CUT TO:

INT. NICKY'S FLAT. LIVING ROOM. PRE SCHOOL. 06:34 - DAY.

5

A weary looking NICKY, still in her dressing gown, sits on the sofa and reaches for a hairdressing magazine. However, secreted amongst its pages are a load of final demands and red bills. She looks at them in despair.

She freezes when there is a loud knock at the door.

Another knock and Nicky is on her feet, not sure what to do.

One more knock and this time someone shouts through the door.

LANDLORD (O.S.)
Mrs Walters? I know you're in
there.

Nicky silently curses. She hears Tonya's feet padding down the stairs and panics...

NICKY
Tonya! Don't...

But she is too late as TONYA opens the door. The Landlord along with two burly Bailiffs walk in.

LANDLORD
Morning, Mrs Walters. I think you know why I'm here.

NICKY
Nice one, Tonya. Why don't you offer 'em a cup of tea whilst you're at it?

TONYA
(confused)
What?

NICKY
(to Landlord)
I was going to come down to the office...

LANDLORD
Sorry, love. Too little, too late.
You've had the eviction notice...

TONYA
We're being evicted?

NICKY
Tonya, go get dressed.

A horrified Tonya goes out.

NICKY (CONT'D)
Can't we work something out?

LANDLORD

I don't think so. It's not just me
you owe, is it? That's what these
lads are here for. They'll be
taking goods to the value of your
arrears, and I'll be changing the
locks. Been a bit plastic
fantastic, have we?

Nicky is furious.

INT. NICKY'S FLAT. PRESTON'S BEDROOM. PRE SCHOOL. 06:43 - DAY.

7

An oblivious Preston is still on his exercise bike. One of the Bailiffs comes in and picks up Preston's laptop. Preston rips out his headphones as...

PRESTON

Who the hell are you? Get off!

He tries to take the laptop back but Bailiff 2 shrugs him off and starts pulling open drawers. He frowns as he reveals a drawer full of food including boxes of cereal, tins of fish, baby rusks, jars of peanut butter and canned energy drinks.

Preston slams the drawer shut.

PRESTON (CONT'D)

There's nothing you want in there.

The Bailiff raises his eyebrows and leaves with the foldaway bike and laptop, passing Nicky as she comes in.

PRESTON (CONT'D)

What's going on?

NICKY

I've messed up, alright? I thought we had more time, but they want us out.

PRESTON

What? Now?

NICKY

Pack what you can.

As she goes, Preston is left looking worried. He furtively reopens the food drawer and quickly fills a red sports bag with the contents.

CUT TO:

8

EXT. NICKY'S FLAT/SALON. PRE SCHOOL. 07:20 - DAY.

8

Nicky, Preston and Tonya stand on the pavement with their stuffed bags, including some supermarket bags for life. They watch as a LOCKSMITH uses an electric screwdriver to change the locks.

The Landlord puts up a 'Salon To Let' sign in the window of the mothballed salon.

NICKY

That place wasn't worth what he's charging. He's done us a favour.

TONYA

Really? What are we supposed to do with all this stuff? Where are we going to go?

NICKY

Tonya...

TONYA

Mum, where are we sleeping tonight?

NICKY

I don't know, alright? Maybe if you gave me five minutes to think instead of going on at me.

TONYA

I wasn't going on. I was just asking...

Preston can see they are drawing stares from passers-by.

PRESTON

Hey, let's not do this out here.

TONYA

Well, it's not like we've anywhere else to go.

NICKY/PRESTON

TONYA!

She clams up.

NICKY

Come on, we'll find somewhere to stash our bags at school.

TONYA

What? No. Please.

NICKY

If I don't go to work, I don't get paid.

PRESTON

Yeah, but how are you going to work and look for somewhere for us to stay?

NICKY

I'll manage. By the end of the day I'll have sorted something out. Come on. Get your stuff.

Preston reluctantly complies. As they gather up their belongings, we see that Nicky is only putting a brave face on things.

CUT TO:

9

EXT. SHOPPING PRECINCT. PRE SCHOOL. 08:05 - DAY.

9

A stressed DONTE walks an annoyed IZZY and TOMMY through the precinct.

DONTE

I've said I'm sorry.

IZZY

I just don't know how you could forget. I told you we were going back today. My shirt's not even properly ironed.

DONTE

Just keep your blazer on. Right, what do you want from the bakery? I need to pick up a package while we're out too.

IZZY

Nothing from there. And we haven't got time.

DONTE

It's you that said you couldn't go to school without a proper breakfast.

IZZY

I meant cornflakes or something.

DONTE

Yeah, well we don't have any.

IZZY

Or the milk to go on them.

DONTE

I'll do some shopping on my way home. So, what do you want?

(to Tommy)

What about a sausage roll?

Tommy seems enthused by the idea but...

IZZY

I'll get something at school. You did remember to put some dinner money on my card. Didn't you?

He didn't.

IZZY (CONT'D)

Oh God, Dad. You need to do it on the website. Remember?

DONTE

(sharp)

Alright, Izzy! Give it a rest, will you. I have got other things to think about, you know. Like the inquest hanging over me? I could do without you having a go every chance you get.

Izzy looks wounded.

IZZY

I'll walk myself to school!

A hurt Izzy storms off ahead. Donte instantly regrets snapping at her.

