We see that the street has a police car cordoning the other end. Indistinct Police radio in the background,

Nana V talks to the policeman, he gesticulates.

NANA V

Right.

Nana V fetches an animal grasper pole from the van

10:00:19 Music Out: "The Mission"

10:00:19 Music in: "Rather be (feat. Jess Glynne)"

CHARLIE a golden labrador retriever puppy is sniffing around the room. JASMINE is dancing playing with a docked MP3 player, whilst NAOMI reads a book "Your new Puppy"

Charlie barks.

CHARLIE

(BARKS)

She raises her arm and gestures 'lie down' as she speaks

NAOMI

Right....Charlie, Charlie?...lie down. Oh for god sake. Charlie lie down. No not sit. Charlie lie down.

CHARLIE continues to bark and play, he ignores her.

Her husband, RAVI enters the living room and heads to the dining table, with a bicycle wheel.

NAOMI (CONT'D)
Charlie lie down.

A phone starts to ring.

NAOMI (cont'd) (CONT'D)
(in her dog voice, gesturing)
Jasmine... CD off.

RAVI
Naomi, your work phone's going.

NAOMI
Ooh it's one of the trustees.

NAOMI answers the phone

NAOMI (CONT'D)
Hello Mr Denomer. No, no, no
problem at all...

NAOMI switches off JASMINE's music at the plug socket and answers the phone.

10:00:46 Music out: "Rather be (feat. Jess Glynne)"

NAOMI (CONT'D)
...I was working anyway. Yes thank you so much for approving the grant aid I recommended.

JASMINE
Charlie's weeing again.

NAOMI
Ravi, can you get the mop. Yes no exactly.

The sound of police sirens in the background. CHARLIE gets over excited and bounces around NAOMI.

CHARLIE
(Barks)

He sniffs NAOMI's groin.

NAOMI
Why are you so interested in my crotch? Sorry Mr Denomer, no I'm talking to my new puppy. So sorry.

The police sirens become more distinguishable

JASMINE
There's police outside.

Naomi gets up to take a look and steps in Charlie's wee.

NAOMI
Oh.

NANA V's boots crunch the ice on the street. grasper pole at the ready.

10:01:11 SCENE IN: EXT. THE SINGH'S HOUSE - DAY - CONTINUOUS

NAOMI, JASMINE & RAVI have all come to the window to look at the proceedings.

10:01:14 SCENE IN: EXT. THE PARADE/PATTERDALE GARDENS - DAY - CONTINUOUS

ALEXANDER MOSS a good looking man in his thirties with a small fluffy dog on a lead, TOFFEE, a cavalier poodle cross walk down the parade, and decide to join the onlookers.

NANA V continues here perilous march down the Patterdale Gardens. She spots something down an alleyway. She silently indicates to the nearest police officer that she has something in her sights, army ops style. We see NAOMI, JASMINE & RAVI in the background looking from their window

NANA V slowly goes down on one knee, like a bomb disposal operative.

CHARLIE looks on through the window too.

NANA V crawls along the alleyway and places some cheese on the ground.

NANA V
Look! Look!

A medium sized very dark brown dog (NO NAME) is at the other end of the alley. NO NAME whines

NO NAME
(Whines)

NANA V
Look! Look!

NO NAME comes running.

10:02:06 SCENE IN: EXT. THE SINGH'S HOUSE. DAY - CONTINUOUS

Charlie barks.

CHARLIE
(barks)

10:02:07 SCENE IN: EXT. THE PARADE/PATTERDALE GARDENS - DAY - CONTINUOUS

The onlookers cheer.

CROWD
(Cheers and applause)

NANA V walks back down the road with NO NAME soaking in the applause.

NANA V
Thank you. Yeah no bother.

NAOMI
Oh, for heaven's sake, it's not a pantomime.

RAVI
Could be a banned breed.

NANA V continues to soak up the applause. ALEXANDER is in the crowd cheering too.

NAOMI

NANA V

A policeman stands next to the NANA V's VAN.

NANA V (cont'd) (CONT'D)
(To the policeman) Right, I'll invoice as usual shall I Pete?

POLICEMAN PETE
Yeah that's fine

NANA V
...and don't forget there'll be the overnights till we see if anyone bothers to claim her. Thanks for that drink the other night, by the way.

ALEXANDER approaches NANA V's van with TOFFEE.

PETE
My pleasure.

NANA V
Oh, I didn't leave my scrunchy on your bedside table did I?

PETE
I'll have a look for it for you.

NANA V
Great. (To NO NAME) Right, let's take a look at you. Sit. Good girl. Down, down.

ALEXANDER
You're very good with dogs.

NANA V
I was brought up in children's homes, so dogs are my life.

ALEXANDER
What's your secret...?

NANA V
A nice bit of crumbly cheshire cheese does the trick.

