away as the gunmen run back towards their vehicle which is also damaged.

91 **INT. MILITARY VEHICLE. DAY 23 - 1329**

91

Maisie swings the vehicle down another side road and stops.

MAISIE

We need to get out and hide?

GEORGIE

Sumon, we're going to get out now...

MAISIE

We're not going to get back to the barracks in this.

They get out as smoke and steam comes from the engine.

MAISIE (CONT'D)

We're outnumbered and out gunned.
God knows how many vehicles they got out looking for us.

The engine is still smoking. They know this will locate them unless they run and hide.

92 **EXT. STREETS. DAY 23 - 1331**

92

Georgie is on the wire, Maisie holding Sumon as they hurry through the streets desperately seeking shelter.

 GEORGIE
 (into mic)
 Hello zero alpha, this is alpha
 one zero. Vehicle ambushed. Primary
 target safe. On the move, looking
 for shelter. Current location grid
 is 2341.89. Wait out.

They carry on running.

93 **INT. BARRACKS. COMMS ROOM. DAY 23 - 1332**

93

James has heard the message and runs out to scramble the guys.

94 **EXT. STREETS. DAY 23 - 1332**

94

A middle aged lady stall holder has seen what has happened and beckons Georgie and Maisie to her.

Georgie and Maisie exchange a glance and head to her stall with a small look up behind.

The stall holder gestures a large display of fruit and vegetables for them to hide underneath.

They have little option so dart underneath the stall.

The stall holder looks up and sees something like a dozen armed men walking down the road clearly searching for them.

95 **EXT. BARRACKS. DAY 23 - 1333**

95

James and Kingy are getting everyone, full combats, into the back of the truck.

Emergency. Fast and focused.

96 **EXT. STALL. DAY 23 - 1334**

96

We see Georgie and Maisie and Sumon underneath the stall.

The gunmen approach the stall holder as they walk down.

They both have their guns drawn. But know they couldn't win a fire fight.

97 **INT. TRUCK. DAY 23 - 1334**

97

James, Kingy and 2 section, weapons very ready are travelling at speed towards the coordinates.

98 **EXT. STALL/STREET. DAY 23 - 1334**

98

The gunmen approach the old lady stall holder.

GUNMEN
(in Bengali)
They came down this way.

The stall holder shakes her head.

Another gunman grabs her by the hair and throws her to the ground.

GUNMAN 2
They came down this way.

The stall holder points further down the road as if they have gone.

Gunman 2 stares at her and looks into the stall lock up. He gestures for his men to go inside.

We see Georgie and Maisie watching, petrified but staying focused, for Sumon.

They see gunman 2 put his gun to the stall holders head and shoot her.

Georgie and Maisie know if they break cover they will all die.

99 **INT. TRUCK. DAY 23 - 1335**

99

James and 2 section speeding through the streets.

They see the destroyed military vehicle now on fire and know they're close.

They pull up and all leap out. Weapons ready.

100 **EXT. STALL/STREET. DAY 23 - 1336**

100

The gunmen are now all over the stall/lock up.

Suddenly two of them gesture underneath the stall.

101 **EXT. UNDERNEATH THE STALL. DAY 23 - 1336** 101

Tight on a frightened Sumon, with Georgie and Maisie all trying to be silent and almost not even daring to breathe.

102 **EXT. STALL/STREET. DAY 23 - 1337** 102

Two of the gun men now on the either end of the stall, nod to each other and using their might, flip the stall over revealing Georgie, Maisie and Sumon.

All guns pointing at their heads.

Georgie and Maisie know to lower their weapons.

One of the men steps forward, roughly grabs Sumon, lifts him away from a screaming Georgie and Maisie.

They are pushed to the ground and within seconds Sumon is whisked away.

One gunmen leans down into the face of Georgie.

GUNMAN 1

He makes no statement or the child
has his head cut off.

And he too is away.

Georgie and Maisie are in a heap on the ground.

103 **EXT. STREETS. DAY 23 - 1338** 103

James and 2 section are running down the streets.

104 **EXT. STALL/STREET. DAY 23 - 1338** 104

Georgie and Maisie are picking themselves up as James and 2 section arrive and survey the scene.

GEORGIE

(screams)

They've got Sumon! They've got
Sumon!

Georgie throws her head back and screams.