DONTE

(calling after her)

Izzy...

But she's gone. Donte looks down at Tommy.

DONTE (CONT'D)

Come on. How about that sausage roll?

CUT TO:

10

EXT. PLAYGROUND. PRE SCHOOL. 08:07 - DAY.

10

Kids are beginning to arrive. As they come into the playground they greet each other and catch up on the gossip. Some kids are kicking a ball around.

CUT TO:

11

INT. STAFF ROOM. PRE SCHOOL. 08:10 - DAY.

11

The morning meeting in full swing. KIM speaks to the staff - including LINDON, JOE, NEIL, AMY, CORAL and VALERIE.

KIM

Unfortunately, the Behavioural Unit
is already proving to be popular.
We've a permanent new...

CORAL

Inmate.

KIM

...addition this week. Dean Weever.

A ripple of amusement and raised eyebrows goes through the staff room.

NEIL

Quelle surprise, as the French
would say. Didn't he already make
his debut in there a few weeks
back?

JOE

If we're going to fill the place to
capacity, then that classroom is
going to need a bit of TLC.

LINDON

It's a behavioural unit, not
Butlins.

JOE

Have you tried teaching in there?
Half the lightbulbs have gone and
it's freezing. Wherever you sit,
you're in a draft.

LINDON

A good incentive not to be sent
there.

KIM

I'm sorry Joe, we're still a
caretaker down since Geoff retired
and Rolf is off sick. So if you can
all just bear with us for now.

This gets some groans.

KIM (CONT'D)

Okay, last thing. All being well, Izzy Charles will be back in school from today. I'm sure we all want her to feel welcome. I'm looking for someone to be her point of contact, her staff support.

AMY

I'm happy to do that.

KIM

Thanks, Amy.

AMY

No problem. Happy to help.

KIM

Okay, that's it for this morning. Thank you everybody.

As the meeting breaks up, Coral sidles over.

CORAL

That was good of you.

AMY

I want to get more involved in the pastoral side of teaching.

CORAL

As long as you're doing it for the right reasons.

AMY

What do you mean?

CORAL

Just as long as it's because you want to help Izzy - not just to make yourself feel better about what happened to her mum.

Amy's face falls as Coral walks away.

Neil has trapped an NS TEACHER beside the coffee machine as he bangs on. Lindon listens in as he checks his pigeon hole.

NEIL

I mean, what's wrong with cricket or footy? Or a bloody good cross country run? Basketball? It's just netball for poseurs.

Lindon rolls his eyes and is about to head off but...

NEIL (CONT'D)

It's certainly not worth Preston
Walters ruining his education over.

LINDON

What was that?

The NS Teacher takes the opportunity to escape.

NEIL

Well, ever since you made him
captain, Walters' grades have been
falling away and his homework's
been late more often than not.

LINDON

This is the first I'm hearing about
it.

NEIL

Well, now you know, he needs to
spend a bit more time hitting the
books instead of the gym.

Neil heads off, leaving Lindon concerned.

Valerie washes up the coffee cups whilst Joe has the tea
towel ready to dry up. They are deep in conversation.

JOE

Got the call from social services
last night. Jamilah was supposed to
be here to help me tell him, but
she's been called out to an
emergency at another school. So,
it's down to me.

VALERIE

How do you think he'll take it?

JOE

I really don't know.

VALERIE

Would it help to have someone else
there?

Joe smiles at her gratefully.

JOE

Thanks, Val. Oh God, poor Danny.

CUT TO:

12

INT. HOSTEL DORM. PRE SCHOOL. 08:15 - DAY.

12

KAI is in his uniform, quickly shoving his stuff in his school bag as DANNY comes back from the bathroom with his towel over his shoulder. He starts putting on his school tie as...

KAI

Is the bathroom clear?

DANNY

Yeah, but make sure nobody sees you. I don't want to get chucked out of here because you can't drag yourself away from the mirror.

KAI

Harsh, but fair.

Kai smiles but then yawns.

KAI (CONT'D)

I'm knackered. I barely slept again. What do you think that bloke was screaming about?

DANNY

I don't want to know.

Kai nods and they both look a bit haunted.

KAI

I never thought I'd look forward to going to school. Come on, we better get going.

DANNY

Yeah.

He hesitates before...

DANNY (CONT'D)

You know, if you wanted to go home...

KAI

I've told you, I can't.

DANNY

But if there were a way. I wouldn't...

KAI

Nah, mate. I'm not leaving you in this place on your own anyway. End of.

Danny is happy to hear this. Kai looks conflicted as...

MAC

Well, look at you two. In your little uniforms.

They turn as MAC (20s, terrifying) saunters in.

MAC (CONT'D)

You look like a right pair of tossers.

KAI

I mean, it's not couture but...

MAC

I hated school. They threw me out for hitting one of my teachers in the end. He was asking for it.

DANNY

I don't doubt it. Sorry, we've got to...

Danny and Kai try to leave but Mac is blocking the way.

MAC

Didn't they tell you that you're not allowed overnight visitors? You'll be out on your ear if they find out.

DANNY

Yeah, but only if someone says something.

MAC

True.

He looks Danny up and down.

MAC (CONT'D)

Nice shoes. What size are you?

Danny and Kai exchange a look.

The bell goes as the last few stragglers are heading inside. Izzy hangs back, keeping a low profile and waiting for the playground to empty.