NANA V notices TOFFEE

NANA V (CONT'D)
Ah, he's a little cutie, aren't you?

ALEXANDER
Yeah, sort of.

ALEXANDER picks up TOFFEE

ALEXANDER (CONT'D)
We've been having a bit of a problem haven't we Toffee?

NANA V
Oh well I can help you with that. Every dog on the Wirral comes to me in the end. Nana V, agility class Mondays, Puppy class Tuesdays.
(MORE)

NANA V (CONT'D)
Or you can book me for a one on
one. Anytime. Number's on the side
of me van.

NANA V pulls shut the van door. The van has "NANA VEE - FOR
ALL YOUR DOGGING NEEDS -07700900527" stuck on the outside in
plastic lettering.

I have fed him.

NAOMI rolls her eyes. JASMINE, in her school uniform, rushes through the kitchen towards the back door.

NAOMI
Jasmine, are you aware of the time sweetheart? Have you got your school bag?

JASMINE
I'm not going to school.

NAOMI
Oh look, you are perfectly capable of sitting your Classics A-level in Year 12 whatever the teacher might say.

JASMINE heads towards the backdoor with a box.

JASMINE
What's the point? I can't live without love.

NAOMI
Jasmine I do love you.

JASMINE
Not everything is about you.

NAOMI
Well Dad loves you too. Now please, go and do your teeth.

JASMINE
But my boyfriend hates me.

NAOMI
Boyfriend?

JASMINE
Ex-boyfriend!

RAVI
Who's got a boyfriend!?

Establisher.

NANA V'S barn is laid out with Agility Class jumps, a seesaw, a tunnel, etc..A number of dogs and owners are sat waiting.

NO NAME, the stray dog, is with NANA V on a lead

NANA V
Right morning class. How we all
doing today? Up you get everybody
we're going to warm your dogs

NANA V's mobile rings and she answers the phone.

NANA V (CONT'D)
Oh. Nana V for all your dogging

wasn't chipped...no collar. We're
looking at re-homing situation
then. Only thing is she's a very
aggressive dog. I might have to
charge extras for a bit of rehab.
yeah.

NANA V kisses NO NAME on the head.

NANA V (CONT'D) (cont'd)
Yeah, well the thing is I think
she's very wary of men. I think she
must have been very badly treated
by them at somepoint haven't we all
eh? (laughs) never mind, some day
her prince will come...

NANA V looks over to see ALEXANDER is walking towards her, with TOFFEE on a lead.

NANA V (CONT'D) (cont'd)
I've got to go.

10:05:22 SCENE IN: EXT. THE SINGH'S GARDEN - DAY

NAOMI is in the garden as JASMINE throws clothes, letters, old soft toys, diaries into a posh outdoor fireplace. They go up in flames.

CHARLIE runs round the garden enjoying himself.

NAOMI
How far did you go?

JASMINE
I still love him.

NAOMI
Look sorry can you put this fire out please. This is a smokeless zone.

JASMINE
(Reading a card) I ache for you inside...

NAOMI
Jasmine, heterosexual girls of your age come under a huge amount of pressure from young men. Thirty one point six per cent of girls say they feel they had sex far too early and that goes up to 43 per cent if they were under 16 at the time.

CHARLIE very much still enjoying himself.

NAOMI (CONT'D)
Look Charlie. Dog's fur is probably highly flamable Jasmine! (Coughs)
Do you remember our chat about alternatives to intercourse?...

JASMINE picks up a nice top.

NAOMI (CONT'D)
Oral sex can be hugely enjoyable with the right prophylactic.

JASMINE
What?

NAOMI
There are specially flavoured condoms on the market, with, with edible lubricant which are, (coughs) actually perfectly palitable.

(Beat)

NAOMI (CONT'D)
Have you been asked to photograph your vulva on your smartphone?

JASMINE looks intensely at her mother.

JASMINE
We were in love.

NAOMI heads towards the house.

NAOMI
Ravi, get the fire extinguisher.
Jasmine's been having sex.

I can tell he's a little Evertonian, aren't you? Well he's a bit young but we can give him a go.

ALEXANDER
Could I just have a chat with you first?

Oh right, she's one of those. She's given up has she? Yeah?

ALEXANDER
Um...Sort of. I'm afraid she died.

NANA V enters the van with No Name, tired out.

Then, locks the car with a key fob. CHARLIE is in the back
seat and barks.

CHARLIE
(barks)

Naomi's phone RINGS

10:10:21 SCENE IN: EXT NAOMI'S CAR/NANA V'S CARAVAN - DAY - CONTINUOUS

Naomi answers her phone.

NAOMI
Oh yes hello there. yes, um no I won't be in the office today I'm afraid because my daughter is school refusing. So erm, I've come straight here. What is the, what is the boy's mother in prison for? A hundred and seven counts of caravan theft on the North Wales coast. Right okay...and RV's and motor homes....What is a toy haulers? Oh no don't worry, I don't need that level of detail. Don't worry about it. Okay, okay I'll, I'll send my report in as soon as I've interviewed them. Okay, yep. Okay, thanks Bunme.