She notices Kai and a furious looking Danny arriving and frowns when she sees that Danny is wearing flip-flops instead of his school shoes.

As Izzy goes through security, she is annoyed to find Amy waiting for her.

AMY

Hello, Izzy. Glad to be back? How are you doing?

IZZY

Fine.

AMY

That's great, but I hope you know it's okay if you're not fine. That's what I'm here for.

IZZY

What do you mean?

AMY

Well, Miss Campbell has asked me to give you a bit of extra support for the next few weeks. Just until you get back into the swing of things. In the meantime, you can come to me with any problems or if you just want a chat. How does that sound?

It's the last thing Izzy wants to hear.

IZZY

Great.

AMY

So, why don't we start with a check-in at break time? See how you're feeling after your first lesson? Look forward to it. Shall I walk you to registration?

IZZY

It's alright, Miss. I know where I'm going.

Izzy gives her a weak smile and heads off. Amy watches her go with concern.

KIM

KIM
That's very generous of you.

NICKY
(pointed)
Got to do your bit, haven't you?
There's always someone worse off
than you. However bad things are.

KIM
Very true.

Kim is not at all convinced by all this. Still...

KIM (CONT'D)
Put it somewhere safe.
(to Preston)
And then you need to get to class.

PRESTON
Yes, Miss.

Kim heads off. Nicky waits until she is out of earshot...

NICKY
Nosy cow.

Preston rolls his eyes.

PRESTON

Maybe we should have taken the day off.

Preston looks worried as they head for the kitchen.

CUT TO:

18

EXT. SHOPPING PRECINCT. PERIOD ONE. 09:10 - DAY.

18

Donte's heading home after dropping Tommy off. He is carrying the parcel he's picked up.

As he sadly spots a young couple passing, he looks down at the label on the parcel for a clue as to what it might be. To no avail, he opens it and pulls something out the packaging.

It is a pink light up sign that reads 'Chlo's Bar'. Donte becomes emotional at the sight of it.

CUT TO:

19

Nicky and Preston have stashed their stuff behind some sacks of potatoes.

NICKY

It'll be alright there.

She holds her hand out for the red sports bag that Preston filled with his food stash. He keeps hold of it as...

PRESTON

She smiles and they steal a quick kiss.

SAMIA (CONT'D)

Where were you this morning? I was worried.

PRESTON

Forgot to set my alarm. I slept in.

SAMIA

Duh, idiot.

PRESTON

I know.

SAMIA

See you at break?

PRESTON

Yeah.

He gives her another quick peck and she heads off. His face falls the moment she is out of sight. He looks at the bag in his hand but then shoves it in his locker and heads off.

CUT TO:

The YR9 pupils are working in small groups. They all have big sheets of paper and markers in front of them. Tonya, Izzy, DWAYNE, SHOLA and NORULLAH are working together. Amy is teaching.

AMY

So, you're thinking about the best staging for the play. Think about how you want to engage with your audience. Remember, theatre doesn't have to happen in a theatre.

The groups start talking intently.

DWAYNE

I don't know what she means by that.

TONYA

Are we supposed to put a play on in a supermarket?

They exchange a look.

DWAYNE

Put it down.

They look at him.

DWAYNE (CONT'D)

It's drama, there aren't any wrong answers, are there?

Shola writes on the paper as Amy approaches.

AMY

You guys need any help? Izzy? You okay? I'm here if you need me.

Amy smiles and moves on. Izzy is aware of her teammates looking at her with sympathy, except for Tonya, who is amused...

TONYA

Shola gives her a sharp look. The penny drops and Tonya turns to Izzy.

TONYA (CONT'D)
Didn't mean to upset you.

IZZY
You didn't.
(to Shola)
And I can speak for myself, thanks.

Shola bristles a bit at this.

IZZY (CONT'D)
Can we get on with this? Or she'll come back over.

SHOLA
Put car park down.

Shola obliges. Izzy looks at Tonya with interest before...

IZZY
What was going on in the school car park this morning? The taxi and the bags and that?

TONYA
Didn't think anybody had seen us.

Everyone is interested now.

TONYA (CONT'D)
If you must know, we got evicted this morning.

Wide eyes all around. Tonya is rather enjoying the attention.

PRESTON

I know. I'm going to get sorted.

LINDON

Good. Because you've a lot on your plate. School work, training and you've got a girlfriend.

He nods at the phone which is still in Preston's hand.

PRESTON

Yeah. You're right.

LINDON

Get your priorities straight.

PRESTON
I'll do that.

He makes to leave.

LINDON
See you at lunchtime?

PRESTON
Will you?

LINDON
Basketball practise.

PRESTON
Of course.

LINDON
I'm putting you through your paces
today.

PRESTON
Glad to hear it, Sir.

Preston looks stressed as he walks away.

CUT TO:

24

EXT. PLAYGROUND. BREAK. 11:12 - DAY.

24

The usual break time activities are underway. A gang of girls scream theatrically as a gang of lads rush them.

Samia is waiting for Preston. She looks at her phone and then furiously texts something.

CUT TO:

Preston's phone beeps, but he ignores it as he gets his red bag from his locker and heads off.

Izzy makes her way down the corridor. Amy comes after her...

AMY

Izzy?

Danny comes in to find Joe and Valerie there.