NAOMI

NANA V
Right

NAOMI
Thank you anyway.

NO NAME is investigating NAOMI and she is clearly nervous of him. She is surrounded by paperwork which has FUTURE'Z stamped on it.

NANA V
Right there you go.
Eron does need to get off. I don't
know how long you're going to
detain him for but he's got to
school you know.

NAOMI
Yes of course. Yes. Sorry I. Just
it's a rather long process. We just
need to ensure that all the
suitability critera are met and I
just need to ask

NO NAME climbs onto NAOMI

NAOMI (CONT'D)
(high pitched) the appropriate
questions.

NANA V
'ey No Name, come here.

NAOMI (cont'd)
So erm....

NO NAME then decides to go for TONY's food.

NANA V
No Name come here.

TONY laughs

NAOMI
...so essentially what FUTURE'Z can
offer to gifted and talented
children of parents who, you know
sadly are, erm in prison. Is to
offer financial assistance, support
to enable them to take part in
various enriching and educative
schemes.

NANA V
Oh right, that's in the form of
cash is it, or?

NAOMI
Well no it would be in the form of
a grant paid into the legal
guardian's account.

NANA V
Very good. Very good.

NAOMI
So I see here, that Eron is not particularly academic...

NANA V
Oh well excuse me. (chuckles) This lad he's one of the best footballers of under eighteens in the whole north west.

NAOMI
Absolutely no judgement. I was going to go on to say that, that I had seen that in the notes, which is terrific. So as long as everything else is in order, you know we may well be in a position to offer Eron, erm some assistance in order to take part in his chosen field. NANA V

TONY and NANA V laugh. NAOMI joins in awkwardly.

NAOMI

Right. Well we might as well move on to the section about you, Granny. You walk and train and board dogs professionally do you?

SUPER MARIA yawns.

NANA V

I do. I actually work sometimes for the police. Erm, working on, well usually suspected banned dogs.

NAOMI

Right okay, and you have a licence for that I presume?

NANA V

(Lying) Yeah.

NAOMI

Great, okay so I will just need a copy of that

NANA V

Very good. Yeah, 'course.

NAOMI

Right and then these two dogs here, that one's an erm rotweiller is it?

NANA V

Yeah this is Eron's own dog.

NAOMI

So that's not a, a banned breed.

NANA V

No (laughs) no, not illegal no.

NAOMI

And this one is there any illegal?

NANA V

No. Well this one's definitely probably not PB. That' pitbull.

NAOMI

Right, erm so how would you? How is that proven? Is that blood tests?

NANA V

Well it can be, or characteristics, you know.'Ey come here No Name. there's a good girl.

NAOMI

Shouldn't it be wearing a muzzle?

NANA V

No! She's soft as spread. Yeah I don't know if you can see this, if you just look at her from there, you can see she's got the eye of a blue whale.

NAOMI can not.

NANA V (CONT'D)

No?

NAOMI 's phone rings.

NAOMI

Sorry, I'm going to have to get this 'scuse me a moment.

NAOMI stands up and looks out of the window. She and JASMINE have a phone call whilst looking at each other.

NAOMI (CONT'D)

Hello, no just, no you can't walk home. No, no jusy stay in the car please. Stay in the car. There are some very. There are some big dogs here, so just wait. I won't be too long. Alright, just stay where you are. Stay where you are. Okay alright, bye bye

NAOMI hangs up

NAOMI (CONT'D)

I'm sorry about. I've been forced to bring a minor on to the premises.

NANA V

Oh, right well, do you want to bring him in?

NAOMI

She. Erm, no I don't think...that would not be policy.

NANA V

Does she want some dinner? Eron goes and ask her if she wants a some dinner.

NAOMI

I'm sure she's fine

NANA V

Eron, go on son.

NAOMI
Well I've locked her in actually.
So...

NANA V
You've locked her in?

NAOMI
Well I've left a little crack in
the window. Perhaps I can do it
from here?

NAOMI tries to use the key fob from where she is.

NAOMI (CONT'D)
No that won't do it.

NANA V
Eron will sort that out. Go on Eron

NAOMI hesitates.

ERON
Don't worry miss. I'll bring them
back.

NAOMI
Oh no I wasn't for a minute
suggesting anything else, good
lord.

NANA V
Come here Super Maria.

ERON goes out to the car.

NAOMI
So if you can let me have the dog's
blood test results.

NANA V
Right, yeah okay.

NAOMI
That would be great.

NANA V
Oh it's guilty till proven innocent
is it?

NAOMI
Well, or you can just simply remove
the dog from the premises. If
there's any.

Through the window we see JASMINE and ERON talking next to
Naomi's car.