DANNY

You wanted to see me?

He is surprised to see Valerie. She spots his flip flops.

VALERIE

Where are your shoes, Danny?

DANNY

It's a long story.

JOE

What size are you?

DANNY

Nine.

Joe opens his desk drawer and pulls out a pair of battered trainers.

JOE

Here. I was going to start jogging home from work.

VALERIE

Well, now you've got a good excuse not to.

Danny puts them on as Joe looks on.

JOE

So, we need to tell you something. Miss Omar has been in touch with your mum.

Danny looks up.

JOE (CONT'D)

She's in Birmingham.

DANNY

Birmingham?

JOE

Thanks. For the shoes.

He goes. Valerie and Joe exchange a desperate look.

JOE

Do you ever feel like you're doing more harm than good?

VALERIE

Only every other day.

CUT TO:

INT. BOY'S TOILETS. BREAK. 11:16 - DAY.

27

Preston comes into the loos with his red bag. He locks himself in a cubicle and sits with the bag on his lap. He takes a moment to himself and is about to unzip it when he hears someone come in and lock themselves into the next cubicle.

It is an upset Danny. He too is hiding and fighting to keep himself together, taking deep breaths. Unwelcome tears slip down his face and he swipes at them angrily with his sleeve. He takes out his phone and calls 'MUM'. It goes straight to voicemail.

VOICEMAIL (V.O.)

The caller is unavailable. Please leave a message.

The beep goes.

DANNY

Mum...

But Danny can't think of anything to say. He kills the call and buries his head in his hands and cries.

In his cubicle, Preston silently curses before quietly slipping back out with his bag.

Donte arrives at school and hesitates before heading inside.

CUT TO:

The bell rings for the end of break as a frustrated Preston is stashing his red bag in his locker when KELLY JO makes him jump.

KELLY JO
What are you doing?

PRESTON
What? Nothing.

He slams the locker shut.

PRESTON (CONT'D)
What do you want?

KELLY JO
Is it true you've been turfed out
of your flat?

Preston looks around to see if anyone heard, before pulling Kelly Jo aside for a bit more privacy.

PRESTON
Who did you hear that off?

KELLY JO
Some year nines were talking about
it in the bog. It's all over
school.

He silently curses.

KELLY JO (CONT'D)
So, it's true?

PRESTON
Yeah, but we didn't want everyone
knowing.

KELLY JO
Oh my God, does that mean you're
homeless now?

PRESTON
No. I'm going to sort it.

KELLY JO
Good.

He heads off trying to keep his annoyance and stress under control. Kelly Jo shouts after him.

KELLY JO (CONT'D)

I was proper worried. I was going to ring my mum and tell her to blow up my air bed for you.

Preston turns and gives her a glare. Kelly Jo realises what she has done.

KELLY JO (CONT'D)

Oh yeah. Sorry.

Suddenly, Amy engulfs her in a sheet of foil.

CORAL (CONT'D)
What the hell are you doing?

AMY
I'm trapping your body heat in, Coral. We have to get your core temperature back up.

CORAL
I'm not a bloody baked potato.

They all turn as...

KIM
Does someone want to tell me why the canteen shutters are still down?
(to Coral)
And why one of your pupils is outside hobbling about on a swollen ankle?

Coral points at Nicky.

CORAL

Well, I was getting ice for that ankle when Mrs Walters decided to shut me in a freezer.

NICKY

That's not... I told you not to go in there.

CORAL

So, you thought you'd teach me a lesson?

NICKY

The handle came off!

CORAL

And if you believe that, you'll believe anything.

DONTE

The door is knackered, but I reckon I can fix it. At least until you can get someone out to it.

NICKY

See?!

KIM

Okay, okay. Let's calm this down.

CORAL

Sorry, but I could have frozen to death.

NICKY

In ten minutes?

Coral flashes her a filthy look.

KIM

(To Donte)

Thank you. I know you didn't come to rescue teachers.

DONTE

It was nice to feel useful.

KIM

Amy. Why don't you take Miss Walker to the staff room for warm drink?

As Amy and Coral go out, Kim turns to Nicky.

KIM (CONT'D)

Let's get the canteen open before we have another riot on our hands.

KIM (CONT'D)

And when you've finished with

Nicky's heart sinks.

CUT TO:

The basketball game continues, where things are getting physical and sweaty out on the court with both Danny and Preston working out their respective frustrations.

Danny hip checks Preston to get the ball. Preston responds by slapping it out of his hands and scoring.

LINDON

Nice. Keep up the pace.

Kai collects the ball and passes it deftly to Danny but Preston clatters him from behind. Danny is instantly on his feet.

DANNY

Have you got a problem with me?

PRESTON

It's you that's got the problem.

DANNY

What makes you say that?

PRESTON

Well, you can't stay on your feet.
Maybe it's your shoes.

Danny is still wearing Joe's trainers. Before Danny can respond...

LINDON

Preston! What are you doing? Head in the game.

Preston goes back to playing. Kai comes over to Danny.

KAI

Everything alright?

DANNY

He needs to get over himself.

KAI

And you need to check yourself.
You're already on your last warning, remember?

He nods over to Lindon who meets their gaze.

LINDON

What are you waiting for? A hand-written invitation? Get back in there!

Danny gets back into the game. This time it is Danny who gets the ball from Preston and scores.

KAI

Oh! That's gotta hurt!

Preston is about to step up to Kai when Lindon blows the whistle to end the game.

LINDON

Alright, that's enough. Hit the showers.

Everyone heads out but Lindon stops Preston.

LINDON (CONT'D)

Preston? What the hell is going on with you?

PRESTON

For the last time, nothing!

He clocks the look on Lindon's face and immediately moderates his tone.

PRESTON (CONT'D)

I'm sorry, sir. I didn't mean that..

LINDON

I should hope not. That aggression is okay on the court but off it...

PRESTON

I know. I just get a bit wound up.

LINDON

Because you let yourself get wound up. And it's a weakness. You need to get your emotions under control. Do you hear me?

PRESTON

Yes, sir. I know how to do that.

LINDON

Go cool off in the shower.

PRESTON

I thought I'd do a few laps. Make up for being late.

LINDON

That's more like it.

Lindon goes, thinking he's given a good pep talk, but Preston looks even more stressed as he starts jogging around the gym.

CUT TO:

Preston is really pushing himself as he runs his laps. He is breathing hard and sweating and there is a grim look of determination on his face. Finally, he stumbles and collapses to the floor, utterly spent.

INT. GYM SHOWER/CHANGING AREA. LUNCH. 13:08 - DAY.

56 B

The changing room is emptying out as Preston comes in from the gym. Danny is fastening his shoes as Kai fastens his shirt and sprays deodorant under his arms.

KAI

Ooh, can you smell that? Smells like... victory.

Danny allows himself a smile at this. Some of the other lads are laughing. Kai sees that Preston isn't amused, so he sprays him.

KAI (CONT'D)

Here you go.

PRESTON

What the hell are you doing?

KAI

Just thought you might like to smell like a winner.

He gives him another spritz and Preston smacks the can from his hand.

PRESTON

Do that again and I'll shove it up your arse.

KAI

Can't you take a joke?

PRESTON

You are a joke.

KAI

Look, you're clearly having a crap day so I'll let that go...

PRESTON

What's that supposed to mean?

Kai and Danny exchange an awkward look.

DANNY

We know you got chucked out of your place.

It's as if all the air goes out of the room for Preston.

PRESTON

No. That's not...

KAI

Mate, everyone knows.

Suddenly Preston is full of rage and humiliation that he needs to vent. He turns on Kai.

PRESTON

And I suppose you had a good laugh about it? Didn't you?

Kai shakes his head in disgust.

KAI

You need to get over yourself.

PRESTON

What? You reckon you need to bring me down a peg or two? Why? Is it the only way you can get on my level?

KAI

What are you on about?

PRESTON

Well, you couldn't handle it. Right? Everyone watching you. Just waiting for you to screw-up.

None of them notice Lindon coming in. Preston is shouting right in Kai's face as...

PRESTON (CONT'D)

You've no idea. You pathetic little...

He takes a threatening step towards Kai.

LINDON

That's enough!

Preston realises he's made a terrible mistake.

CUT TO:

57

INT. HEAD TEACHER'S OFFICE. LUNCH. 13:13 - DAY.

57

Kim stares at Preston whilst Lindon looks disappointed.

KIM

I can't believe I have to say this, but we do not verbally abuse people in this school. Even if we are having a tough time at home.

Preston reacts to that sharply.

KIM (CONT'D)

If that had escalated beyond a bit of shouting, we'd be having a far more serious conversation right now. A conversation that would involve your mum. And I get the feeling that's the last thing she needs right now.

Preston hangs his head at this, hiding his upset.

KIM (CONT'D)

You need to get your temper under control. And if you can't...

PRESTON

I can.

LINDON

Didn't look like it to me.

PRESTON

I have... coping mechanisms.

Lindon and Kim exchange a surprised look.

PRESTON (CONT'D)

It won't happen again. I promise.

He is sincere.

PRESTON (CONT'D)

I'll apologise to Kai. I'll make it right.

KIM

See that you do. Go to your lesson.

He goes out. Kim looks to Lindon.

KIM (CONT'D)

Just a blip?

LINDON

Yeah. He's a good lad. I've a lot
of time for him.

KIM

Not like you to play favourites.

LINDON

Maybe I see a bit of myself in him.

KIM

Really? And what is it about the
heart throb of the sixth form and
captain of the basketball team that
reminds you of yourself, Lindon?

She looks at him with a straight face.

LINDON

You're right. It's like looking in
the mirror.

He goes, leaving her to smile to herself.

CUT TO:

58

Tonya is eating her lunch on the embankment behind the car park. She looks up to see Izzy.

TONYA

No! This is my spot.

IZZY

I don't see your name on it.

She plonks herself down.

You don't get to do whatever you like just because your mum died, you know.

There is a moment of shocked silence, but then Izzy cracks out laughing.

IZZY

Oh my God! You're awful.

TONYA

So everyone keeps telling me.

IZZY

But thank you.

TONYA

For what?

IZZY

For saying she died. Not that she passed on or that I lost her. I hate that. Makes her sound like a...

TONYA

Sock?

Izzy looks shocked.

TONYA (CONT'D)

Sorry! Sometimes stuff like that just pops into my head.

IZZY

And out of your mouth.

They laugh.

IZZY (CONT'D)

That's the first time I've laughed in ages.

Izzy suddenly looks sad again, guilty to have forgotten her grief.

TONYA

Here, do you fancy going somewhere more fun?

IZZY

There's only ten minutes of dinner time left.

TONYA

Yeah, but we've got history with Guthrie next. Not like we'll be missing anything important.

IZZY

I don't know. I've never bunked off before.

TONYA

I do it all the time.
(loaded)
No-one ever misses me.

Izzy is still not sure.

TONYA (CONT'D)

Come on! Look, if we get caught, you just look a bit sad and remind them that you lost your mum.

Izzy pretends to be shocked, but she still gets up. They head off together.

Kai and Danny sit together.

KAI

He looks at them expectantly.

DANNY

Been thrown out the hostel, haven't I? They told me it was for thieving.

KAI

That's nothing to do with us.

MAC

Don't you lie to me.

Danny's anger flashes at this.

DANNY

We didn't say anything! Alright? You've probably stolen something off everyone in that hostel.

Suddenly Mac has him by the throat. Danny is terrified.

MAC

Who do you think you're talking to? A couple of nights in a hostel and you think you're it?

Valerie sees the trouble and gets on her walkie-talkie as she heads over.

VALERIE

Immediate assistance required in the playground.

(to Mac)

(MORE)

VALERIE (CONT'D)

I don't know why you are on school
property but you need to leave.

MAC

In a minute.

VALERIE

I won't tell you again...

Mac lets Danny go, but gets in Valerie's face.

MAC

You won't tell me anything,
darling. Outside the school gates,
you're just like anyone else.
That's what you teachers always
forget.

Valerie stands her ground. Mac is amused.

MAC (CONT'D)

Always hated teachers. Talking to
me like I were stupid or something.

VALERIE

Well, things have changed since you
were last at school. For a start,
we have CCTV.

She points to one and he instinctively looks up.

VALERIE (CONT'D)

Ooh, that'll be a good shot. Tell
me, are you a familiar face to the
police?

Mac hesitates but storms off. Valerie takes a deep breath.

CUT TO:

59A

INT. DEPUTY HEADS' OFFICE. PERIOD FOUR. 13:40 - DAY.

59A

Joe and Valerie speak with Danny and Kai.

JOE

Sorry, you're both living at
Sardinia House?

Danny and Kai nod. Joe and Valerie look at each other.

JOE (CONT'D)

(to Kai)

Because your parents threw you out?

KAI

They're always on me, Sir. You
know? About my lifestyle choices?

Valerie frowns at this, suspicious.

KAI (CONT'D)

But it's okay. Me and Danny can
keep an eye out for each other.

DANNY

It wasn't my fault that Mac came
here. He's not right in the head...

JOE

You're not in trouble. We're just
trying to work out the best way to
keep you safe.

VALERIE

Why don't you come back after
class. We'll see what we can come
up with.

Danny and Kai leave.

JOE

I better let Jamilah know we've
another homeless pupil.

VALERIE

Hold your horses. I think we should
hear the other side of Kai's story
first.

Joe is intrigued.

CUT TO:

60

INT. KITCHENS. LUNCH. 13:18 - DAY.

60

Preston comes in to find an anxious Nicky cleaning with one hand but still scrolling through her contacts on her phone.

PRESTON

Mum?

She plasters on a smile for his benefit.

NICKY

Alright, love? How's your day going? Better than mine, I hope.

PRESTON

Have you found us anywhere to stay?

Nicky decides not to lie to him.

NICKY

Not yet. And not for the want of trying. Tried to call in a few favours. Turns out a friend in need is an endangered species. Called the council about getting on the housing list but it sounds like you'll have kids of your own before they find us somewhere.

Her smile melts as...

NICKY (CONT'D)

And Miss Campbell wants to see me later and I don't think it's to tell me I'm employee of the month.

She is close to tears now.

PRESTON

Don't, Mum. It's going to be okay. I think I've found us somewhere.

NICKY

Oh, you little smasher. Where?

Preston hesitates - he has a good idea how this news is going to go down.

PRESTON

I went to see Auntie Debs. And I know what you're going to say...

NICKY

Over my dead body.

PRESTON

Mum!

NICKY

How could you? She was the last person I wanted to know! And I bet she was over the moon to hear I screwed everything up. Wasn't she?

He can't deny it.

NICKY (CONT'D)

Yeah. And she said she'd put us up? What's the catch?

PRESTON

She wants you to apologise. For what you said to her last time...

NICKY

Forget it.

PRESTON

Mum...

NICKY

I'd rather sleep on the streets.

She goes back to her cleaning, turning her back on him to hide her emotions. Preston flounders for a moment but knows there's no point in arguing. Preston looks more stressed than ever.

CUT TO:

INT. FOYER / MAIN CORRIDOR. LUNCH. 13:23 - DAY.

60 A

As the lunch bell goes, Preston comes out and makes his way past the crowd of kids rushing to class. He feels exposed and scrutinised.

He becomes aware of people whispering and casting looks his way. He sees Kelly Jo talking to a gang of girls, who all giggle as he goes past. He gets his head down and pushes roughly past some YR7 kids, desperate to escape the stares.

CUT TO:

Coral is ready to teach the YR12s but with her coat still on and a cup of hot coffee in her hands. A visibly worked up Preston comes in and takes a seat, but he's paranoid as he observes Kai and Caz whispering. As they both look up at him, Preston's increasingly on edge.

CORAL

Let's make a start. The key themes of The Great Gatsby...

As everyone gets their books out, Preston is feeling hot and loosens his collar. He is struggling to stay still.

CORAL (CONT'D)

So, initial thoughts? What do you think Fitzgerald was trying to tell us? What was his central message?

Caz's hand goes up.

CAZ

Just because it looks like you've got everything, it doesn't make you happy.

Preston is really struggling now. Sweat stands out on his forehead and he is breathing hard. People around him are starting to notice and whisper - adding to his distress.

CORAL

Interesting. Can you expand on that?

The classroom descends into chatter and debate. The noise triggers Preston who stands suddenly, tipping over his chair. All eyes are on him as...

CORAL (CONT'D)

Preston? Sit down.

PRESTON

No... I can't be in here... Sorry.

He bolts from the room, much to the amusement and curiosity of his classmates. Coral goes after him.

CUT TO:

63

Lindon is heading up the corridor when Preston barrels past him and Coral comes out after him.

CORAL

Preston Walters, get back here.

LINDON

I've got this. Go back to your class.

Lindon goes after Preston as Coral goes back into her classroom.

CORAL

Back to your desks! It's a classroom not a circus!

CUT TO:

Preston crashes into an empty classroom and collapses to the floor. He tears at his tie and collar, gasping for breath. He is in the midst of his first panic attack. Lindon comes in.

PRESTON

No! Please.

His breathing gets ragged again.

Okay, okay. Just keep breathing.

He sits beside Preston.

65

Kim looks up as a defensive Nicky comes in.

NICKY

Okay, I'm here. Can we make this quick. I've got a lot on my plate.

KIM

That's what I wanted to talk to you about...

NICKY

Yeah, I get it. I've given you the excuse you needed to sack me, but if you were half the headteacher you reckon to be, you'd hear my side of it.

KIM

Okay. That's fair.

She looks at Nicky expectantly.

NICKY

Nicky looks skyward as...

NICKY
Oh, you're having a laugh!

CUT TO:

66

EXT / INT. PET SHOP. PERIOD FOUR. 13:54 - DAY.

66

Tonya and Izzy walk down the street. Izzy looks a bit nervous.

IZZY

Where are we going? I've not got any money for shopping or anything.

TONYA

Costs nothing to look.

They stop outside a pet shop.

IZZY

Mum hated this place.

TONYA

Why? Didn't she like animals?

IZZY

She loved them, but she reckoned this place was a disgrace. They don't look after the pets right.

Tonya makes a decision.

TONYA

Come on.

Tonya goes in. Izzy follows.

The shop is full of aquarium and vivarium. The creepy SHOPKEEPER eyes Izzy and Tonya as they look around.

TONYA (CONT'D)

Ugh. It stinks in here.

They regard a tank of white mice.

IZZY

Look at all these.

TONYA

(of the Shopkeeper)

You know what he does with them?

IZZY

What?

She nods to another tank containing a large snake - the sign above his tank reads "Ronaldo".

IZZY (CONT'D)

Do you think so?

TONYA
Looks pretty well fed to me.

Tonya gets a determined look on her face.

TONYA (CONT'D)
Open your bag.

IZZY
Why?

TONYA
Just do it.

She does and Tonya reaches into the tank. Izzy grins as Tonya gleefully fills her bag with rescued mice until the shopkeeper shout after them to stop...

Tonya and Izzy explode out of the shop with the Shopkeeper in hot pursuit.

CUT TO:

I don't want to pile it on, but I think you should know that I had Preston in my office this afternoon.

NICKY

Preston?

KIM

He'd been verbally abusive to another pupil.

NICKY

Well, it looks like you'll be able to get rid of us all in one go then. That's a good day's work for you.

Kim lets that slide.

KIM

I've no intention of sacking you. Or excluding Tonya and Preston. I just want to know what I can do to help.

Nicky hesitates before letting pride get in her way again.

NICKY

Nothing. I can manage.

KIM

I'm not sure that's true.

NICKY

I always have before.

KIM

I know, I've seen how hard you work. How strong you are. How you always come out fighting. And if there were any justice in this world, that should have been enough to keep you afloat. But the way things are at the moment, it's just not. And that's not your fault.

Nicky gets emotional when she hears this.

KIM (CONT'D)

And I get how hard it is to admit that not everything is in your control. Believe me. I have to deal with that everyday in this place. And I've had to realise that I can't do it all. And there's no shame in that, Mrs Walters. There's no shame in asking for a bit of help.

Kim gets up.

KIM (CONT'D)

I'll go and find out if there's any news.

Kim goes out leaving Nicky emotional and thoughtful.

CUT TO:

71

INT. CLASSROOM. PERIOD FIVE. 14:31 - DAY.

71

Preston is calm now as he and Lindon breathe together.

LINDON

Nice and slow. That's it. So, I think you've had a panic attack.

PRESTON

No! It felt like...

LINDON

Like you were dying? Yeah, that's what it feels like. It's caused by your brain releasing hormones like adrenaline.

PRESTON

Are you sure?

LINDON

I'm not a doctor, but I know the signs. It's pretty common.

PRESTON

Yeah?

LINDON

You know, I really should talk to your mum.

PRESTON

You can't.

LINDON

Why not?

PRESTON

Have you met her?

Lindon suppresses a smile at this.

PRESTON (CONT'D)

She'll turn it into something it's not. And it's just a one-off.

LINDON

I didn't say that.

PRESTON

But it is. I know it is. I can usually cope. I have things that I do that help when I get stressed.

LINDON

What do you mean? Breathing
exercises? Mindfulness?

PRESTON

Something like that. But today...I
couldn't find the time I needed.

Nicky sits with a cup of tea. Wendy is on the phone as Donte rushes past and into Kim's office.

WENDY (O.S.)

Thank you for that. I'll let them know.

Wendy pops her head into the office.

WENDY (CONT'D)

Mr Charles...

DONTE

You were supposed to be keeping an eye on her. And she just walks out of school? And now nobody has any idea where the hell she is?

WENDY

She's in the back of a police car, on her way back to school. That was the station on the phone.

Donte slumps with relief.

NICKY

And Tonya?

WENDY

Her as well.

DONTE

Who's Tonya?

NICKY

My little idiot. This will have been all her idea.

She gives Donte an apologetic smile and offers him her tea.

NICKY (CONT'D)

Here, you look like you need this more than me. Four sugars.

He sits down beside her looking worn out. Wendy goes back to her work but is listening in as...

NICKY (CONT'D)

It's okay. Breathe. She's safe.

DONTE

This time. And no thanks to me.

NICKY

Don't be daft. You can't watch them
24/7. Especially when it's just
you.

DONTE

What are you supposed to do then?

NICKY

Knock a bit sense into them and
hope they make good decisions?

DONTE

No, it's not enough. I need to sort
something out. Sort myself out. I
need her to know I'm always there
for her.

NICKY

Well, don't expect her to thank you
for it.

CUT TO:

74

Joe is with Valerie and SALMA who is in her coat and nurses' scrubs with her hospital ID around her neck. There is a knock on the door and Kai and Danny come in. Kai is surprised to see Salma.

KAI

Salma?

SALMA

Well, I've just heard quite the tragic story from your teachers. About your terrible abusive parents and your miserable home life.

KAI

I didn't say abusive.

A guilty Kai looks to Danny.

KAI (CONT'D)

They don't approve of me. Dad can't even say the word 'gay'. And Mum's always telling me to tone it down. I'm not allowed to be my true self.

SALMA

That's because your true self is bloody annoying! Have you any idea what it's like living with you at full volume?

He rolls his eyes at this.

KAI

See? They suppress me.

SALMA

They're not even at home! They've gone away for a family funeral. I was keeping an eye on him but I work shifts.

(to Kai)

And you end up in a homeless shelter? Mum's going to be mortified when she finds out.

KAI

Then maybe don't tell her.

SALMA

You must be joking. The minute she gets off the plane, mate.

KAI

Oh my God! You are proper loving this.

Valerie can see the upset on Danny's face.

VALERIE

That's enough, Kai.

VALERIE

(worrying)

We'll make some calls, Danny. We'll try and find you somewhere else to go.

Val isn't convinced by her own words while the look on Joe's face tells Danny everything he needs to know.

DANNY

Don't worry. I can handle myself.

Danny slopes out.

JOE

We can't make those kind of
promises. There's nowhere else for
him to go.

VALERIE

What was I supposed to say? I can't
forget what I've seen and heard
Joe.

Joe agrees, but feels totally helpless. Val is conflicted.

CUT TO:

Kim talks to Tonya and Izzy as Nicky and Donte look on.

KIM

I'm very glad you two are getting on. I think you both probably need a good friend at the moment.

KIM (CONT'D)

But in the future keep it on school grounds. No more adventures. Or you'll be BFFs in the BU. Understand?

TONYA/IZZY

Yes, Miss Campbell.

KIM

For the rest of the term you need to get your school journals signed at the start and finish of every lesson. And then bring them to Mrs Whitwell to be checked at the end of each day.

They both groan at that. Kim is unmoved.

KIM (CONT'D)

Off you go.

The girls troop out. Nicky pauses as...

NICKY

(to Kim)

Why? Do you know someone?

DONTE

KIM
(taken aback)

DONTE

KIM
You should know that it's not all
rescuing teachers from the deep
freeze. It's also sorting faulty
toilets and waxing floors.

DONTE
I don't care. I need to get my life
sorted, Miss Campbell. For my kids.
For Chlo.

KIM
(impressed)
Then the job's yours.

Donte is grateful and happy.

NICKY

I'm sorry.

Debs looks at her. She needs more...

NICKY (CONT'D)

For what I said, last time I was here. I was out of order. Mind you, you said some things too...

Debs makes a show of considering. Preston is on tenterhooks until...

DEBS

I'll put the kettle on.

She goes inside. Nicky turns to Preston, resentful.

NICKY

Happy now?

PRESTON

It's for the best, Mum.

An unhappy Nicky trudges inside. Preston watches her go, before...

PRESTON (CONT'D)

Actually, I'm going to meet Sami now Mum. Will you be okay?

Nicky gives him a small smile, and Preston heads off, clutching his red bag.

CUT TO:

Val is driving from the staff overflow car park when she sees Danny leaving for the hostel. She pulls up beside him.

VALERIE

(stunned)

VALERIE

Then you better get in. We'll go
